4. SETUP

| Slow charging. | Power source limitation; vehicle settings; environmental factors. | Verify power source output. Check vehicle charging settings. Ensure cable is not overheating. |
| Connector difficult to insert/remove. | Debris in port/connector; misalignment; locking mechanism issue. | Inspect and clean port/connector. Ensure correct alignment. Do not force. If issue persists, contact support. |
