Bluey 8.5" Fly Wheels Junior Cruiser Tricycle Instruction Manual

1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and use. Failure to follow these safety guidelines may result in serious injury.

- **Adult Assembly Required:** This product contains small parts prior to assembly and requires adult assembly.
- **Adult Supervision Required:** Always supervise children while they are using the tricycle.
- **Helmet Use:** Always ensure your child wears a properly fitted helmet (not included) when riding the tricycle.
- **Age and Weight Limits:** This tricycle is designed for children aged 18 to 36 months, weighing up to 35 lbs (15.9 kg), and between 33 to 35 inches (84-89 cm) tall. Do not exceed these limits.
- **Choking Hazard:** Small parts are present before assembly. Keep un-assembled parts away from children under 3 years of age.
- **Riding Surface:** Use on flat, level surfaces free of obstacles, traffic, and steep inclines. Avoid riding near streets, swimming pools, or other hazards.
- **Footwear:** Children should wear closed-toe shoes while riding.

2. PARTS LIST

Ensure all components are present before beginning assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly and contact customer support.

- Tricycle Frame
- Front Wheel with Pedals (8.5 inch)
- Rear Wheels (2)
- Handlebars
- Sticker Sheet (Bluey themed)
- Hardware Pack (nuts, bolts, washers)

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Adult assembly is required. Please follow these general steps. Refer to the specific assembly instructions included in your product packaging for detailed diagrams and hardware usage.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and verify against the parts list.
2. **Attach Front Wheel:** Securely attach the front wheel assembly, including the pedals, to the main tricycle frame using the provided hardware. Ensure pedals rotate freely.
3. **Install Handlebars:** Insert the handlebars into the designated slot on the frame and tighten securely. Ensure they are aligned correctly and do not wobble.
4. **Attach Rear Wheels:** Mount the two rear wheels to the axle at the back of the frame, securing them with the appropriate hardware.
5. **Apply Stickers:** Customize your tricycle by applying the Bluey-themed stickers to the designated areas as desired.
6. **Final Check:** Before first use, double-check all nuts, bolts, and fasteners to ensure they are tight and secure. Ensure all moving parts operate smoothly.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Bluey Junior Cruiser Tricycle is designed for simple, pedal-powered operation, providing a stable and enjoyable riding experience for toddlers.

- **Riding Position:** Ensure the child is seated comfortably on the tricycle seat with their feet able to reach the pedals.
- **Pedaling:** Instruct the child to push down on the pedals in an alternating motion to propel the tricycle forward.
- **Steering:** The easy-grip ergonomic handlebars are designed for small hands. Guide the child to turn the handlebars left or right to steer the tricycle.
- **Stability:** The wide 8.5-inch front wheel and low center of gravity provide enhanced stability and control for smaller riders.
- **Braking:** The tricycle does not have a hand brake. Children stop by ceasing to pedal and placing their feet on the ground. Always ensure adequate space for stopping.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help ensure the longevity and safe operation of your Bluey Junior Cruiser Tricycle.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the tricycle clean with a damp cloth and mild soap as needed. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all nuts, bolts, and fasteners to ensure they are tight. Inspect the wheels, pedals, and handlebars for any signs of wear, damage, or loose connections.
- **Storage:** Store the tricycle indoors in a dry place when not in use to protect it from weather elements and prolong its lifespan.
- **Lubrication:** No lubrication is typically required for this type of tricycle.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your tricycle, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Tricycle feels unstable:** Ensure all assembly bolts are securely tightened. Verify the child's weight and height are within the recommended limits.
- **Difficulty pedaling:** Check for any obstructions around the pedals or wheels. Ensure the front wheel assembly is correctly installed and rotates freely.
- **Loose handlebars:** Re-tighten the handlebar fastening bolt. If the issue persists, inspect for damage.
- **Squeaking noises:** Inspect wheels and axles for any debris. A small amount of silicone spray (avoiding contact with child's skin) may be used on non-load-bearing plastic-on-plastic contact points if necessary, but generally not required.
