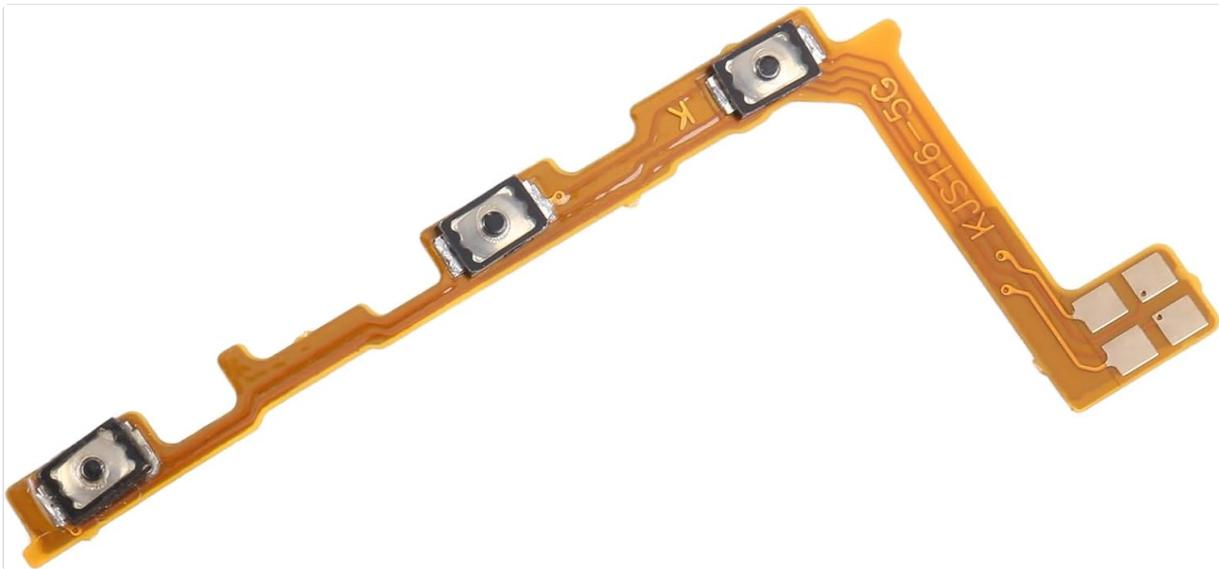


Image 2: Close-up view of the flex cable showing the integrated button contacts.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues after installing the flex cable, consider the following:

- **No Button Response:** Ensure the flex cable's connector is fully and securely seated on the mainboard. A loose connection is a common cause of non-responsiveness.
- **Intermittent Functionality:** Check for any kinks, tears, or damage to the flex cable itself that may have occurred during installation. Even minor damage can affect conductivity.
- **Physical Button Alignment:** Verify that the external power and volume buttons on your device's frame are correctly aligned with the contact points on the flex cable. Misalignment can prevent proper button presses.
- **Re-check Steps:** Review the installation steps and ensure all components were reconnected correctly.
- **Professional Assistance:** If troubleshooting steps do not resolve the issue, it is advisable to seek assistance from a qualified mobile device repair technician.
