VEHICLE SETUP AND INITIAL FAMILIARIZATION

Upon acquiring your 2023 Dodge Charger, it is recommended to perform an initial setup and familiarization process. This includes adjusting seating positions, mirror settings, and understanding the basic controls before driving.

Key Fob and Ignition

- **Unlocking/Locking:** Press the unlock or lock button on the key fob.
- **Remote Start:** Press the remote start button twice within five seconds.
- **Starting the Engine:** With the key fob inside the vehicle, press the brake pedal and then the ENGINE START/STOP button.

Seat and Mirror Adjustment

1. Adjust the driver's seat for comfortable pedal and steering wheel access.
2. Adjust the interior rearview mirror to provide a clear view of the rear window.
3. Adjust the exterior side mirrors for optimal rearward visibility, minimizing blind spots.

OPERATING YOUR VEHICLE

This section covers the fundamental aspects of operating your 2023 Dodge Charger, including driving controls, transmission, and various driver assistance systems.

Transmission Operation

The 2023 Dodge Charger is equipped with an automatic transmission. Use the gear selector to choose between Park (P), Reverse (R), Neutral (N), and Drive (D). For manual gear selection, refer to the specific instructions for your vehicle's trim level.

Lighting Controls

The lighting control stalk, located on the left side of the steering column, operates the headlights, parking lights, and turn signals. Rotate the end of the stalk to select desired lighting mode. Push the stalk up or down for turn signals.

Your vehicle features a Uconnect infotainment system. Access navigation, audio, climate control, and vehicle settings via the touchscreen display. Consult the Uconnect supplement for detailed instructions on pairing Bluetooth devices and using advanced features.

VEHICLE MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance is crucial for the longevity and optimal performance of your 2023 Dodge Charger. Adhere to the recommended service schedule outlined in this manual.

Scheduled Maintenance

Recommended Service Intervals

Interval	Service Item
Every 10,000 miles or 12 months	Oil and filter change, tire rotation, inspect brakes, check fluid levels.
Every 20,000 miles or 24 months	Inspect suspension, exhaust system, and drive shafts.
Every 30,000 miles or 36 months	Replace engine air filter, cabin air filter, inspect spark plugs.

Note: These are general guidelines. Always refer to the detailed maintenance schedule specific to your vehicle's engine and driving conditions found within this manual.

TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

This section provides guidance on addressing common operational issues you might encounter with your 2023 Dodge Charger. For more complex problems, consult a certified service technician.

Engine Will Not Start

- **Check Battery:** Ensure battery terminals are clean and tight. If the battery is dead, jump-start the vehicle according

to instructions in this manual.

- **Check Fuel Level:** Verify there is sufficient fuel in the tank.
- **Key Fob:** Ensure the key fob is inside the vehicle and its battery is not depleted.

Warning Lights Illuminated

If a warning light illuminates on your instrument cluster, refer to the "Warning Lights and Indicators" section of this manual for specific details and recommended actions. Do not ignore warning lights, as they often indicate a condition requiring immediate attention.
