Model: G10

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your GOODTEL G10 10-inch Android 13 Tablet. Please read this manual thoroughly before using your device to ensure proper functionality and to maximize your user experience.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Upon opening the package, please verify that all items are present and in good condition. The standard package includes:

- GOODTEL G10 10-inch Android 13 Tablet
- USB Type-C Cable
- Power Adapter
- Protective Case
- Bluetooth Keyboard
- Wireless Mouse
- User Manual (this document)

3. SETUP GUIDE

3.1 Charging the Tablet

Before initial use, fully charge the tablet's 8000mAh battery. Connect the provided USB Type-C cable to the tablet's Type-C port and the power adapter, then plug the adapter into a wall outlet.

3.2 Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button located on the side of the tablet until the screen illuminates.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button until a menu appears on the screen. Select "Power off" and confirm.
- **To Restart:** From the power menu, select "Restart" and confirm.

3.3 Initial Setup

The first time you power on your tablet, you will be guided through an initial setup process:

1. Select your preferred language.
2. Connect to a Wi-Fi network.
3. Sign in with your Google Account or create a new one. This is necessary for downloading apps from the Google Play Store and accessing Google services.
4. Review and accept the terms and conditions.
5. Set up screen lock (PIN, pattern, or password) for security.

3.4 Inserting a MicroSD/TF Card

The GOODTEL G10 supports storage expansion up to 1TB via a MicroSD/TF card. Locate the card slot on the side of the

tablet. Gently insert the MicroSD card with the gold contacts facing down until it clicks into place.

3.5 Connecting Accessories (Keyboard & Mouse)

Your tablet comes with a Bluetooth keyboard and a wireless mouse for enhanced productivity.

3.5.1 Bluetooth Keyboard

1. Ensure the keyboard is charged and powered on.
2. On your tablet, go to **Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth**.
3. Turn on Bluetooth and scan for devices.
4. Select the keyboard from the list of available devices and follow any on-screen pairing instructions.

3.5.2 Wireless Mouse

The wireless mouse typically connects via a USB dongle. If your mouse uses a dongle, you will need an OTG (On-The-Go) adapter (not included) to connect the dongle to the tablet's Type-C port. Alternatively, if it's a Bluetooth mouse, follow the same steps as for the Bluetooth keyboard.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Basic Navigation

The GOODTEL G10 tablet uses a touch-sensitive screen for navigation. Common gestures include:

- **Tap:** To select an item or open an app.
- **Tap & Hold:** To access contextual menus or move icons.
- **Swipe:** To scroll through pages or lists.
- **Pinch-to-Zoom:** To zoom in or out on images and web pages.

4.2 Wi-Fi Connectivity

Your tablet supports both 2.4GHz and 5GHz Wi-Fi for faster internet access.

1. Go to **Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi**.
2. Turn on Wi-Fi.
3. Select your desired network from the list and enter the password if prompted.

4.3 Bluetooth Pairing

To connect Bluetooth devices like headphones or speakers:

1. Ensure the Bluetooth device is in pairing mode.
2. On your tablet, go to **Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth**.
3. Turn on Bluetooth and scan for devices.
4. Select the device from the list and follow any on-screen pairing instructions.

4.4 Using the Camera

The tablet features an 8MP rear camera and a 5MP front camera. Open the Camera app from your home screen or app drawer.

- Tap the shutter button to take a photo.
- Tap the video icon to record a video.
- Use the switch camera icon to toggle between front and rear cameras.

4.5 Installing and Managing Apps

You can download and install applications from the Google Play Store.

- **Install:** Open the **Play Store** app, search for your desired app, and tap "Install".
- **Uninstall:** Tap and hold the app icon on the home screen or in the app drawer, then drag it to "Uninstall" or select "App info" and then "Uninstall". Alternatively, go to **Settings > Apps**, select the app, and tap "Uninstall".

4.6 GPS Functionality

The tablet includes GPS for navigation and location-based services. Ensure location services are enabled in **Settings > Location** for apps to utilize GPS.

4.7 OTG (On-The-Go) Functionality

The Type-C port supports OTG, allowing you to connect USB devices such as flash drives, external hard drives, or certain peripherals (like a wired mouse) using an appropriate OTG adapter (sold separately).




Image: An overview of the GOODTEL G10 tablet's features, including the Type-C port which supports OTG functionality.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Tablet

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the tablet.
- For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen cleaner designed for electronics.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive materials, or excessive moisture.

5.2 Battery Care

- Avoid exposing the tablet to extreme temperatures (hot or cold), as this can degrade battery life.
- Do not leave the tablet fully discharged for extended periods.
- Use only the provided charger or a certified compatible charger.

5.3 Software Updates

Periodically check for system updates to ensure optimal performance and security. Go to **Settings > System > System update**.

5.4 Storage Management

To maintain performance, regularly manage your tablet's storage:

- Delete unnecessary apps and files.
- Move large files (photos, videos) to the MicroSD card or cloud storage.
- Clear app cache regularly via **Settings > Apps > select app > Storage & cache > Clear cache**.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

6.1 Common Issues and Solutions

Issue	Possible Solution
Tablet won't turn on	Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the charger and wait a few minutes before attempting to power on again. If still unresponsive, perform a forced restart by holding the power button for 10-15 seconds.
Wi-Fi connection issues	Check if Wi-Fi is enabled in settings. Restart your router and the tablet. Forget the network and reconnect. Ensure you are within range of the Wi-Fi signal.
Slow performance	Close unused apps. Clear app caches. Free up storage space. Restart the tablet. Consider a factory reset if the issue persists after other steps.
Apps crashing or freezing	Clear the app's cache and data (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage & cache). Update the app to the latest version. Uninstall and reinstall the app.
Touchscreen unresponsive	Restart the tablet. Ensure the screen is clean and free of debris. If the issue persists, contact support.

6.2 Factory Reset

A factory reset will erase all data from your tablet and restore it to its original factory settings. **Backup all important data before proceeding.**

1. Go to **Settings > System > Reset options**.
2. Select **Erase all data (factory reset)**.
3. Confirm your decision and enter your PIN/pattern/password if prompted.
4. The tablet will restart and begin the reset process.




