# Retevis RA79 Ham Radio Instruction Manual

Model: RA79

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides detailed instructions for the proper setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Retevis RA79 Ham Radio. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device to ensure optimal performance and safety.

The Retevis RA79 is a versatile handheld ham radio designed for reliable communication. Key features include multi-band receiving capabilities, NOAA weather alerts, USB-C charging, and an emergency alarm function.

## 2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

## 3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

### 3.1 Battery Installation

1. Align the battery with the back of the radio body.
2. Slide the battery upwards until it clicks securely into place.

## 3.2 Antenna Attachment

1. Screw the antenna clockwise onto the connector at the top of the radio until it is finger-tight. Do not overtighten.

## 3.3 Charging the Battery

The RA79 radio uses a 1400mAh rechargeable Li-ion battery. It can be charged using the included USB desktop charger or directly via the USB-C port on the radio.

1. **Using the Desktop Charger:** Place the radio (with battery installed) into the desktop charger. Connect the USB charging cable to the desktop charger and a compatible USB power source (e.g., USB adapter, power bank, PC). The indicator light on the charger will show charging status.
2. **Direct USB-C Charging:** Connect the USB-C charging cable directly to the USB-C port on the side of the radio and to a compatible USB power source.

## 3.4 Initial Power On

1. Rotate the power/volume knob clockwise to turn on the radio.
2. Adjust the knob to set the desired volume level.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 4.1 Basic Controls



- **Power/Volume Knob:** Rotate to turn on/off and adjust volume.
- **PTT (Push-to-Talk) Button:** Press and hold to transmit, release to receive. Located on the left side of the radio.
- **Menu Button:** Accesses the radio's menu system.
- **Up/Down Arrows:** Navigate menu options or adjust frequencies.
- **Keypad:** For direct frequency entry and accessing specific functions.

## 4.2 Frequency and Channel Modes

The RA79 supports both VFO (Variable Frequency Oscillator) mode for direct frequency input and Channel mode for pre-programmed frequencies.

1. **VFO Mode:** Allows manual entry and editing of frequencies. Press the **VFO/MR** button (often labeled 3) to switch to VFO mode. Use the keypad to enter the desired frequency.
2. **Channel Mode:** Accesses pre-stored channels. Press the **VFO/MR** button to switch to Channel mode. Use the Up/Down arrows or keypad to select a channel.

### 4.3 Programming

The RA79 can be programmed via its keypad or using CHIRP software.

- **Keypad Programming:** Frequencies and settings can be entered directly using the radio's keypad. Refer to the detailed menu structure in the full user manual for specific programming steps.
- **CHIRP Software:** For advanced programming and channel management, the RA79 is compatible with CHIRP software (Windows XP/7/8/10/11). A programming cable (not always included, check package contents) is required to connect the radio to a computer.

### 4.4 Multi-Band Receiving

The RA79 supports receiving across multiple bands, including V/UHF, AM, and FM, as well as the Air Band.

## 4.5 NOAA Weather Alert

The radio features 10 NOAA weather channels, providing access to weather alerts and forecasts. This function is particularly useful for outdoor activities.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

### 5.1 Cleaning the Device

- Wipe the radio's surface with a soft, damp cloth.
- Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Ensure the radio is powered off and disconnected from any charging source before cleaning.

### 5.2 Battery Care and Storage

- Avoid fully discharging the battery frequently to prolong its lifespan.
- Store batteries in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- If storing for extended periods, charge the battery to approximately 50% capacity.



### 5.3 Antenna Care

- Handle the antenna carefully to prevent bending or damage.
- Ensure the antenna is securely attached during operation.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Retevis RA79 radio, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Radio does not power on	Low or depleted battery; improperly installed battery	Charge the battery; ensure battery is correctly installed.
No signal or poor reception	Antenna not attached; out of range; incorrect frequency/channel	Attach antenna securely; move closer to other radios/repeater; verify frequency/channel settings.
Cannot transmit	Incorrect frequency/offset; PTT button not pressed correctly; battery low	Check frequency and offset settings; ensure PTT is fully pressed; charge battery.
Distorted audio	Volume too high/low; squelch level incorrect; interference	Adjust volume; adjust squelch level; move away from sources of interference.
