1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Baboni 3-Flaps Pet Door, Model PD-2-M, is designed to provide your pets with convenient access between interior and exterior spaces. This medium-sized pet door features a robust steel frame and a telescoping tunnel, ensuring durability and a secure fit for various door thicknesses. Its innovative 3-flap system offers superior weatherproofing and energy efficiency, helping to maintain indoor temperatures. This model is specifically designed for pets weighing up to 40 lbs.

5. CHOOSING THE RIGHT SIZE

To ensure your pet can comfortably use the door, it is crucial to select the correct size. Follow these steps to measure your pet:

- 1. Make sure your pet is standing:** Have your pet stand naturally.
- 2. Measure the width of your pet's chest:** Measure the widest part of your pet's chest.
- 3. Measure the height from your pet's shoulders to the bottom of chest:** This will give you the approximate shoulder height.
- 4. Choose the door where both your pet's height and width fit:** Refer to the size chart below to match your pet's measurements with the appropriate door size.

6. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS (SETUP)

The Baboni Pet Door is designed for easy installation in various door types. A cut-out template and step-by-step instructions are included in your package. Please refer to these detailed instructions for precise measurements and cutting. The telescoping tunnel adjusts to accommodate door thicknesses between 1 3/8" and 1 31/32".

General Steps:

- 1. Prepare the Door:** Use the provided template to mark the cutout area on your door.
- 2. Cut the Opening:** Carefully cut the marked opening. For metal doors, a side grinder with a metal cut-off blade is recommended for a clean cut. Avoid using jigsaws or reciprocating saws on metal doors as they may cause bending.
- 3. Assemble the Frames:** Insert the telescoping tunnel sections into the frames, adjusting for your door's thickness.
- 4. Secure the Door:** Place the front and back frames into the cutout. Align the screw holes. For foam-centered doors, it may be helpful to use a steel rod (same size as screws but longer) to create a path through the foam for the screws to ensure proper alignment before inserting the screws and fastening the nuts.
- 5. Final Tightening:** Securely tighten all screws.

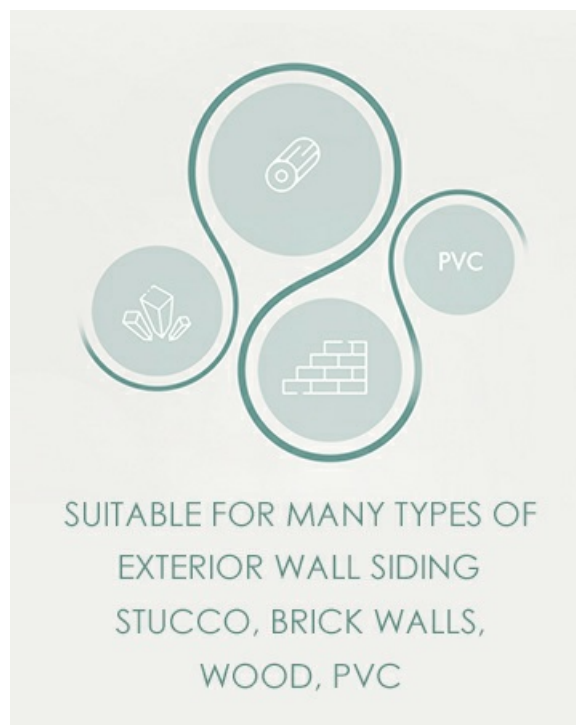


Image: Illustration highlighting the durable steel frame construction of the Baboni pet door compared to plastic frames.

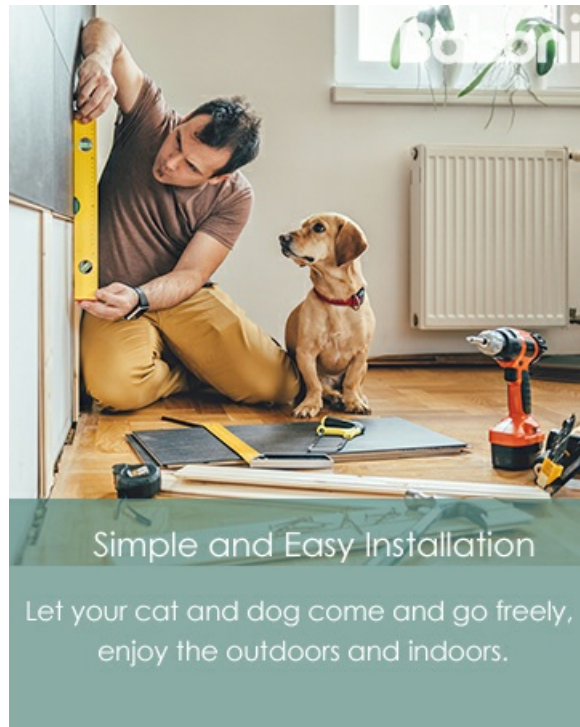


Image: Diagram showing the telescoping tunnel feature, allowing adjustment for different door thicknesses.

7. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Pet Usage:

The 3-flap system is designed for easy pushing by pets. The two outer vinyl flaps and one insulated middle flap are held in place by magnets, ensuring they close securely after your pet passes through. This magnetic closure helps maintain energy efficiency and prevents drafts.

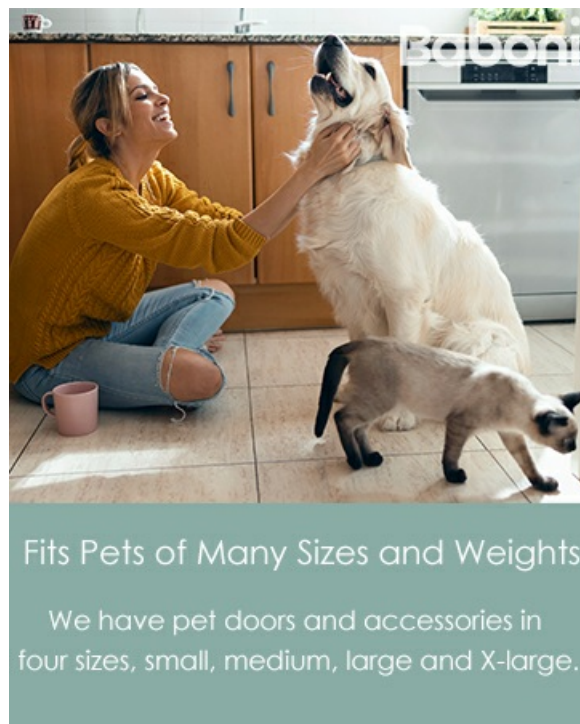


Image: Close-up view of the three-flap system, highlighting the insulated middle flap and magnetic closure.

Using the Metal Closing Panel:

For added security or to restrict pet access, slide the metal closing panel into the designated slots on the interior side of the pet door. This panel provides a solid barrier, offering enhanced security and thermal insulation when the door is not in use.

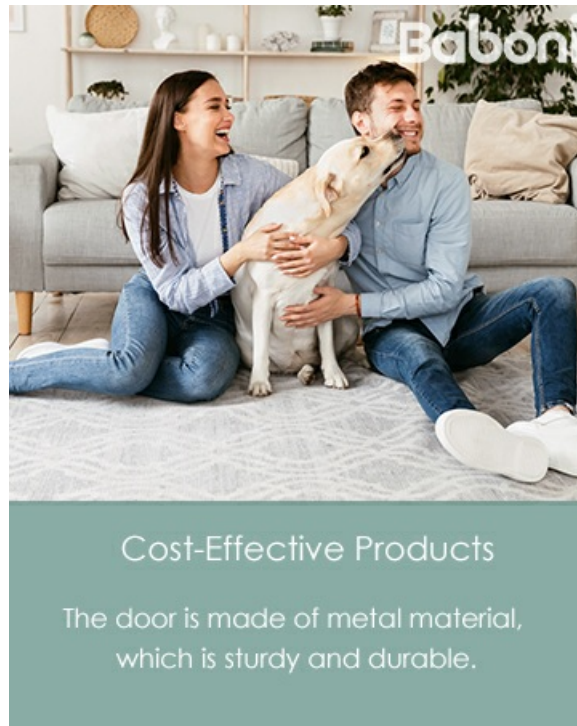


Image: The metal closing panel inserted into the pet door for security and insulation.

8. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will prolong the life and efficiency of your Baboni Pet Door.

- **Cleaning:** Periodically clean the flaps and frame with a mild soap and water solution. Avoid abrasive cleaners that could damage the materials.
- **Inspect Flaps:** Check the flaps for any signs of wear, tears, or stiffness. Replace damaged flaps to maintain weatherproofing and security.
- **Check Magnets:** Ensure the magnets on the flaps and frame are clean and free of debris to allow for proper closure.
- **Frame Inspection:** Periodically check the frame and screws for tightness. Tighten any loose screws to ensure the door remains securely installed.

9. TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions:

- **Flaps not closing properly:** Check for debris obstructing the flaps or magnets. Clean the area. Ensure magnets are still functional.
- **Pets hesitant to use the door:** Gently encourage your pet to pass through the door using treats or toys. You may need to temporarily prop open one or more flaps during initial training.
- **Air drafts around the door:** Verify that the flaps are closing completely and that the magnetic seal is intact. Check the installation for any gaps between the frame and the door.

- **Door feels loose:** Inspect all mounting screws and tighten them as needed.
