INTRODUCTION

This Igloo Electric Countertop Ice Maker is a compact, stylish, and portable appliance designed to provide a continuous supply of ice for your beverages. It is capable of producing up to 33 pounds of ice per day, with the first batch ready in as little as 7 minutes. The unit features a transparent viewing window, a 2-pound ice basket, and an LED-lighted control panel for easy operation and monitoring.

Key features include:

- Quick-freezing capability, producing 9 small or large cylinder-shaped ice cubes in approximately 7 minutes.
- Large ice-making capacity of 33 pounds per 24-hour period.
- Integrated ice basket with a 2-pound storage capacity.
- · User-friendly LED-lighted control panel indicating when to add water or when the ice basket is full.
- · Compact and portable design suitable for various settings.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all instructions carefully before operating this appliance to ensure safe and efficient use. Retain this manual for future reference.

- Ensure the appliance is placed on a stable, level surface with adequate ventilation around it.
- Do not immerse the power cord, plug, or appliance in water or any other liquid.
- Unplug the appliance from the outlet when not in use, before cleaning, or if a malfunction occurs.
- Keep the appliance away from heat sources, direct sunlight, and flammable materials.
- This appliance is for household use only. Do not use it for commercial or industrial purposes.
- Supervise children closely when the appliance is in use.
- · Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug.
- · Only use potable water in the ice maker.
- Note: Please check the dimensions and item weight of the product to confirm it fits your intended space before setup.

- 1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the ice maker from its packaging. Remove all packing materials, including any tape or labels.
- 2. **Placement:** Place the ice maker on a flat, stable surface away from direct sunlight and other heat sources. Ensure there is at least 4 inches of space around the unit for proper ventilation.
- 3. **Initial Standby:** After transportation, allow the ice maker to stand upright for at least one hour before plugging it in. This allows the refrigerant to settle.
- 4. **First Cleaning:** Before first use, clean the interior of the ice maker. Refer to the "Maintenance and Cleaning" section for detailed instructions.
- 5. **Power Connection:** Plug the ice maker into a grounded electrical outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Add Water: Open the lid and fill the water reservoir with potable water up to the MAX fill line. Do not overfill.

- 2. **Power On:** Press the **ON/OFF** button on the control panel to turn on the ice maker. The Power indicator light will illuminate.
- 3. **Select Ice Size:** Press the **SELECT** button to choose between small (SMALL) or large (LARGE) ice cube sizes. The corresponding indicator light will illuminate.
- 4. **Ice Production:** The ice maker will begin the ice-making cycle. The first batch of ice cubes will typically be ready in approximately 7 minutes. Subsequent batches may be produced more quickly.
- 5. **Ice Full Indicator:** When the ice basket is full, the **ICE FULL** indicator light will illuminate, and the ice production will pause. Remove ice from the basket to resume operation.
- 6. **Add Water Indicator:** If the water level in the reservoir is too low, the **ADD WATER** indicator light will illuminate, and the ice production will stop. Add more water to the reservoir to resume operation.
- 7. Power Off: To turn off the ice maker, press the ON/OFF button again.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance will prolong the life of your ice maker and ensure optimal performance.

• Daily Cleaning:

- Unplug the appliance.
- Remove the ice basket and clean it with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly.
- Drain any remaining water from the reservoir by removing the drain plug located at the bottom of the unit.
- Wipe the interior with a soft cloth and a mild detergent. Rinse by wiping with a damp cloth.
- · Dry all parts thoroughly before reassembling.
- **Self-Cleaning Function:** This model features a self-cleaning function. Consult the full user manual for specific instructions on how to activate and utilize this feature for thorough internal cleaning.
- . Addressing Taste Issues: If you notice an unusual taste in the ice, it may be due to mineral buildup or residual

manufacturing odors. Perform several cleaning cycles. Some users have found success by running cleaning cycles with a mixture of water and white vinegar or lemon juice, followed by multiple plain water rinses. Always ensure thorough rinsing to remove any cleaning solution residue.

 Exterior Cleaning: Wipe the exterior of the ice maker with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer support, please refer to the following common issues and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice maker not producing ice.	No water in reservoir; water pump malfunction; ambient temperature too high.	Fill water reservoir; contact customer support if pump is faulty; ensure unit is in a cool environment.
"ADD WATER" indicator is on.	Water level is too low.	Add potable water to the reservoir up to the MAX fill line.
"ICE FULL" indicator is on.	Ice basket is full.	Remove ice from the basket.
Ice cubes are small or cloudy.	Water temperature too high; mineral buildup.	Use colder water; perform a thorough cleaning cycle.
Unit is noisy.	Normal operation sounds (compressor, water pump); unit not level.	Ensure unit is on a level surface. Some operational noise is normal.
