## INTRODUCTION

---

Thank you for choosing the Silonn Smart Countertop Ice Maker. This compact and efficient appliance is designed to provide you with fresh ice quickly and conveniently, featuring Wi-Fi connectivity for app control and self-cleaning capabilities. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating your ice maker to ensure safe and optimal performance.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

---

- Always plug the ice maker into a grounded electrical outlet.
- Do not immerse the appliance, power cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Unplug the ice maker before cleaning or when not in use.
- Keep the ice maker away from heat sources and direct sunlight.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the unit.
- Use only purified or distilled water for ice production to maintain hygiene and prolong appliance life.

## WHAT'S IN THE BOX

---

Upon unpacking, please ensure all items are present and in good condition:

- Silonn Smart Countertop Ice Maker
- Ice Scoop
- Ice Basket

## SETUP

---

1. Unpack the ice maker and remove all packaging materials.
2. Place the ice maker on a stable, level surface, away from direct sunlight and heat sources. Ensure there is adequate space around the unit for ventilation.
3. Clean the interior of the ice maker and the ice basket with a soft cloth and mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly and dry.
4. Fill the water reservoir with purified or distilled water up to the MAX fill line.
5. Insert the ice basket into its designated position.
6. Plug the ice maker into a grounded electrical outlet.

## OPERATION

---

### Initial Ice Production

After setup, press the POWER button to turn on the ice maker. The unit will begin its ice-making cycle. The first few batches of ice may be smaller or irregular; discard these as they are part of the priming process.

The Silonn ice maker produces 9 ice cubes in just 6 minutes, with a total capacity of 26 lbs per day from its 2L water tank.

## App Control (Wi-Fi)

The Silonn Smart Countertop Ice Maker can be controlled via the Silonn mobile app. Download the app from your device's app store or the official Silonn website. Follow the in-app instructions to connect your ice maker to your Wi-Fi network.

- Start or stop ice production remotely.
- Adjust ice cube size (Small or Large).
- Receive notifications for "Add Water" or "Ice Full" status.

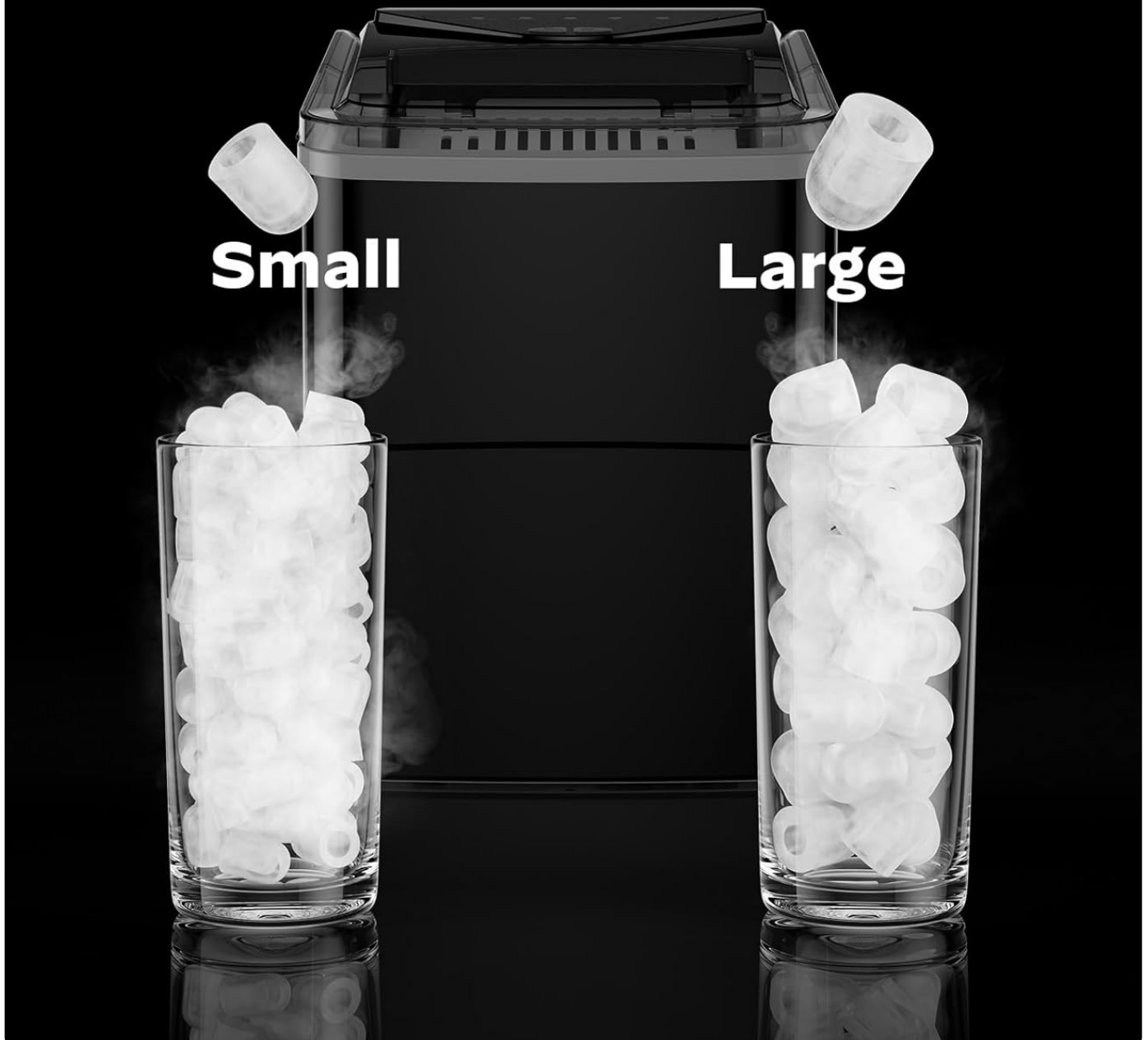

## Ice Cube Sizes

The ice maker offers two ice cube sizes: Small and Large. Use the "SELECT" button on the control panel or the app to toggle between sizes based on your preference.

# 2 Bullet Ice Sizes



Choose between small or large bullet-shaped ice cubes to suit your beverage needs.

## Timer Function

Utilize the timer function for scheduled ice production. This feature allows you to set a desired run time for the ice maker to operate before automatically shutting down, or to schedule a specific time for it to turn on.

The timer function allows for flexible scheduling of ice production, whether setting a run time or a delayed start.

## MAINTENANCE

---

### Automatic Self-Cleaning

The Silonn ice maker features an automatic self-cleaning cycle that takes approximately 30 minutes. To initiate:

1. Remove the ice basket.
2. Add water to the reservoir.
3. Press and hold the "CLEAN" button for 5 seconds.
4. Once the cycle is complete, drain the water over a sink.

# Automatic Cleaning



The automatic cleaning function ensures the internal components remain hygienic with minimal effort.

## General Cleaning

Regularly wipe down the exterior of the ice maker with a soft, damp cloth. For the interior, after draining, wipe surfaces with a clean cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice maker not producing ice.	No water in reservoir; power issue; ambient temperature too high.	Add water; check power connection; ensure unit is in a cool environment.
"Add Water" indicator is on.	Water reservoir is empty or low.	Refill the water reservoir with purified or distilled water.
"Ice Full" indicator is on.	Ice basket is full.	Remove ice from the basket.
Ice cubes are small or clumpy.	Water temperature too high; air bubbles in water; unit needs cleaning.	Use colder water; run self-cleaning cycle.
