1. INTRODUCTION

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury when using your dishwasher, follow these basic precautions:

- Be careful when opening the door during or after a wash cycle, as hot steam may escape.
- Ensure the dishwasher is properly grounded.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

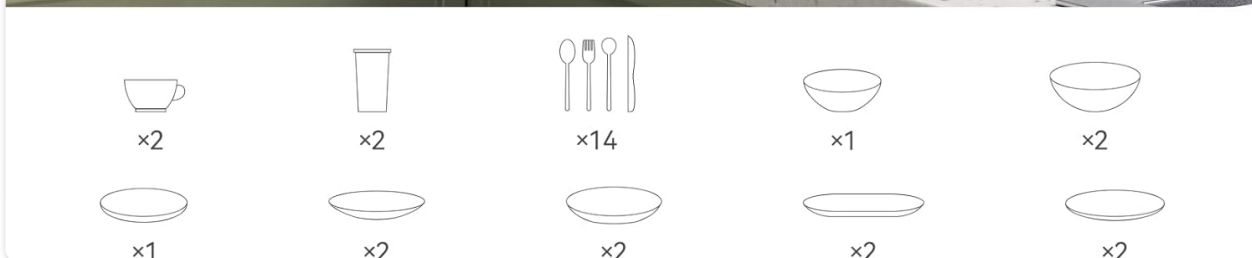
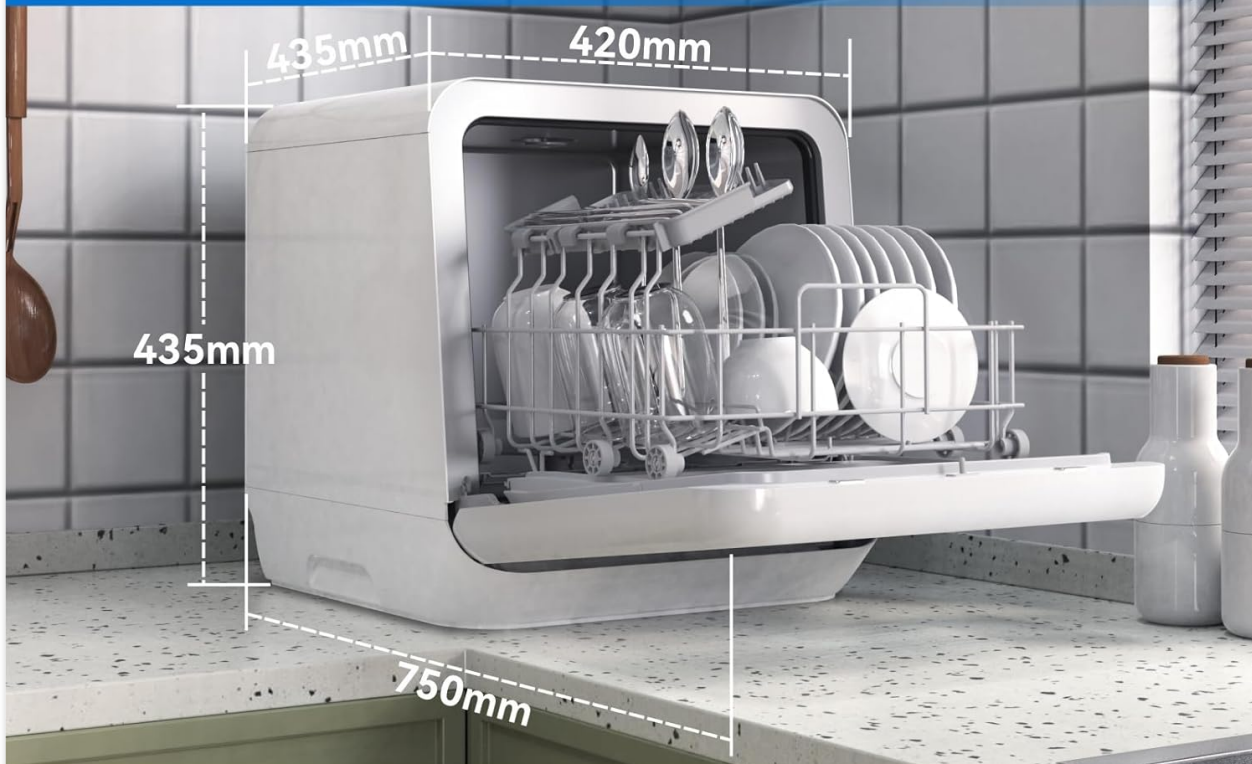


Figure 3: Compact Size and Dimensions

5. SETUP

5.1 Water Supply Modes

The dishwasher offers two convenient water supply options:

1. **Manual Filling:** Use the provided measuring cup and funnel to manually pour water into the designated inlet on top of the dishwasher. The appliance will signal when the water tank is full.
2. **Direct Connection:** Connect the inlet hose to a kitchen faucet for automatic water supply. Ensure the connection is secure to prevent leaks.

5.2 Salt Addition

To reduce water hardness and prevent limescale buildup, add dishwasher salt to the dedicated salt dispenser. This helps improve cleaning performance and prolong the appliance's lifespan.

5.3 Loading the Dishwasher

Before loading, remove large food scraps from dishes to prevent drain blockage. Arrange dishes in the basket as shown in the illustrations below, ensuring proper water circulation.

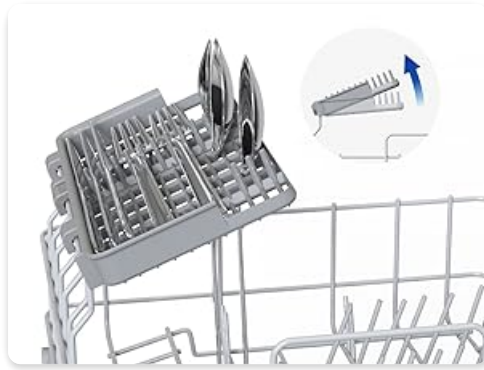


Figure 8: Proper Placement of Cutlery

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Control Panel

The dishwasher features an intuitive LED touch control panel for easy operation. The panel displays cycle status and allows selection of various programs and functions.

6.2 Wash Programs

Choose from 6+1 wash programs to suit your needs:

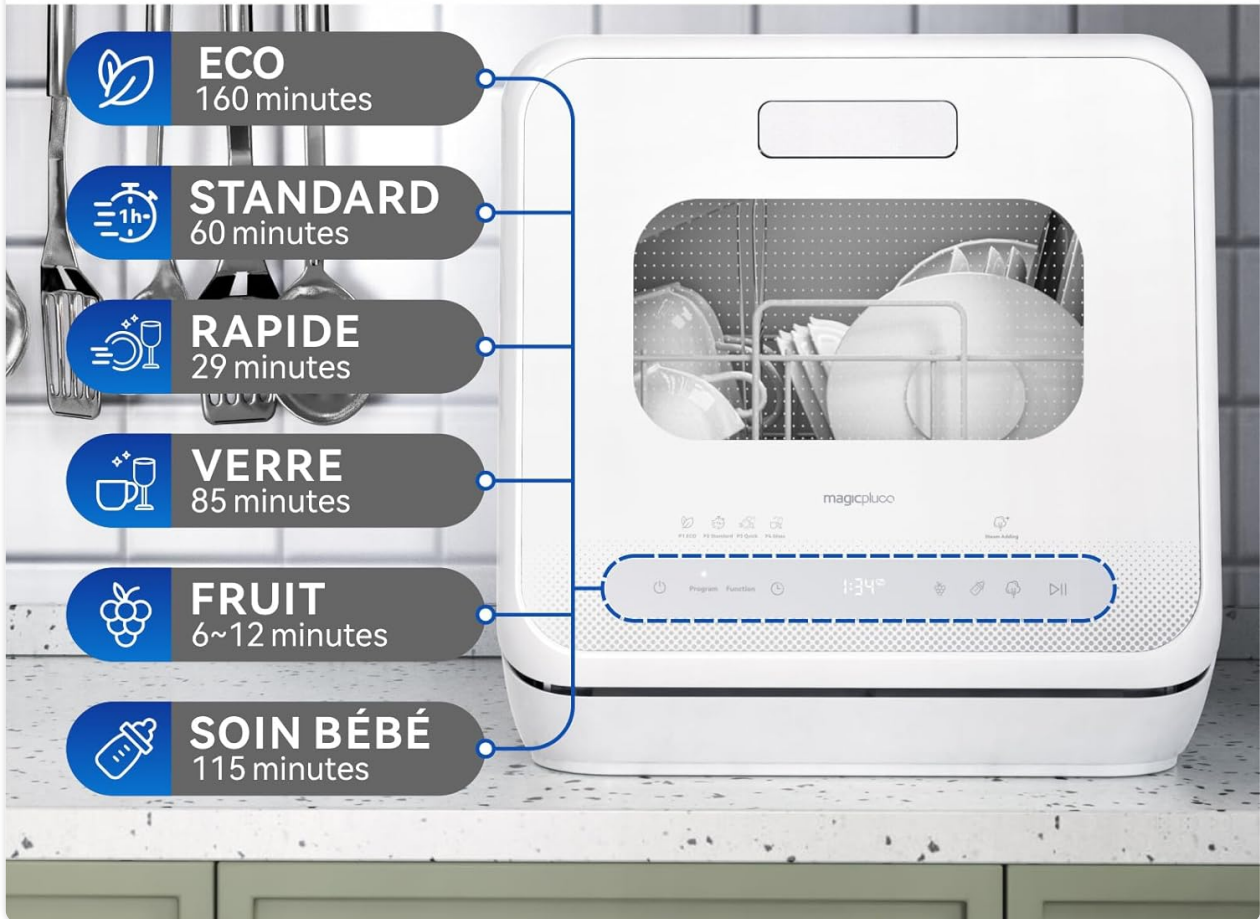


Figure 9: Available Wash Programs

- **ECO (160 minutes):** Energy-saving program for normally soiled dishes.
- **Standard (60 minutes):** Regular program for daily use.
- **Rapid (29 minutes):** Quick wash for lightly soiled dishes.
- **Gentle (Glass) (85 minutes):** For delicate items like glassware.
- **Fruit (6-12 minutes):** Specialized program for washing fruits.
- **Baby Care (115 minutes):** High-temperature wash for baby bottles and items.
- **Extra Dry Function:** Provides enhanced drying performance.

6.3 Steam Function

The steam function helps to soften and dissolve hardened food residues on dishes before the main wash cycle, improving overall cleaning effectiveness.

6.4 Delayed Start

The delayed start mode allows you to program the dishwasher to begin a wash cycle at a later time (1-24 hours). This feature can be used to take advantage of off-peak electricity rates or to have dishes ready at a convenient time.

6.5 LED Interior Light

The transparent door combined with the LED interior light allows you to observe the washing process and easily load or unload dishes.

Wipe the exterior of the dishwasher with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

7.3 Interior Cleaning

Periodically run a self-clean cycle or use a dishwasher cleaner to remove any buildup and maintain hygiene.

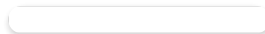


Figure 13: Before and After Cleaning

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your dishwasher, consult the table below for common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dishwasher does not start	Power supply issue, door not closed properly, program not selected.	Check power connection, ensure door is latched, select a wash program.
Dishes are not clean	Improper loading, clogged spray arms, insufficient detergent, water hardness.	Reload dishes correctly, clean spray arms, use appropriate detergent, add dishwasher salt.
Water remaining in the tub	Clogged drain hose or filter.	Clean the drain filter, check for kinks in the drain hose.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unusual noise during operation	Dishes interfering with spray arm, foreign object in pump.	Rearrange dishes, inspect pump area for obstructions.

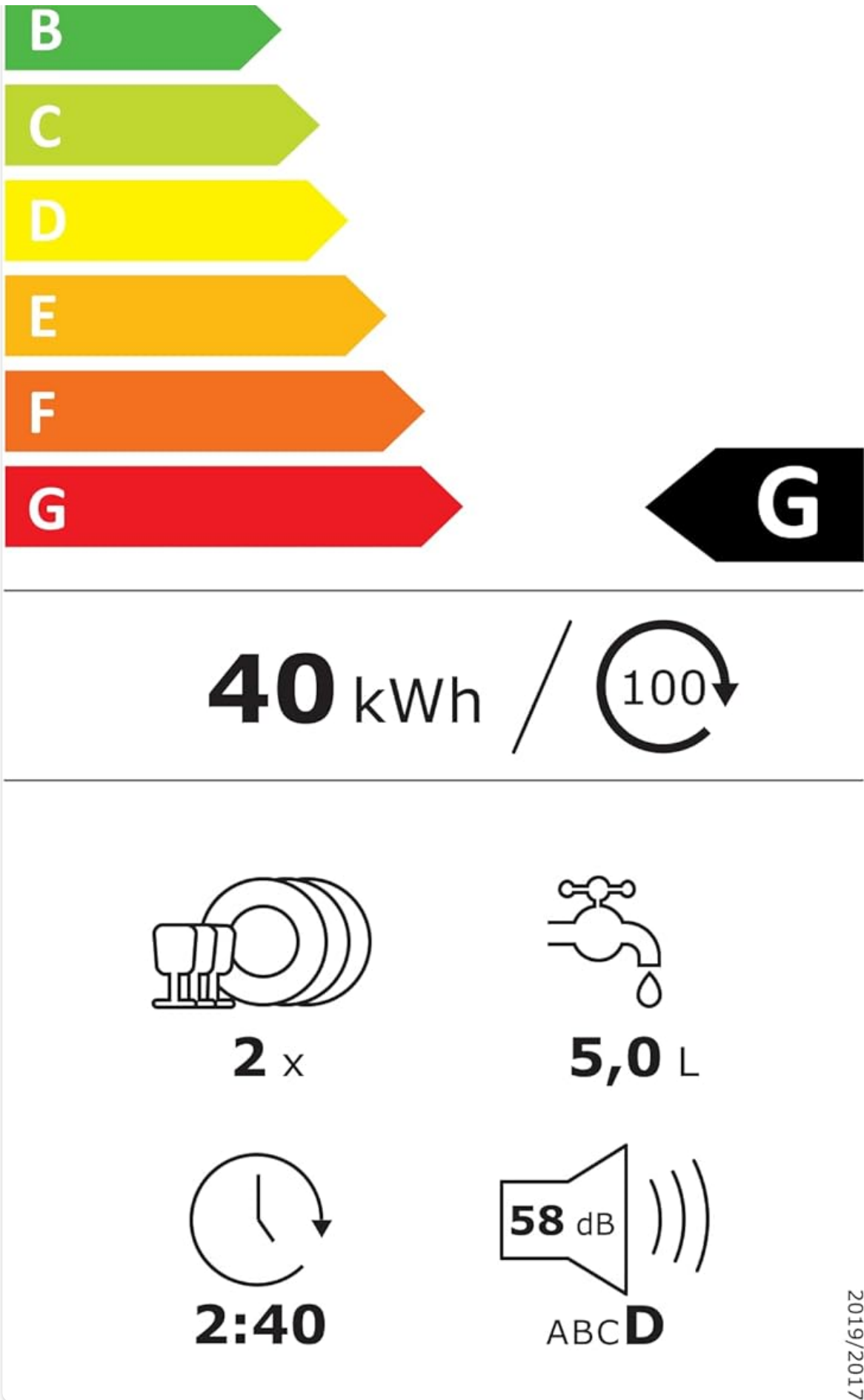


Figure 14: EU Energy Label for MDW4CW01
