1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your HYUNDAI Smart TV 42-inch Full HD. This television features a 42-inch Full HD (1920x1080p) display, VIDAA operating system, and integrated smart applications such as Netflix, YouTube, and Prime Video. It also supports Screencast functionality for content sharing from mobile devices.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

3. SETUP

3.1 Unpacking and Stand Installation

Carefully remove the television from its packaging. Attach the included stands to the bottom of the television using the provided screws. Ensure the stands are securely fastened before placing the TV upright.

- **RJ45 (Ethernet):** Connect to your home network for internet access.
- **Optical Output:** Connect to an external audio system.
- **Headphone Output:** Connect headphones for private listening.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Television

Before cleaning, unplug the power cord from the wall outlet. Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the screen and cabinet. For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive cleaner specifically designed for electronics. Never spray liquid directly onto the screen or cabinet.

5.2 Software Updates

The television may receive software updates to improve performance and add new features. Ensure your TV is connected to the internet to receive automatic updates. You can also check for updates manually through the TV's settings menu.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your television, refer to the following common solutions:

- **No Power:** Check if the power cord is securely plugged into both the TV and the wall outlet. Ensure the power outlet is functional.
- **No Picture/Sound:** Verify the correct input source is selected. Check all cable connections (HDMI, antenna). Try another channel or input device.
- **No Internet Connection:** Ensure your Wi-Fi router is on and functioning. Reconnect to the Wi-Fi network in the TV settings. For wired connections, check the Ethernet cable.
- **Remote Control Not Working:** Replace the batteries in the remote control. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR sensor.
- **Picture Quality Issues:** Adjust picture settings (brightness, contrast, sharpness) in the TV menu. Ensure the input source is providing a high-quality signal.

If problems persist, consider performing a factory reset through the TV's settings menu (note: this will erase all personalized settings and data). For further assistance, contact customer support.

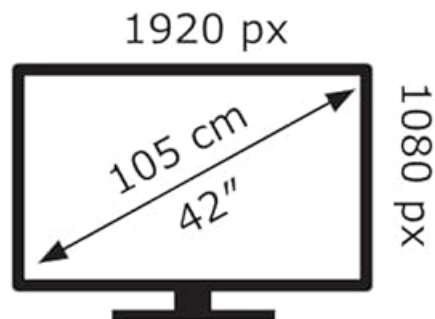
