1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions carefully before using the Oster Steam Iron GCSTBS6002. Retain this manual for future reference.

1.1 General Safety

- Always unplug the iron from the electrical outlet when filling with water, emptying, or when not in use.
- Do not leave the iron unattended while it is connected to a power source or on an ironing board.
- Keep the iron and its cord out of reach of children and pets.
- Do not operate the iron with a damaged cord or plug, or if the iron has been dropped or damaged. Contact customer service for repair.
- Use the iron only for its intended household use, as described in this manual.
- Never immerse the iron, cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Avoid touching hot metal parts, hot water, or steam to prevent burns.

1.2 Electrical Safety

- Ensure the voltage indicated on the iron matches your local power supply.
- Do not pull the cord to disconnect from the outlet; grasp the plug instead.
- Do not allow the cord to touch hot surfaces. Let the iron cool completely before storing.
- If an extension cord is necessary, use a cord with an amperage rating equal to or greater than the iron's rating.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Oster Steam Iron GCSTBS6002 is designed for efficient and convenient garment care. It features a non-

stick soleplate, powerful steam functions, and an anti-calcification system.

2.1 Components

1. **Water Tank:** Transparent reservoir for water. Capacity: 250ml.
2. **Water Fill Opening:** For adding water to the tank.
3. **Temperature Control Dial:** Adjusts heat settings for different fabric types.
4. **Steam Control Selector:** Manages steam output (dry, low steam, high steam).
5. **Spray Button:** Activates a fine mist for stubborn wrinkles.
6. **Steam Shot Button:** Delivers a powerful burst of steam (up to 80 grams/minute).
7. **Non-Stick Soleplate:** Designed for smooth gliding and even heat distribution.
8. **Precision Tip:** Allows access to difficult areas like collars and cuffs.
9. **360° Swivel Cord:** Flexible cord for ease of movement. Length: 2m.
10. **Anti-Calcification System:** Internal filter to reduce mineral buildup.

3. SETUP AND INITIAL USE

3.1 Before First Use

- Remove any labels, protective film, or stickers from the iron's soleplate.
- It is normal for a slight odor or smoke to occur during the first few minutes of use as manufacturing oils burn off. This is temporary.
- Test the iron on an old piece of fabric to ensure no residue is transferred.

3.2 Filling the Water Tank

1. Ensure the iron is unplugged from the electrical outlet.
2. Set the steam control to the 'Dry Ironing' position (no steam).
3. Hold the iron in a horizontal position.
4. Open the water fill opening cover.
5. Carefully pour tap water into the water tank up to the 'MAX' fill line. Do not overfill.
6. Close the water fill opening cover securely.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Temperature Selection

1. Plug the iron into a suitable electrical outlet.
2. Turn the temperature control dial to the desired setting based on the fabric type. Refer to garment care labels.
3. Allow the iron to heat up. The indicator light will turn off when the selected temperature is reached.

4.2 Dry Ironing

- Set the steam control to the 'Dry Ironing' position.
- Select the appropriate temperature for your fabric.
- Once heated, iron the garment as usual.

4.3 Steam Ironing

- Ensure the water tank is filled.
- Set the temperature control dial to a steam-compatible setting (usually indicated on the dial).
- Once the iron is hot, adjust the steam control selector to the desired steam level (low or high).
- Iron the garment, moving the iron continuously.

4.4 Vertical Steam

- Fill the water tank and set the iron to a high temperature setting.
- Hold the iron vertically, a few inches away from the garment (e.g., hanging clothes, curtains).
- Press the Steam Shot button repeatedly to release bursts of steam.
- This function is ideal for removing wrinkles from hanging fabrics or refreshing upholstery.

4.5 Spray Function

- Press the Spray Button to emit a fine mist of water onto the fabric.
- This helps to dampen stubborn wrinkles for easier removal.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Soleplate

- Ensure the iron is unplugged and completely cool.
- Wipe the soleplate with a damp cloth and a non-abrasive cleaner.
- Do not use abrasive scouring pads or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the non-stick coating.

5.2 Cleaning the Anti-Calcification System

- The iron features an internal anti-calcification filter. While this reduces mineral buildup, occasional cleaning may be beneficial in hard water areas.
- Consult the manufacturer's website or customer support for specific descaling instructions if needed.

5.3 Storage

- After use, unplug the iron and empty any remaining water from the tank.
- Allow the iron to cool completely before storing.
- Store the iron upright on its heel rest to protect the soleplate.
- Wrap the cord loosely around the base or use the cord clip if provided.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer service, review the following common issues and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Iron does not heat up.	Not plugged in; power outlet fault; temperature dial set to 'OFF' or too low.	Check power connection; test outlet with another appliance; adjust temperature dial.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No steam or insufficient steam.	Water tank empty; temperature too low for steam; steam control set to 'Dry Ironing'; mineral buildup.	Fill water tank; increase temperature; set steam control to desired steam level; descale iron if necessary.
Water leaks from soleplate.	Temperature too low for steam; water tank overfilled; iron left horizontal too long when hot.	Increase temperature; do not overfill tank; store iron upright when not in use.
White flakes on clothes.	Mineral deposits from hard water.	Use distilled water; clean anti-calcification system or descale the iron.






