## SETUP

### Initial Power-On and Configuration

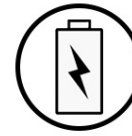
1. **Unboxing:** Carefully remove the laptop and all accessories from the packaging. Ensure all components listed in the "What's in the Box" section are present.
2. **Charging:** Connect the power adapter to the laptop's power input port and a wall outlet. Allow the battery to charge fully before initial use for optimal performance.
3. **First Boot:** Open the laptop lid. The device features a "Flip-to-Start" function, which automatically powers on the laptop when the lid is opened.
4. **Windows 11 Setup:** Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the Windows 11 Home setup. This includes selecting your region, language, connecting to a Wi-Fi network, and creating a user account.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Connectivity and Ports

- **SD Card Reader:** For transferring files from memory cards.
- **USB 3.2 Gen 1 (Type-A):** High-speed data transfer.
- **Power Input:** Connect the AC adapter for charging.
- **USB 2.0 (Type-A):** Standard USB connectivity.
- **HDMI 1.4b:** Connect to external monitors or TVs.
- **USB-C 3.2 Gen 1:** Supports data transfer only.
- **Headphone / Microphone Combo Jack (3.5mm):** For audio input and output.

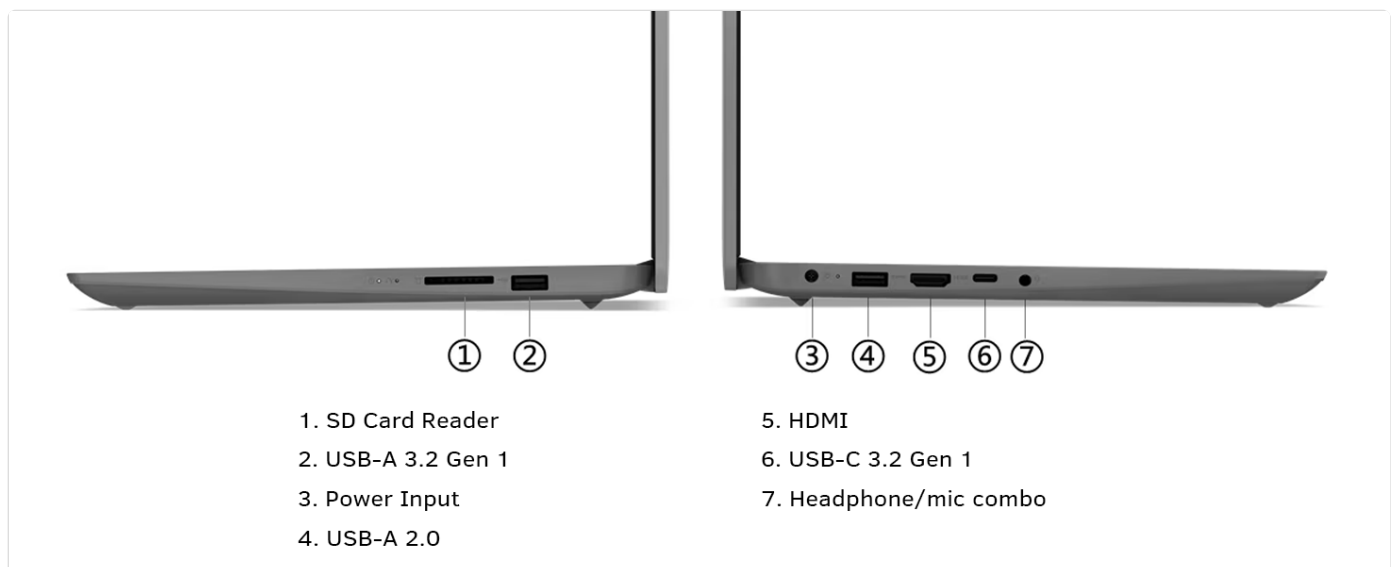


Image: Detailed diagram illustrating the location and type of ports on the Lenovo IdeaPad 1.

### Webcam Privacy Shutter

The IdeaPad 1 includes a physical privacy shutter for the 720p webcam. To activate or deactivate the camera, simply slide the shutter located above the webcam lens. This ensures your privacy, especially during and after video calls.

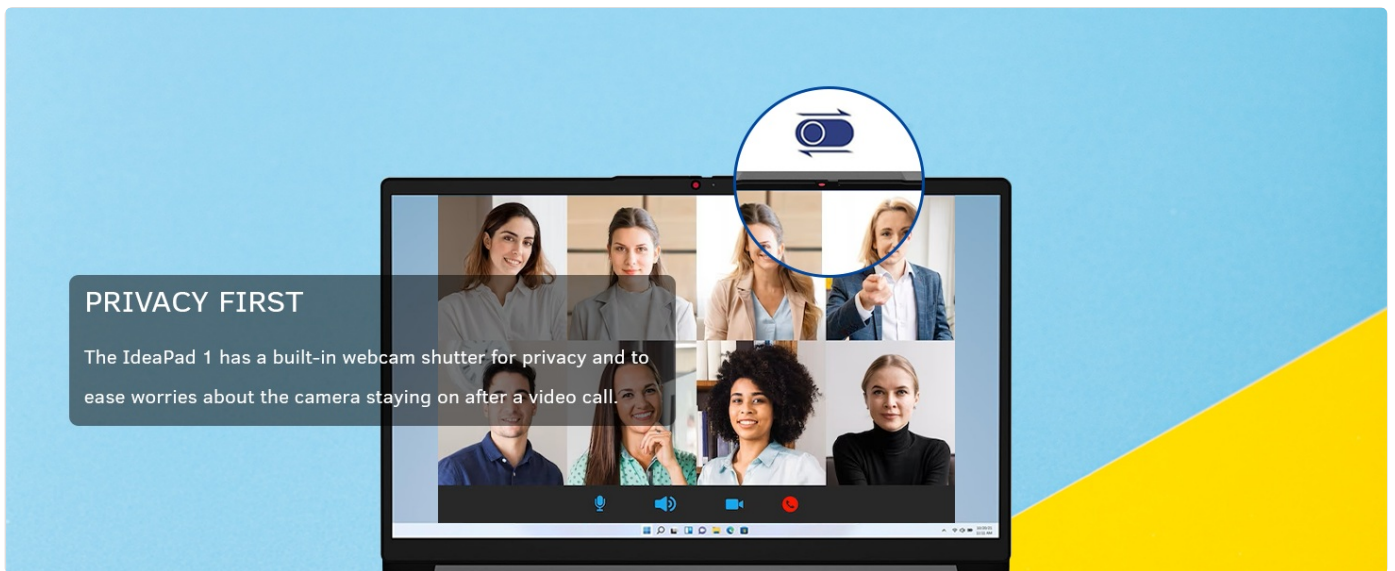


Image: Visual representation of the webcam privacy shutter on the IdeaPad 1.

Enjoy rich and clear sound with the integrated Dolby Audio speakers. These speakers enhance your listening experience for movies, music, and games.

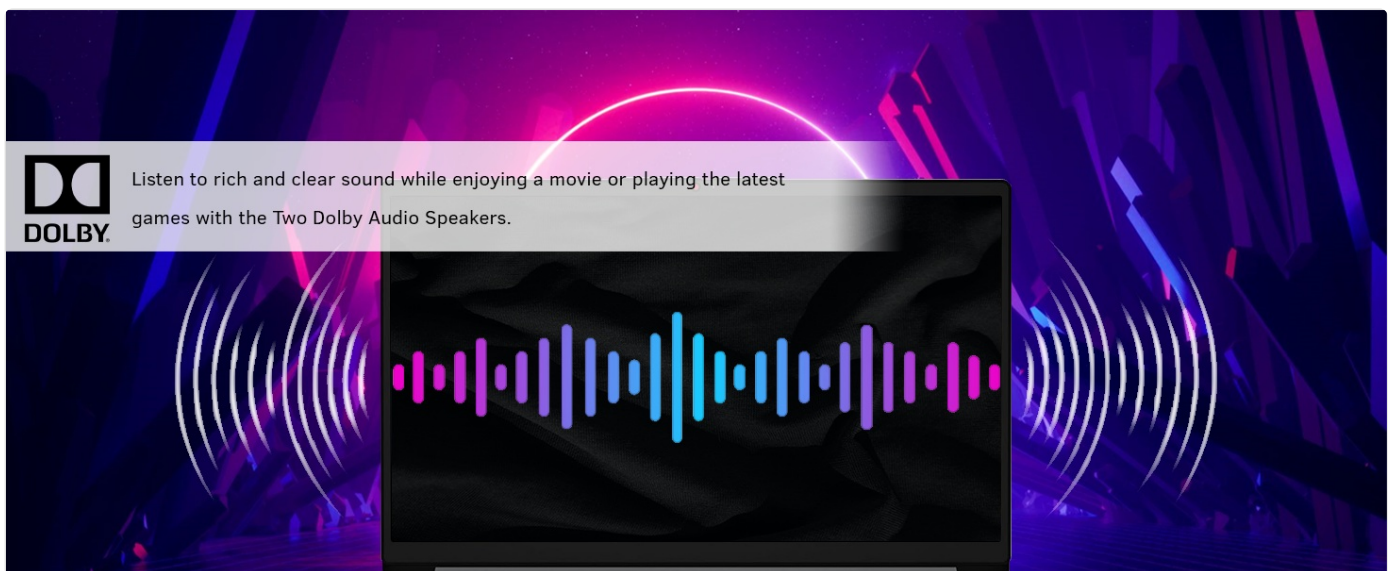


Image: Graphic highlighting the Dolby Audio sound system of the IdeaPad 1.

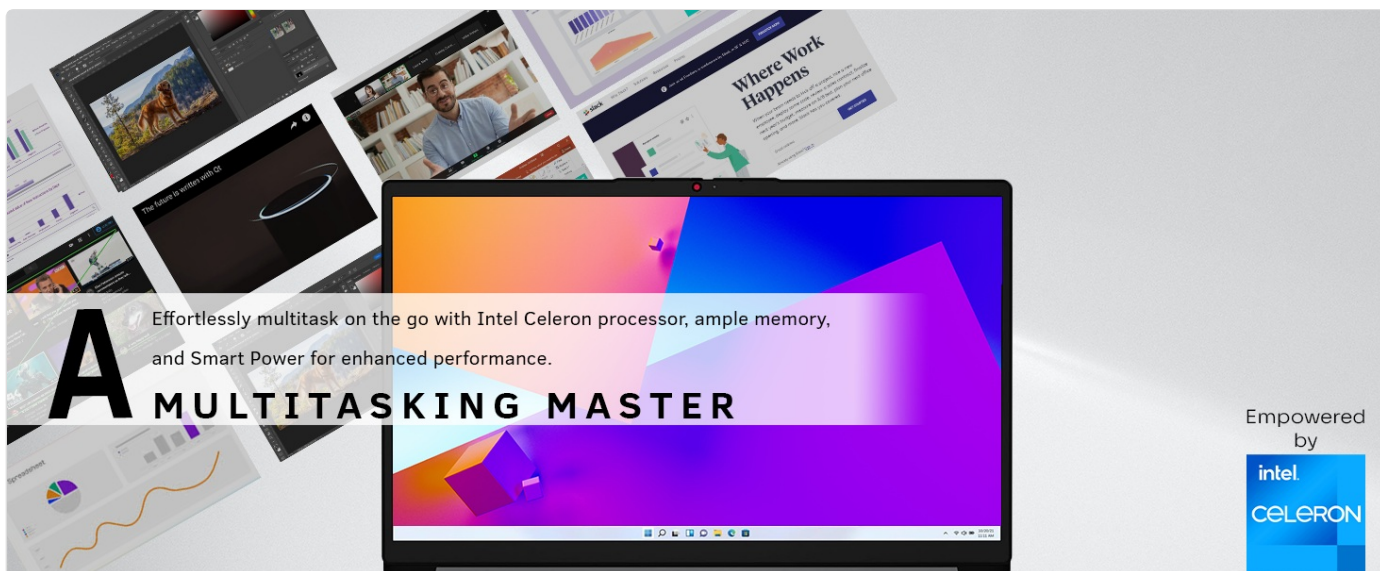


Image: Depiction of the IdeaPad 1 as a multitasking master, powered by Intel Celeron.

## MAINTENANCE

### Cleaning Your Laptop

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a screen cleaner to wipe the display.
- For the keyboard and chassis, use a soft, dry cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- Regularly clean dust from vents to ensure proper airflow and prevent overheating.

### Battery Care

- To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently.
- Store the laptop in a cool, dry place when not in use for extended periods.
- The laptop supports rapid charge, allowing for 2 hours of battery life from just 15 minutes of charging.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

### Common Issues and Solutions

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Laptop does not power on	Low battery, power adapter issue	Ensure power adapter is securely connected and wall outlet is functional. Allow to charge for at least 30 minutes before attempting to power on again.
Slow performance	Too many applications open, insufficient RAM, background processes	Close unnecessary applications and browser tabs. Check Task Manager for resource-intensive processes. Ensure Windows is up to date.
Wi-Fi connectivity issues	Incorrect password, router issues, driver problems	Verify Wi-Fi password. Restart your router and modem. Update Wi-Fi drivers via Device Manager.
Webcam not working	Privacy shutter closed, driver issues, application permissions	Ensure the physical privacy shutter is open. Check camera permissions in Windows settings. Update webcam drivers.
