Replacement Remote Control User Manual

FOR SKYWORTH 4K UHD HDTV ANDROID TV MODELS

Introduction

This manual provides instructions for the replacement remote control compatible with various Skyworth 4K UHD HDTV Android TV models. This remote is designed to offer essential functionality for your television, serving as a direct replacement for your original remote.

Product Overview

This replacement remote control is designed to operate specific Skyworth television models. It features standard navigation, volume, channel, and dedicated app buttons.

Setup and Initial Use

Installing Batteries

The remote control requires two AAA batteries (not included).

- 1. Open the battery compartment cover on the back of the remote control.
- 2. Insert two AAA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+ and -).
- 3. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

Pairing (Bluetooth Models)

If your original remote was a Bluetooth voice remote, this replacement may require pairing with your TV. Refer to your TV's user manual for specific Bluetooth pairing instructions. Generally, this involves:

- 1. Ensure your TV is powered on.
- 2. Navigate to the TV's settings menu (usually "Remotes & Accessories" or "Bluetooth Settings").

- Home Button: Accesses the TV's main home screen.
- Menu Button: Opens the TV's main menu.
- Source Button: Changes the input source (HDMI, AV, etc.).

Dedicated App Buttons

- Prime Video: Launches the Amazon Prime Video application.
- YouTube: Launches the YouTube application.

Maintenance

Cleaning

To clean the remote control, gently wipe it with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.

Battery Replacement

Replace batteries when the remote's response becomes sluggish or it stops functioning. Always replace both batteries at the same time with new ones of the same type. Dispose of used batteries responsibly according to local regulations.

Storage

Store the remote control in a dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

Troubleshooting

Remote Not Responding

- Check Batteries: Ensure batteries are inserted correctly and are not depleted. Replace if necessary.
- Line of Sight: For IR functionality, ensure there is a clear line of sight between the remote and the

TV's IR receiver.

- Re-pair Remote: If it's a Bluetooth remote, try re-pairing it with your TV (refer to the "Setup" section).
- TV Power Cycle: Turn off your TV, unplug it from the power outlet for a few minutes, then plug it back in and turn it on.

Specific Buttons Not Working

- **Compatibility**: As a replacement remote, some specific or advanced functions (e.g., certain voice commands, very specific smart TV features) may not be fully compatible with all TV models.
- **App Availability**: Ensure the corresponding app is installed and updated on your TV for dedicated app buttons to function correctly.
