INTRODUCTION

The Peg Perego Gaucho PRO Realtree is an all-terrain 24-volt ride-on vehicle designed for children aged 6 and up. It features a rugged design, two-speed operation with reverse, extreme traction rubber wheels, and a working FM radio. This manual provides essential information for assembly, safe operation, and maintenance to ensure the longevity and performance of your vehicle.

SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Adult supervision is required at all times when the vehicle is in use.

- Always ensure children wear appropriate safety gear, including a helmet.
- Do not operate the vehicle near streets, motor vehicles, steep inclines, swimming pools, or other bodies of water.
- Ensure the vehicle is used on level ground or slight inclines only.
- The 2nd speed lockout feature should be engaged for beginners to prevent excessive speed.
- Regularly inspect the vehicle for any loose parts, damage, or wear before each use.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these general steps for assembly. Refer to the detailed diagrams in the printed manual for specific part identification and connection points.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and lay them out on a clean, flat surface.
2. **Wheel Assembly:** Attach the extreme traction rubber wheels to the axles as per the instructions, ensuring they are securely fastened.
3. **Steering Column and Dashboard:** Assemble the steering column and connect it to the rack and pinion steering mechanism. Install the dashboard components, including the FM radio.
4. **Seat Installation:** Secure the adjustable seats into position. Ensure the seat belts are properly installed and functional.
5. **Battery Connection:** Connect the 24-volt rechargeable battery. Ensure the battery is fully charged before first use (refer to charging instructions). The battery compartment is located under the hood.
6. **Final Checks:** Before operation, double-check all connections, screws, and safety features.




Image: Detailed view of the engine compartment, where the battery is housed, accessible by removing screws.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Familiarize yourself with the controls and features before operating the vehicle.

- **Power On/Off:** Use the designated start button on the dashboard to turn the vehicle on or off.
- **Speed Selection:** The vehicle features a 2-speed shifter. Speed 1 operates at approximately 3.5 mph, and Speed 2 operates at up to 7.5 mph. A reverse gear is also available.
- **2nd Speed Lockout:** For younger or less experienced drivers, engage the 2nd speed lockout feature to limit the vehicle to the lower speed.
- **Steering:** The rack and pinion steering provides easy and responsive control.
- **FM Radio:** The integrated FM radio allows for entertainment during rides. Tune to your preferred stations.
- **Headlights:** The vehicle is equipped with working headlights for enhanced visibility.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help prolong the life of your Peg Perego Gaucho PRO Realtree.

- **Battery Charging:** Always charge the 24-volt battery fully after each use. Do not overcharge. Store the battery in a cool, dry place.
- **Cleaning:** Clean the vehicle with a damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners. Do not hose down the vehicle.
- **Tire Inspection:** Periodically check the extreme traction rubber wheels for wear or damage.
- **General Inspection:** Regularly inspect all nuts, bolts, and screws to ensure they are tight. Check for any cracks or damage to the plastic body.
- **Storage:** Store the vehicle indoors in a dry area when not in use to protect it from the elements.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your vehicle, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vehicle does not move	Battery is not charged or connected; Thermal fuse tripped; Loose wire connection.	Charge battery; Allow vehicle to cool down; Check all electrical connections.
Vehicle runs slowly	Battery low; Overloaded vehicle; Operating on rough terrain.	Recharge battery; Reduce weight; Operate on smoother surfaces.
FM Radio not working	Not powered on; Out of range; Volume too low.	Ensure vehicle is on; Try different location; Increase volume.
