1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the XODO VD2 Wireless Video Doorbell. This device provides enhanced home security and convenience with its advanced features, including high-definition video, motion detection, and two-way communication. Please read this manual carefully to ensure proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your new video doorbell.

2. PRODUCT FEATURES

- 2K FHD Camera & Night Vision: Upgraded 2K resolution for crystal-clear images and video. Built-in lights automatically switch to night vision mode for clear visibility in darkness.
- PIR Motion Detection & Two-Way Audio: Integrated PIR motion sensor sends instant alerts upon motion detection. Microphone and speaker enable real-time two-way audio communication with visitors.
- **IP65 Weatherproof & 2.4G Wi-Fi:** Designed to withstand extreme weather conditions (-4°F to 122°F). Features a built-in 4800mAh rechargeable battery for up to 180 days of standby time. Stable 2.4GHz Wi-Fi connection ensures reliable operation.
- Free Local Storage & Family Sharing: Supports up to 128GB Micro SD storage (not included) and offers a 7-day trial of the Subscription Plan (Cloud storage with 30-day free trial). Account sharing is available for up to 15 online users and 20 account users.
- 100% Wire-Free & Easy Installation: Simple setup in under 5 minutes due to its battery-powered design. Mounts easily with provided screws.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

- Wireless Chime (requires 3 AAA Batteries, not included)

- USB Cable (for charging)

4. SETUP GUIDE

4.1. Charging the Doorbell

Before first use, fully charge the doorbell using the provided USB cable. The indicator light will show charging status and turn off when fully charged.

4.2. Installing the MicroSD Card (Optional)

Insert a MicroSD card (up to 128GB, not included) into the designated slot for local video storage. Ensure the card is inserted correctly.

4.3. App Download and Setup

- 1. Download the **Xodo App** from the Google Play Store or Apple App Store.
- 2. Register for a new account or log in if you already have one.
- 3. Follow the in-app instructions to add your XODO VD2 doorbell. This typically involves scanning a QR code on the doorbell or manually entering its ID.
- 4. Ensure your mobile device is connected to a 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network during the pairing process.

4.4. Chime Setup

Insert 3 AAA batteries (not included) into the wireless chime. The chime will automatically pair with the doorbell once both are powered on and within range. You can place the chime in various locations within your home, such as the living room, kitchen, or bedroom.

4.5. Physical Installation

- 1. Choose a suitable location near your front door, ensuring good Wi-Fi signal strength.
- 2. Mount the bracket to the wall using the provided screws and wall anchors.
- 3. Slide the doorbell onto the mounted bracket until it clicks securely into place.


5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Live View and Two-Way Audio

Open the Xodo App on your smartphone to access the live video feed from your doorbell. Tap the microphone icon to initiate two-way audio communication with visitors at your door.

5.2. Motion Detection Alerts

The built-in PIR motion sensor will detect human movement and send instant notifications to your Xodo App. You can adjust motion sensitivity settings within the app to minimize false alerts.




Image 8: A visual representation of the PIR detection zone extending from the doorbell, highlighting its ability to detect human presence from 10-30 feet.

5.3. Night Vision

The doorbell automatically switches to night vision mode in low-light conditions, providing clear black-and-white video footage. This ensures continuous monitoring day and night.

5.4. Video Playback and Storage

Recorded videos can be accessed and played back through the Xodo App. If a MicroSD card is installed, recordings are stored locally. Cloud storage options are also available with a free trial period.

5.5. Family Sharing

Share access to your doorbell's live feed and features with family members through the Xodo App. This allows multiple users to monitor and interact with the doorbell.

6. MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Wipe the doorbell's lens and body with a soft, damp cloth to remove dust and smudges. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Battery Life:** Monitor the battery level via the Xodo App. Recharge the doorbell when the battery is low to ensure continuous operation.
- **Firmware Updates:** Regularly check the Xodo App for available firmware updates to ensure optimal performance and access to new features.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Doorbell not connecting to Wi-Fi	Incorrect Wi-Fi password, 5GHz network, weak signal	Ensure correct 2.4GHz Wi-Fi, check signal strength, restart router/doorbell.
No motion detection alerts	PIR sensitivity too low, incorrect settings	Adjust PIR sensitivity in the app, ensure motion detection is enabled.
Poor video quality	Weak Wi-Fi signal, dirty lens	Improve Wi-Fi signal, clean the camera lens.
Chime not ringing	Low chime batteries, out of range	Replace AAA batteries in chime, move chime closer to doorbell.
