INTRODUCTION

This user manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your tectake 1500W Portable Electric Space Heater. Designed for versatile use in various indoor and outdoor settings such as patios, greenhouses, garages, bedrooms, and offices, this heater features PTC ceramic heating technology, 120° oscillation, and multiple safety protections. Please read this manual thoroughly before use and retain it for future reference.

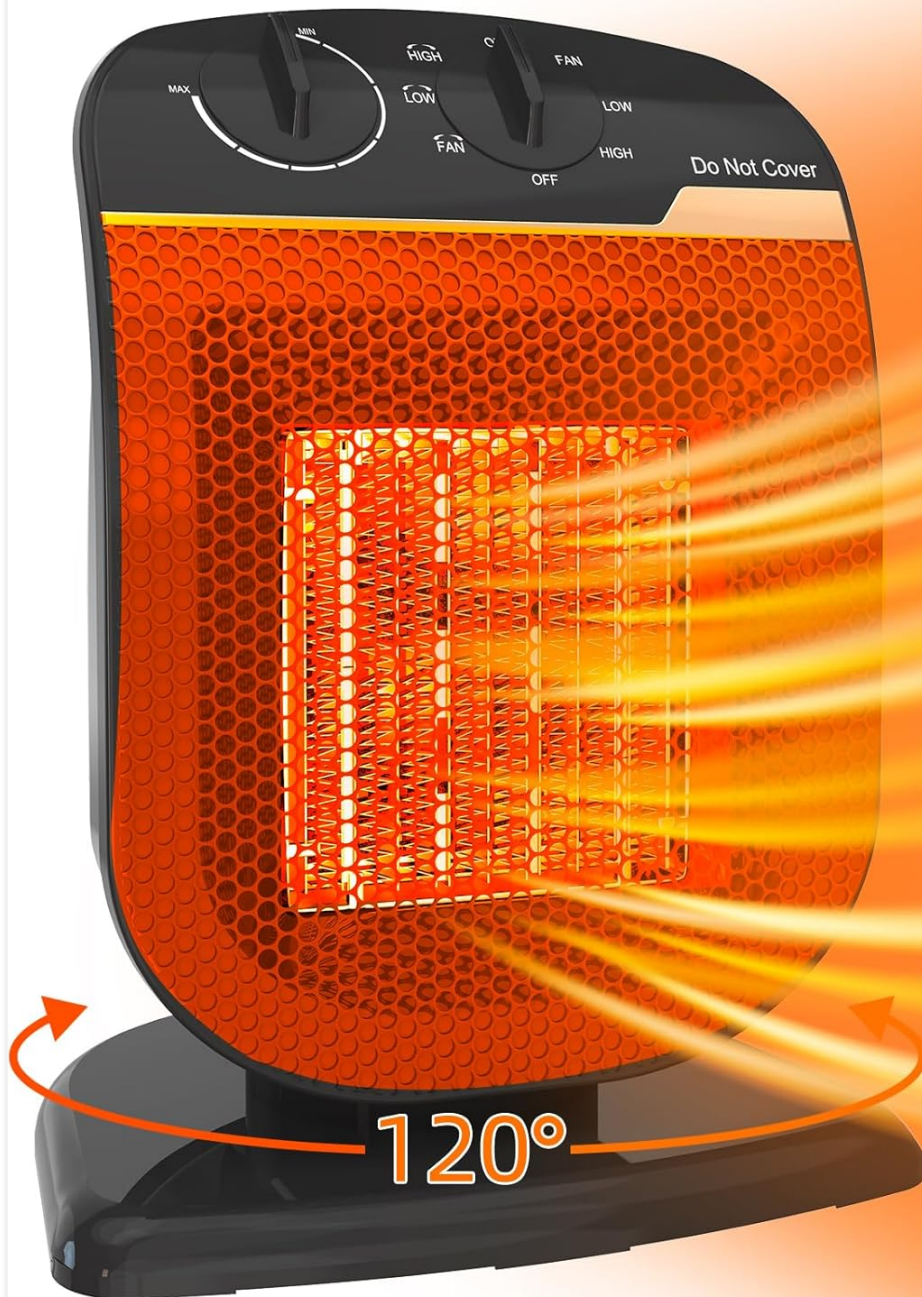


Figure 1: tectake 1500W Portable Electric Space Heater.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury, always follow these basic precautions:

- Read all instructions before using this heater.
- Do not use this heater in bathrooms, laundry areas, or similar indoor locations where it may come into contact with water.
- Always unplug the heater when not in use.
- Do not operate any heater with a damaged cord or plug, or after the heater malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any manner.
- Keep combustible materials, such as furniture, pillows, bedding, papers, clothes, and curtains at least 3 feet (0.9 m) from the front of the heater and away from the sides and rear.

- To prevent a possible fire, do not block air intakes or exhaust in any manner. Do not use on soft surfaces, like a bed, where openings may become blocked.
- Do not insert or allow foreign objects to enter any ventilation or exhaust opening as this may cause an electric shock or fire, or damage the heater.
- This heater is equipped with an **Overheat Protection** feature that automatically cuts off power if the internal temperature reaches 167°F (75°C). The heater will resume operation once it cools down.
- The heater also includes a **Tip-over Protection** switch, which automatically shuts off the unit if it is accidentally knocked over. Ensure the heater is placed on a stable, flat surface.

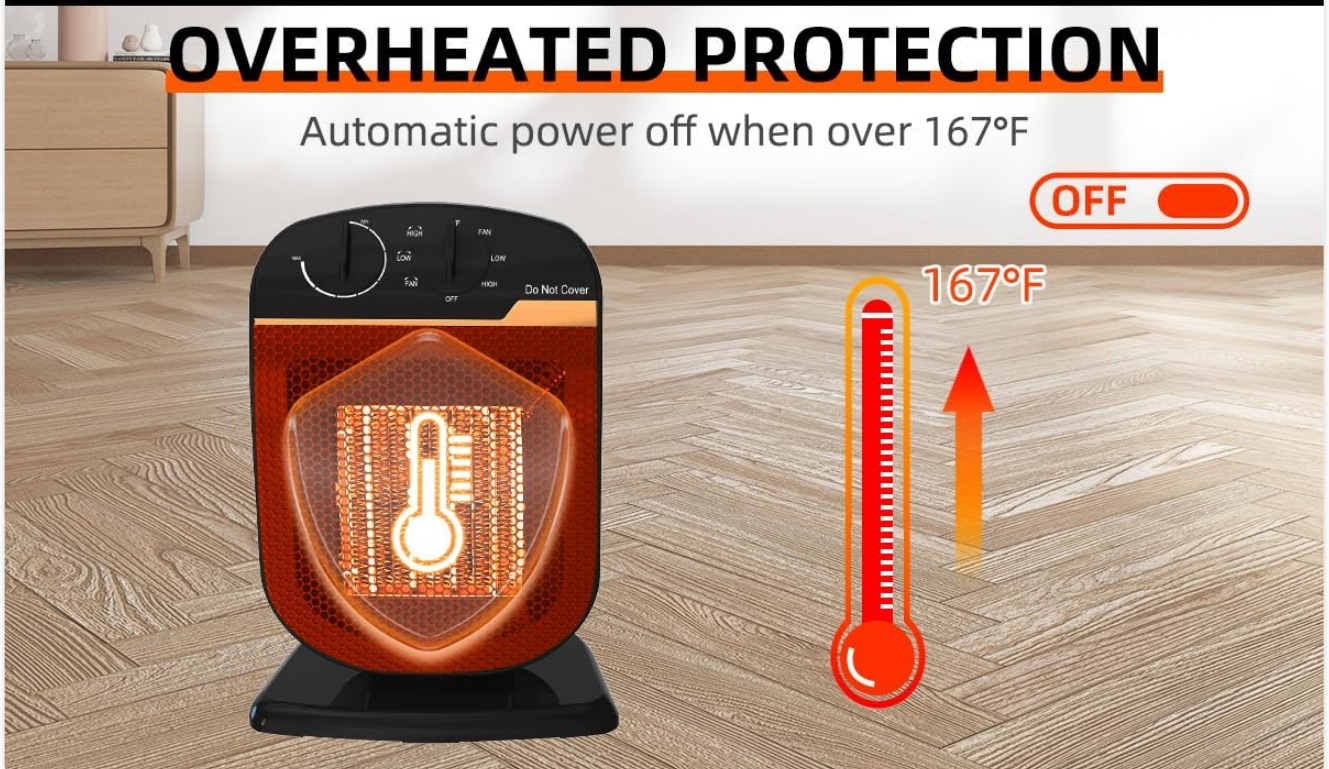

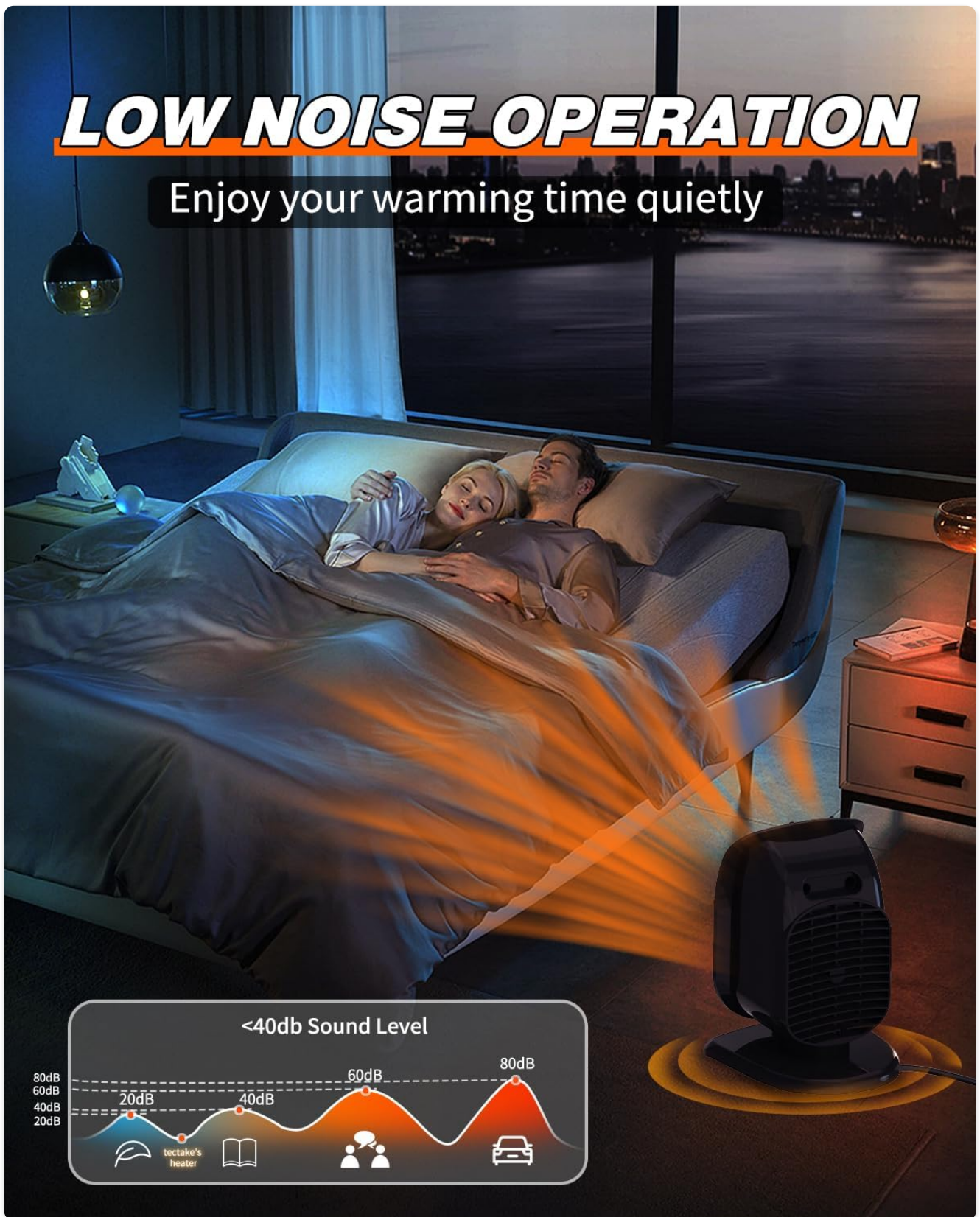


Figure 7: Low noise operation for undisturbed comfort.

SETUP

1. Unpack the heater and all accessories from the box.
2. Place the heater on a firm, level surface. Ensure there are no obstructions to the air intake or exhaust vents.
3. Ensure the heater is at least 3 feet (0.9 meters) away from walls, furniture, curtains, and other combustible

materials.

4. Plug the power cord into a standard 120V AC electrical outlet. Do not use extension cords or power strips with this heater.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your tectake space heater features two rotary knobs for easy control:

1. Power/Mode Selection Knob (Right Knob):

- Turn to **OFF** to power off the unit.
- Turn to **FAN** for natural wind circulation without heat.
- Turn to **LOW** for 750W low heat output.
- Turn to **HIGH** for 1500W high heat output.

2. Thermostat/Oscillation Knob (Left Knob):

- Adjust the thermostat from **MIN** to **MAX** to set your desired room temperature. The heater will cycle on and off to maintain this temperature.
- To activate the 120° oscillation function, ensure the heater is powered on and then turn the thermostat knob to the desired setting. The oscillation will begin automatically.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your heater.

- **Cleaning:** Always unplug the heater from the wall outlet before cleaning. Use a soft, damp cloth to wipe the exterior surfaces of the heater. Do not use cleaning sprays, abrasive cleaners, or polishes as they may damage the heater.
- **Storage:** When storing the heater, keep it in a cool, dry location. It is recommended to store it in its original packaging to protect it from dust and damage.
- **No User-Serviceable Parts:** This heater contains no user-serviceable parts. Do not attempt to open or repair

the unit yourself. Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Heater does not operate.	Not plugged in securely. Power outlet not functioning. Tip-over switch activated. Overheat protection activated. Thermostat set too low.	Ensure the power cord is firmly plugged into a working 120V AC outlet. Check the circuit breaker or try another outlet. Place the heater on a firm, level surface. Unplug the heater, wait 10-15 minutes for it to cool down, then plug it back in. Turn the thermostat knob to a higher setting.
Heater stops operating unexpectedly.	Overheat protection activated. Tip-over switch activated.	Unplug the heater, wait 10-15 minutes for it to cool down, then plug it back in. Ensure vents are not blocked. Ensure the heater is upright and on a stable surface.
Heater produces a burning smell.	New unit or dust accumulation.	This is normal for new heaters and should dissipate quickly. If the smell persists or is strong, unplug the unit and contact customer support. Ensure the heater is clean and free of dust.





