1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Tefal GC774D OptiGrill 4-in-1 Contact Grill. This appliance is designed to provide versatile cooking options, functioning as a smart grill, barbecue, oven, and full meal device. Its patented technology measures food thickness and adjusts cooking time automatically for optimal results. This manual provides essential information for safe and efficient use of your appliance. Please read it thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always observe the following safety precautions when using electrical appliances:

- Read all instructions carefully before use.
- Do not immerse the appliance, power cord, or plug in water or any other liquid.
- Ensure the voltage indicated on the appliance corresponds to your mains voltage.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.

- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- This appliance is for household use only.
- The cooking plates and the appliance's metal parts become very hot during use. Always use oven mitts or gloves when handling hot surfaces.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Tefal GC774D OptiGrill 4-in-1 is a versatile cooking appliance designed for various culinary tasks.

Key Components:

- **Main Unit:** The core appliance housing the heating elements and control panel.
- **Cooking Plates:** Removable, non-stick plates for grilling.
- **Drip Tray:** Collects excess fat and juices during cooking.
- **Control Panel:** Features power button, automatic programs, manual mode, and cooking level indicator.
- **Baking Tray (included):** For oven and full meal functions.

4. SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the appliance and all accessories from the packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or transport if needed.
2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wash the cooking plates and drip tray with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely. Wipe the exterior of the appliance with a damp cloth.
3. **Placement:** Place the grill on a stable, flat, heat-resistant surface, away from water sources and flammable materials. Ensure adequate ventilation around the appliance.
4. **Install Drip Tray:** Slide the drip tray into its designated slot at the front of the appliance.
5. **Connect Power:** Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet. The appliance will emit a sound, and the power button will illuminate.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The OptiGrill GC774D features intelligent technology to ensure perfect cooking results.

5.1. Intelligent Grilling Technology

The patented OptiGrill technology automatically measures the thickness of your food (meat, fish, vegetables) and considers the number of items placed on the grill. It then adjusts the cooking time and temperature to achieve your desired doneness, from rare to well-done.

5.2. Automatic Programs

The appliance includes 9 automatic cooking programs for various food types. These programs simplify the cooking process by pre-setting optimal temperatures and times.

- **Preheating:** Press the power button, then select your desired program. Press OK to start preheating. The indicator light will flash purple.
- **Cooking Indicator:** The color indicator ring on the control panel changes color to show the cooking progress:
 - **Blue/Green:** Preheating
 - **Yellow:** Rare
 - **Orange:** Medium
 - **Red:** Well-done
- **Adding Food:** Once preheating is complete (indicator is solid green), place your food on the grill plates. Close the lid.
- **Monitoring:** Follow the color indicator. Remove food when it reaches your preferred doneness.

5.3. Manual Mode

For foods not covered by automatic programs or for specific preferences, use manual mode.

1. Turn on the appliance.
2. Select the manual mode button (usually marked 'M').
3. Adjust the temperature setting if available (refer to specific model instructions for temperature control in manual mode).
4. Preheat the grill. Once ready, place food on the plates and monitor cooking manually.

5.4. 4-in-1 Functions (Grill, Barbecue, Oven, Full Meal)

The OptiGrill GC774D offers enhanced versatility beyond standard grilling.

- **Grill:** Use the contact grill function for perfectly seared meats, fish, and vegetables with automatic thickness detection.
- **Barbecue:** Open the grill completely to use it as an open barbecue, ideal for cooking larger quantities or different types of food simultaneously.
- **Oven:** Utilize the included baking tray for oven-style cooking, such as baking casseroles, gratins, or reheating dishes. Place the baking tray on the lower grill plate and close the lid.
- **Full Meal:** Combine grilling with the baking tray to prepare a complete meal, such as grilling meat on one side and cooking vegetables or a side dish in the tray.

6. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your OptiGrill.

1. **Unplug and Cool:** Always unplug the appliance from the power outlet and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
2. **Remove Drip Tray:** Empty and clean the drip tray after each use. It is dishwasher-safe.
3. **Remove Cooking Plates:** Detach the cooking plates by pressing the release buttons. The non-stick cooking plates are dishwasher-safe. For stubborn residue, soak them in warm, soapy water before cleaning.
4. **Clean Main Unit:** Wipe the exterior of the main unit with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads. Never immerse the main unit in water.
5. **Reassemble:** Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembling and storing the appliance.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your OptiGrill, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not turn on.	Not plugged in or power outlet issue.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check the circuit breaker.
Food is not cooking evenly.	Plates not properly installed or food unevenly distributed.	Ensure cooking plates are correctly locked into place. Distribute food evenly on the plates.
Smoke or unusual odor during first use.	Protective coating burning off.	This is normal for first use. Ensure good ventilation. If it persists, contact customer service.
Indicator light not changing color.	Sensor malfunction or incorrect program selection.	Ensure the correct automatic program is selected. If the issue persists, contact customer service.
