INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the world of Tech Deck! This manual provides essential information for assembling, operating, and maintaining your Tech Deck Competition Wall 2.0 X-Connect Park Creator. This customizable ramp set allows you to design and build your own mini skateboard park for fingerboard tricks. Please read these instructions carefully before use.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

- 1 Large Roll-in Ramp
- 1 Roll-in Ramp
- 1 Triangle Ramp

- 2 Scaffold Beams
- 1 Coping
- 2 Small Supports
- 3 Large X-Connectors
- 11 X-Connectors
- 12 Foot Pegs

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

The X-Connect Park Creator system allows for flexible assembly. Follow these steps to build your custom park:

1. **Identify Components:** Familiarize yourself with the different ramps, panels, rails, and connectors as shown in the 'What's in the Box' section.
2. **Connect Base Panels:** Use the X-Connectors to link the main panels together. These connectors slide into designated slots on the edges of the panels.
3. **Attach Ramps and Obstacles:** Secure the vert ramps, wedge ramp, triangle ramp, and small box to the base panels using the appropriate X-Connectors. Ensure they are firmly clicked into place.
4. **Install Rails and Coping:** Attach the rail and coping pieces to the designated slots on the ramps or panels. The scaffold beams can be used to create elevated sections or supports.
5. **Customize Your Layout:** Experiment with different arrangements of the ramps and obstacles. The X-Connect system allows for various configurations to create unique skate park designs.
6. **Secure with Foot Pegs:** Use the foot pegs to provide additional stability to your assembled park,

especially for larger or more complex setups.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once your Tech Deck park is assembled, you are ready to perform fingerboard tricks:

- **Fingerboard Placement:** Place your Tech Deck fingerboard on the ramps or flat surfaces of the park.
- **Basic Movement:** Use your fingers to push and steer the fingerboard across the park. Practice rolling up and down ramps.
- **Grinding and Sliding:** Utilize the rail and coping to perform grinds and slides. Position the fingerboard's trucks or deck edge onto the obstacle and slide along.
- **Carving:** Use the curved surfaces of the ramps to carve and gain momentum, simulating real skateboarding movements.
- **Stalling:** Practice stalling by balancing your fingerboard on the edge of a ramp or coping.
- **Experiment:** The park is designed for creativity. Experiment with different lines, speeds, and trick combinations to master your fingerboarding skills.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity of your Tech Deck Competition Wall 2.0 X-Connect Park Creator, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the plastic components with a soft, damp cloth to remove dust and dirt. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store the park and its components in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures when not in use.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all X-Connectors and components for any signs of wear or damage. Replace any broken parts if necessary (replacement parts may not be available).

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues during assembly or use, consider the following:

- **Components Not Connecting:** Ensure that the X-Connectors are aligned correctly with the slots on the ramps and panels. Apply firm, even pressure until you hear a click.
- **Park Instability:** Double-check that all X-Connectors are fully engaged. Utilize the foot pegs provided to enhance stability, especially on uneven surfaces.

- **Missing Parts:** Refer to the 'What's in the Box' list. If a part is genuinely missing, contact customer support.
