1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Polibi Wood Twin Size House Shaped Bunk Bed is designed to provide a fun and functional sleeping solution for children. This unique bunk bed features a distinctive house shape with a brown roof, a window, a built-in ladder, and a slide, creating an engaging environment for play and rest.

Crafted from high-quality solid pine wood and MDF, the bed offers a sturdy and durable structure. It includes wood slats that support mattresses without the need for a box spring, enhancing mattress longevity. The design incorporates safety features such as guardrails on the upper bunk and an integrated ladder for easy access.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all safety warnings and instructions before assembly and use of this product. Failure to follow these instructions can result in serious injury.

- Always supervise children when using the ladder and slide.
- Assemble according to the instructions to ensure stability.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 275 pounds for each bed.
- Be cautious of sharp edges during assembly and use.
- Ensure all connections are securely tightened before use and periodically check for looseness.
- Only use mattresses of the specified size (Twin) to ensure proper fit and safety.

3. COMPONENTS AND PARTS LIST

Before beginning assembly, ensure all parts are present and undamaged. Refer to the packing list provided with your product for exact quantities. Key components include:

1. Bed Frame Components (Side Rails, End Panels, Support Beams)
2. Roof Panels (Brown)
3. Window Frame and Panel
4. Ladder Assembly
5. Slide Assembly
6. Wood Slats for Mattress Support
7. Hardware Pack (Screws, Bolts, Nuts, Allen Wrench, etc.)

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Polibi House Shaped Bunk Bed is designed to be straightforward. Each order includes a clear and detailed assembly instruction guide, along with all necessary tools. It is recommended to assemble the bed with at least two adults.

1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Lay out all components and hardware. Compare them against the provided parts list in your manual to ensure nothing is missing or damaged.
2. **Assemble Bed Frames:** Begin by connecting the side rails to the end panels for both the upper and lower bunks. Ensure all bolts are finger-tight initially.
3. **Install Support Slats:** Once the frames are stable, place and secure the wood slats onto the designated support beams for both beds. These slats provide direct mattress support.
4. **Attach Roof and Window:** Secure the brown roof panels and the window frame to the upper structure of the bed, following the specific instructions for alignment.
5. **Install Ladder and Slide:** Attach the ladder securely to the upper bunk, ensuring it is stable and safe for climbing. Then, attach the slide to its designated position, verifying all connections are firm.
6. **Final Tightening:** Once all major components are in place, systematically tighten all bolts and screws using the provided tools. Do not overtighten.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This bunk bed is designed for sleeping and recreational use of the slide and ladder. Adhere to the following guidelines for safe operation:

- **Using the Ladder:** Always use the built-in ladder to access the upper bunk. Ensure hands and feet are dry to prevent slipping. Climb one step at a time.
- **Using the Slide:** The slide is intended for single-person use at a time. Slide feet first, in a seated position. Ensure the landing area is clear before sliding.
- **Weight Limits:** Do not exceed the recommended weight capacity for each bunk.
- **General Use:** Avoid jumping on the bed or engaging in rough play that could compromise the bed's stability or cause injury.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help prolong the life and ensure the safety of your Polibi bunk bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the bed frame with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that could damage the finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically (e.g., every 3-6 months) check all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they are tight. Retighten if necessary, but do not overtighten.
- **Wood Care:** Protect the wood from extreme temperature changes and direct sunlight, which can cause warping or fading.
- **Mattress Support:** Ensure mattress slats are properly seated and undamaged. Replace any broken slats immediately.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your bunk bed, refer to the following common troubleshooting tips:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed feels wobbly or unstable.	Loose hardware connections.	Check and tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure all components are correctly aligned.
Squeaking noises.	Loose connections or friction between wood parts.	Tighten all hardware. Apply a small amount of paraffin wax or silicone spray to contact points if squeaking persists.
Mattress slides on slats.	Lack of friction or incorrect mattress size.	Ensure mattress is the correct Twin size. Consider placing a non-slip mat between the mattress and slats.


