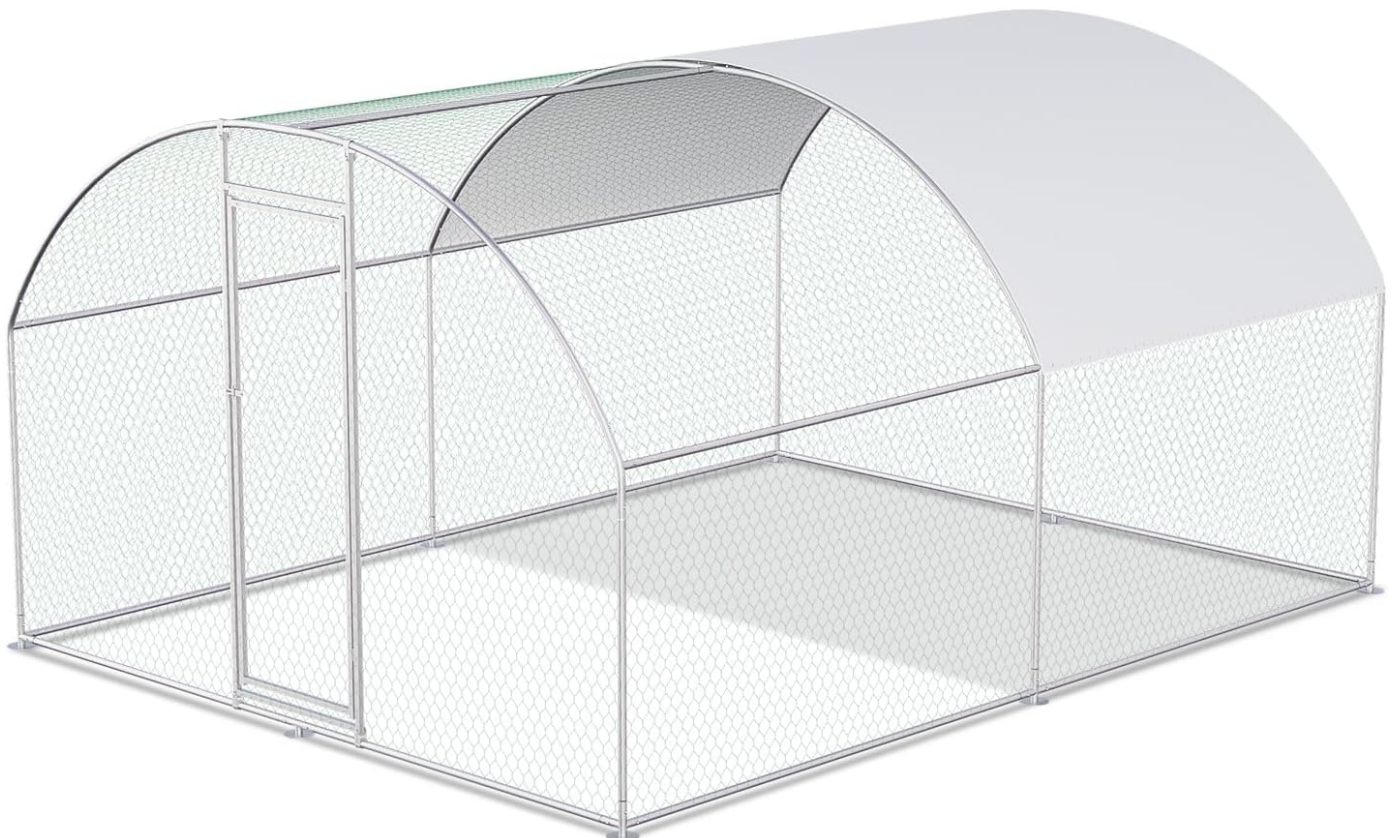


Image: Overview of the CHIKENCOOP Dome Room 2-Unit Coop.

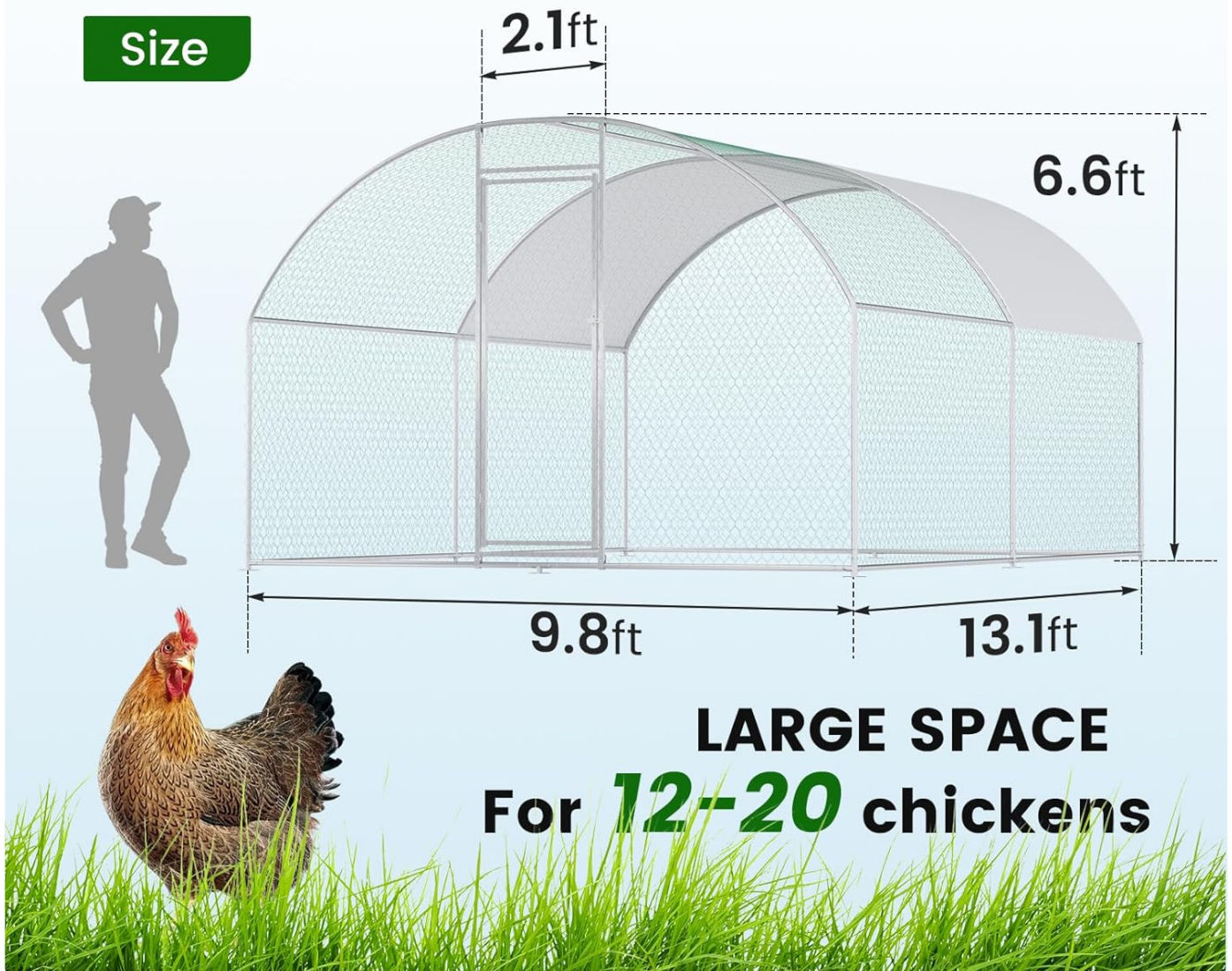


Image: Detailed product dimensions and capacity for the 2-Unit Coop.

The heavy metal structure provides a sturdy and durable framework. Ensure all connections are secure for optimal stability.

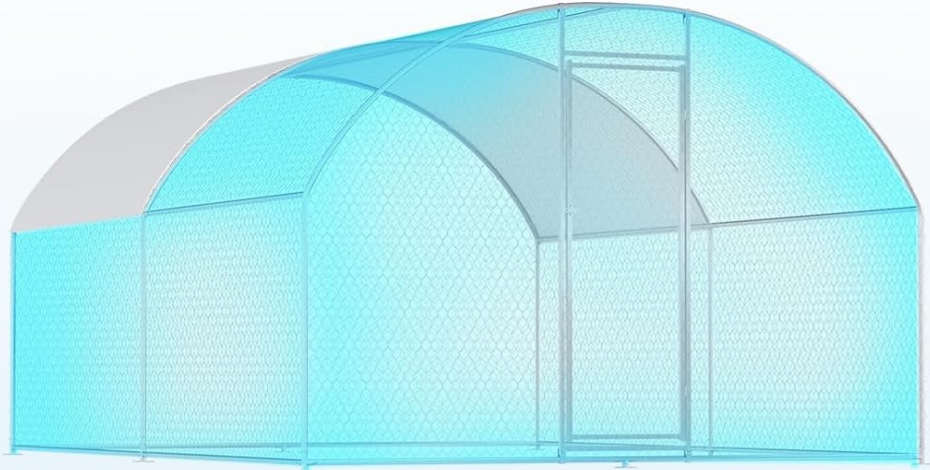

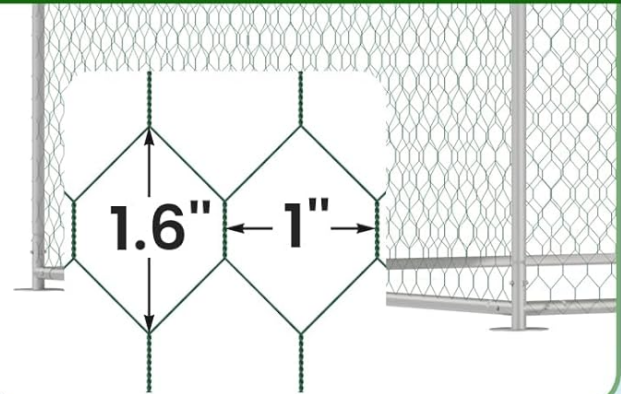


Image: Illustration of the galvanized steel pipes and wire mesh, emphasizing durability and ease of assembly.

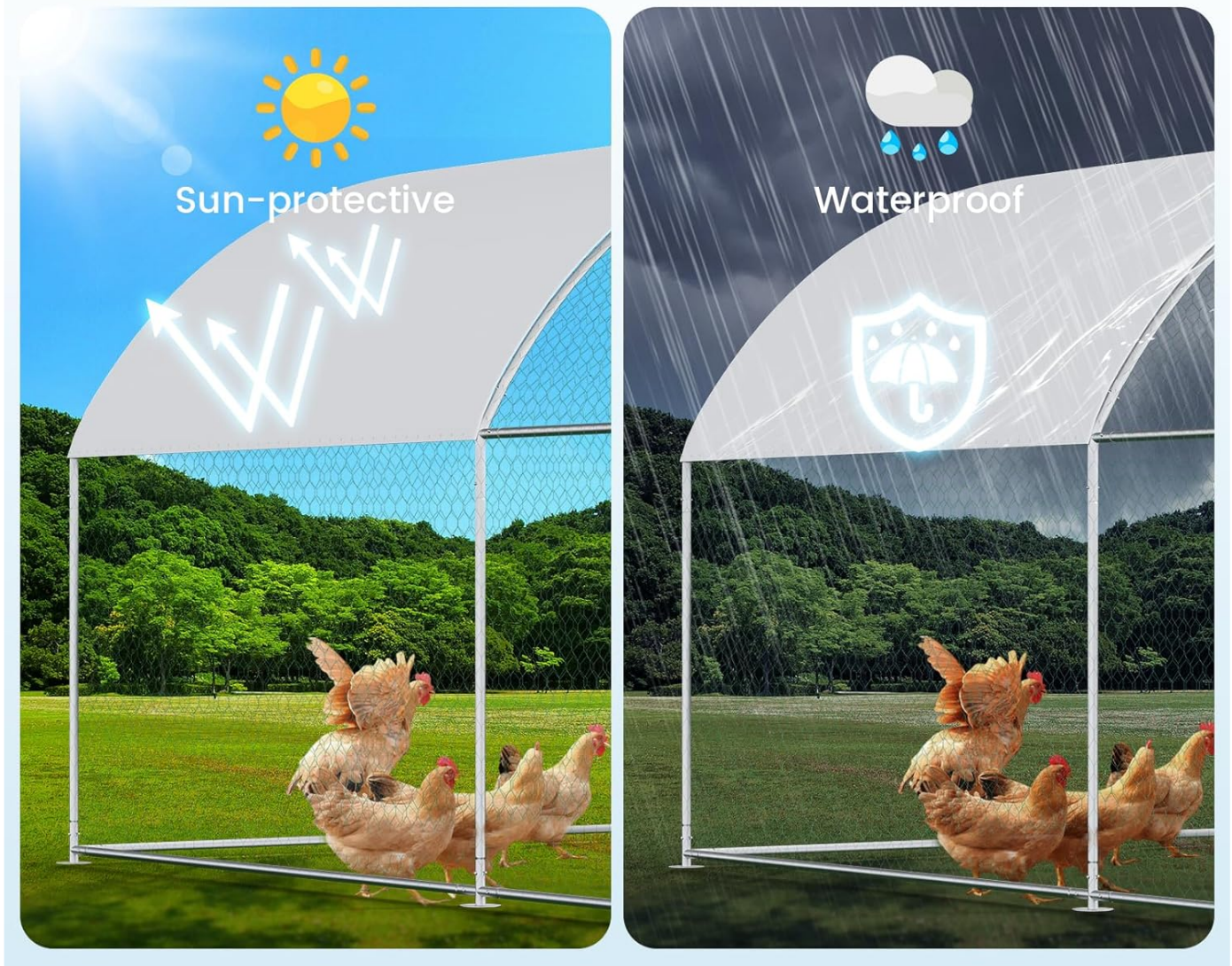


Image: Demonstrating the sun-protective and waterproof features of the coop's cover.

Assembly Tips:

- Lay out all components before beginning assembly to ensure all parts are present.
- Follow the provided detailed instructions carefully.
- While self-tapping screws are provided for certain connections, some users have found that larger diameter screws may be beneficial for increased security in specific areas, particularly for triangular bracing.
- Ensure the base is level and secure. For added stability, especially in windy conditions, consider anchoring the coop with T-posts or railroad ties around the perimeter.

The CHIKENCOOP provides a secure and spacious environment for your poultry. The lockable steel door with a latch ensures easy access for you while preventing unwanted entry from predators. The narrowed gap design further enhances security, preventing chickens from escaping and wild animals from entering.

The spacious interior allows chickens to move freely and comfortably, promoting their well-being. The waterproof and UV-protected cover offers full protection from sun, rain, and snow, with a sloped roof design to prevent accumulation of water or debris.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your chicken coop. The gate is designed for easy cleaning and maintenance. Periodically inspect the wire mesh for any damage and repair as needed to maintain predator resistance.

The waterproof cover should be checked periodically for tears or damage, especially after severe weather. While the sloped roof helps, it is advisable to clear any heavy snow accumulation to prevent potential structural stress.

Cleaning Guidelines:

- Regularly remove droppings and soiled bedding from the coop floor.
- Clean feeders and waterers daily to prevent bacterial growth.
- Periodically hose down the wire mesh and frame with water, and use a mild disinfectant if necessary.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Possible Cause / Solution
Coop feels wobbly or unstable	Ensure all frame connections are tightened. Consider adding additional ground anchors like T-posts or railroad ties, especially in areas prone to strong winds.
Screws for bracing are not holding	If self-tapping screws are not securing properly, you may need to use slightly larger diameter screws for a more secure fit.
Wire mesh appears flimsy or easily damaged	While the provided wire mesh offers basic protection, for enhanced predator resistance (e.g., against raccoons, foxes), consider reinforcing the mesh with stronger gauge wire or hardware cloth, particularly around the base.
Door lock is not secure	If the provided lock does not meet your security needs, it can be upgraded with a more robust latch or padlock.
Water or snow accumulation on roof	Ensure the waterproof cover is properly tensioned and sloped. Regularly clear heavy snow to prevent structural strain.
