INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Philips Steamer 3000 Series with XL StyleBoard STE3180/30. This garment steamer is designed to provide efficient and convenient wrinkle removal for your clothes. Please read this manual carefully before using the appliance and keep it for future reference.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and personal injury.

- Ensure the voltage indicated on the appliance corresponds to your local mains voltage before connecting.
- Do not immerse the appliance, power cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Keep the steam head away from your body and hands during operation to avoid steam burns.
- Always unplug the appliance before filling or emptying the water tank, and during cleaning or maintenance.
- Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or if it has been dropped or damaged.
- Keep out of reach of children.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

1. Assembling the Steamer

1. Place the base unit on a stable, flat surface.
2. Insert the adjustable pole into the designated slot on the base unit until it clicks into place.
3. Attach the XL StyleBoard to the adjustable pole. Ensure it is securely fastened.
4. Connect the steam hose to the steam outlet on the base unit.
5. Hang the steam head on the hanger provided on the adjustable pole.

2. Filling the Water Tank

1. Ensure the appliance is unplugged from the power outlet.
2. Remove the water tank from the base unit.
3. Open the water tank cap and fill it with clean tap water up to the maximum fill line. Do not overfill.
4. Close the cap securely and place the water tank back into the base unit.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Powering On and Selecting Steam Settings

1. Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
2. Turn the power dial on the base unit to the desired steam setting. The appliance features 5 steam settings for various fabric types.
3. Wait for the appliance to heat up. The indicator light will show when it is ready to use.

2. Steaming Garments

1. Hang your garment on a hanger on the adjustable pole or place it directly on the XL StyleBoard.
2. Hold the steam head close to the fabric, ensuring not to touch delicate materials directly unless specified.
3. Move the steam head slowly downwards over the fabric, allowing the steam to relax the fibers and remove wrinkles.
4. Utilize the pointed metal steam plate tip for hard-to-reach areas like collars, cuffs, and pleats.

3. Using MyEssence Fragrance Infuser

The MyEssence feature allows you to refresh your clothes with your favorite scents.

1. Locate the MyEssence fragrance infuser compartment (refer to appliance diagram if available).

2. Add a few drops of your preferred essential oil or fragrance to the infuser pad.
3. Close the compartment securely. The steam will carry the fragrance to your garments.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

1. General Cleaning

- Always unplug the appliance and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- Wipe the exterior of the base unit and steam head with a soft, damp cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

2. Descaling (Calc-Clean)

Regular descaling is essential to maintain optimal performance and extend the life of your steamer. The frequency depends on water hardness and usage.

1. Ensure the appliance is unplugged and cool.
2. Remove the water tank and empty any remaining water.
3. Refer to the specific descaling instructions in the full manual or on the Philips support website for detailed steps, as procedures may vary.
4. Rinse the water tank thoroughly after descaling.

3. Storage

When not in use, store the steamer in a dry, safe place. Ensure the water tank is empty and the appliance is cool before storing.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your steamer, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No steam or low steam output.	Water tank empty, appliance not heated, calcification.	Fill water tank, allow to heat up, perform descaling.
Water leaking from steam head.	Condensation, overfilling water tank, calcification.	Allow appliance to heat fully, do not overfill, descale.
Appliance not turning on.	Not plugged in, power outlet issue.	Check power connection, try a different outlet.
