SETUP GUIDE

- 1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the ladder from its packaging.
- 2. **Unfolding:** Place the ladder on a flat, stable surface. Hold the top handle and gently pull the front and back legs apart until the ladder is fully extended and the locking mechanisms engage. You should hear a click indicating it's securely locked.
- 3. **Tool Tray Attachment (Optional):** If desired, attach the tool tray to the designated slots on the top step. Ensure it is firmly seated.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. **Placement:** Position the ladder on a firm, level, and non-slippery surface. Ensure there are no obstructions around the base or top.
- 2. **Ascending:** Face the ladder and use the handrail for support. Step onto the pedals one at a time, ensuring your feet are centered and fully on the anti-slip surface.
- 3. **Working:** Maintain three points of contact (two feet and one hand, or two hands and one foot) whenever possible. Do not overreach; reposition the ladder as needed.
- 4. Descending: Face the ladder and descend carefully, using the handrail for support.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

• Cleaning: Wipe down the ladder with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Avoid abrasive cleaners.

- **Storage:** After use, fold the ladder and store it in a dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Its compact design allows for storage in narrow spaces.

Troubleshooting

Ladder feels wobbly:

- Ensure the ladder is fully unfolded and locked.
- Check that all four rubber feet are firmly on a flat, level surface. Adjust placement if necessary.
- Inspect rubber feet for wear or damage; replace if needed.

Difficulty folding/unfolding:

- Ensure no debris is obstructing the hinges or locking mechanisms.
- Apply a small amount of silicone lubricant to moving parts if stiffness persists.
