PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The WOLFANG GA300 Action Camera features a compact design with intuitive controls and multiple connectivity options.

Camera Components

- Front Screen: For live preview and status indicators.
- Rear Touchscreen (2-inch): For menu navigation, settings adjustment, and playback.
- Power/Mode Button: To power on/off and switch between modes.
- Shutter/OK Button: To start/stop recording or take photos.
- USB-C Port: For charging and data transfer.
- Mini HDMI Port: For video output to external displays.
- Microphone Input: For connecting the external microphone.
- Micro SD Card Slot: Supports up to 128GB cards (32GB included).
- Battery Compartment: Houses the removable 1350mAh battery.

SETUP

1. Inserting Battery

Open the battery compartment cover located at the bottom of the camera. Insert a fully charged 1350mAh battery, ensuring the contacts align correctly. Close the cover securely.

2. Inserting Micro SD Card

Locate the Micro SD card slot on the side of the camera. Insert a compatible Micro SD card (Class 10 or higher, up to 128GB) with the contacts facing the correct direction until it clicks into place.

3. Charging the Camera

Connect the camera to a USB power source using the provided USB-C cable. The charging indicator will illuminate. A full charge typically takes a few hours. Two batteries are included, each providing approximately 90 minutes of recording time.

4. Attaching the Waterproof Case

For underwater use or protection against dust and impact, place the camera inside the waterproof case. Ensure the case is properly sealed before use. The case allows the camera to be waterproof up to 40 meters.

5. Attaching Mounts

Utilize the various included mounts (bicycle stand, helmet mounts, general mounts) to secure your camera for different activities. Ensure all mounts are firmly attached to prevent accidental detachment.

OPERATING THE CAMERA

1. Power On/Off

Press and hold the Power/Mode button to turn the camera on or off.

2. Using the Touchscreen

Navigate through menus and settings by swiping and tapping on the 2-inch rear touchscreen. The responsive touchscreen allows for easy operation.

3. Video Recording

Select video mode from the menu. Press the Shutter/OK button to start recording. Press again to stop. The camera supports 4K at 60FPS, 1080P at 120FPS, and 720P at 240FPS for various recording needs.

4. Photo Capture

Switch to photo mode. Press the Shutter/OK button to take a 24MP photo.

5. Using the Remote Control

The included remote control allows you to start/stop video recording and take photos from a distance of up to 10 meters.

6. Wi-Fi Connectivity and App

Enable Wi-Fi on the camera and connect it to your smartphone via the IBK Cam app. This allows for live preview, remote control, and easy transfer of media to your device.

7. Special Functions

8. Adjustable View Angle Lens

9. 6-Axis EIS Stabilization & 8x Zoom

The advanced 6-axis Electronic Image Stabilization (EIS) ensures your videos remain smooth and stable, even during dynamic activities. The 8x zoom function allows for precise control over shooting distance and capturing distant details.

MAINTENANCE

- Waterproof Case: Regularly inspect the waterproof case for any damage or debris on the seal. Clean with fresh water after saltwater use and allow to air dry.
- Lens Care: Use the provided lens cloth to gently clean the camera lens and waterproof case lens. Avoid abrasive materials.
- **Battery Storage:** Store batteries in a cool, dry place. For long-term storage, charge batteries to approximately 50% capacity.
- General Cleaning: Wipe the camera body with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- Camera Not Turning On: Ensure the battery is fully charged and correctly inserted. Try using the second included battery.
- **Recording Issues:** Check if the Micro SD card is properly inserted and has sufficient free space. Ensure the card is Class 10 or higher.
- Poor Audio Quality: If using the external microphone, ensure it is securely plugged into the correct port.

 Check camera settings to confirm external mic is selected.
- Wi-Fi Connection Problems: Restart both the camera and your smartphone. Ensure the IBK Cam app is

up to date.

• Water Leakage: Immediately remove the camera from the waterproof case. Inspect the case for cracks or damage to the rubber seal. Do not use the case if damaged.


