BELLA Pro Series 8-Cup Pour Over Coffee Maker User Manual

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

1. Read all instructions before operating the coffee maker.
2. Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
3. To protect against fire, electric shock, and injury to persons, do not immerse cord, plugs, or the appliance in water or other liquid.
4. Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
5. Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
6. Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions, or has been damaged in any manner. Return appliance to the nearest authorized service facility for examination, repair, or adjustment.
7. The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may result in fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
8. Do not use outdoors.
9. Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
10. Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
11. Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to 'off', then remove plug from wall outlet.
12. Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
13. Scalding may occur if the lid is removed during the brewing cycle.
14. This appliance is for household use only.

COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the parts of your BELLA Pro Series Pour Over Coffee Maker:

- Water Reservoir with Lid
- Brew Head
- Filter Cone (removable)
- Glass Carafe with Lid
- Measuring Scoop
- Heating Plate / Base
- Brew/Off Button

SETUP

Before first use, follow these steps to prepare your coffee maker:

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all packaging materials and labels from the coffee maker.
2. **Clean Components:** Wash the glass carafe, its lid, and the filter cone in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry. The water reservoir can be wiped clean with a damp cloth.
3. **First Brew Cycle (Cleaning):** Fill the water reservoir to the MAX line with fresh, cold water. Do not add coffee grounds. Place the empty filter cone and carafe in their positions. Plug the coffee maker into a standard electrical outlet. Press the BREW/OFF button to start a brewing cycle. Allow the full cycle to complete. Discard the water from the carafe. This process cleans the internal components and removes any manufacturing residues.
4. **Repeat:** For optimal cleanliness, you may repeat the first brew cycle once more with fresh water.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to brew a perfect cup of coffee:

1. **Fill Water Reservoir:** Open the lid of the water reservoir and fill it with fresh, cold water up to the desired level indicated by the markings. Do not exceed the MAX fill line.
2. **Add Coffee Grounds:** Place the filter cone into its designated spot. Add your preferred amount of medium-ground coffee into the filter cone. For best results, use approximately one level scoop (provided) of coffee per cup. The BELLA Pro Series Pour Over Coffee Maker is designed for #4 cone filters if you prefer to use paper filters, though it includes a reusable filter.
3. **Position Carafe:** Ensure the glass carafe with its lid is properly placed on the heating plate beneath the brew head.
4. **Start Brewing:** Plug the coffee maker into a standard electrical outlet. Press the BREW/OFF button. The indicator light will illuminate, signaling that the brewing process has begun.

5. **Brewing Process:** The coffee maker will heat the water and dispense it over the coffee grounds in a controlled pour-over method.
6. **Serving:** Once the brewing cycle is complete, the coffee maker will automatically switch to a 'keep warm' function.

Carefully remove the carafe from the heating plate to pour and serve your coffee.

7. **Turn Off:** After serving, press the BREW/OFF button again to turn off the coffee maker and unplug it from the outlet.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and longevity of your coffee maker:

- **Daily Cleaning:** After each use, discard used coffee grounds and rinse the filter cone and glass carafe with warm water. These parts can also be washed in the top rack of a dishwasher.
- **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the coffee maker and the heating plate with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads.
- **Descaling (Monthly or Bi-Monthly):** Mineral deposits from water can build up over time and affect performance. To descale:

- Fill the water reservoir with a mixture of 1 part white vinegar and 2 parts cold water.
- Place the empty filter cone and carafe in position.
- Run a full brewing cycle with the vinegar solution.
- After the cycle, discard the solution and rinse the carafe and filter cone.
- Run 2-3 cycles with fresh, cold water only to flush out any remaining vinegar taste.
- **Storage:** Ensure the coffee maker is clean and dry before storing. Store in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your coffee maker, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Coffee does not brew.	Coffee maker not plugged in; BREW/OFF button not pressed; water reservoir empty.	Ensure unit is plugged in. Press BREW/OFF button. Fill water reservoir.
Coffee is too weak.	Not enough coffee grounds; grounds too coarse; too much water.	Add more coffee grounds. Use medium-ground coffee. Adjust water level.
Coffee overflows from filter cone.	Too many coffee grounds; filter cone clogged; carafe not properly placed.	Reduce coffee grounds. Clean filter cone. Ensure carafe is correctly positioned.
Brewing is slow.	Mineral buildup in the system.	Perform a descaling cycle as described in the Maintenance section.
