MERITLINE Kids House Bunk Bed with Slide - Twin Over Twin Instruction Manual

Model: G345AK

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the MERITLINE Kids House Bunk Bed with Slide. This twin over twin bunk bed is designed to provide a fun and functional sleeping and play area for children. Crafted from pine wood and MDF, it features a house-shaped design with a roof, windows, and an integrated slide and ladder. This manual provides essential information for safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new bunk bed.

Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and use to ensure proper installation and to prevent injury. Keep this manual for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Failure to follow these warnings and instructions could result in serious injury or death.

- Always use the recommended mattress size and thickness to prevent falls. For the upper bunk, the mattress should not exceed 6 inches in thickness. For the lower bunk, the mattress should be between 6-8 inches thick.
- Ensure all connections are tight before use. Periodically check and tighten all bolts and fasteners.
- The upper bunk is not suitable for children under 6 years of age.
- Prohibit more than one person on the upper bunk.
- Prohibit horseplay on or under the bed.
- Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the upper bunk.
- Do not attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed; for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts, and jump ropes.
- The maximum weight capacity for each bed is 400 lbs. Do not exceed this limit.
- Ensure the slide is properly secured and clear of obstructions before use.
- Full-length safety railings are provided on the upper bunk to prevent accidental falls. Do not remove them.
- Keep children away from the assembly area until assembly is complete.

Important: This product is intended for indoor use only. Do not modify the bed structure in any way.

3. COMPONENTS LIST

Before beginning assembly, ensure all parts are present and undamaged. Refer to the included installation manual for a detailed list of parts and hardware. The package includes:

- House Bunk Bed Frame (disassembled components)
- Slide
- Integrated Ladder
- All necessary assembly tools (e.g., Allen wrench)
- Fasteners and hardware
- Detailed Installation Manual

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly is required for this bunk bed. It is recommended that two adults assemble the bed. Please follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the separate Installation Manual included with your purchase. Ensure you have ample space for assembly and keep all small parts out of reach of children.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully unpack all boxes and lay out all parts on a clean, soft surface (e.g., carpet) to prevent scratches. Verify all parts against the components list in the Installation Manual.
2. **Assemble Frame:** Follow the numerical sequence in the Installation Manual to assemble the main bed frame, ensuring all bolts are finger-tightened initially.
3. **Attach Ladder and Slide:** Securely attach the integrated ladder and slide according to the manual. Ensure all connections are firm.
4. **Install Slats:** Place the bed slats onto the designated supports for both the upper and lower bunks.
5. **Final Tightening:** Once the entire structure is assembled, go back and securely tighten all bolts and fasteners using the provided tools. Do not overtighten.
6. **Placement:** Position the bunk bed against a wall to maximize stability and safety. Ensure there is adequate clearance around the slide.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This bunk bed is designed for sleeping and supervised play. Adhere to the following guidelines for safe operation:

- **Upper Bunk Access:** Always use the integrated ladder to access the upper bunk. Ensure hands and feet are clean and dry to prevent slipping.
- **Slide Use:** The slide is for single-person use only. Children should slide down feet first, in a seated position. Ensure the landing area is clear before sliding. Adult supervision is recommended during slide use.
- **Lower Bunk Use:** The lower bunk can accommodate a twin-size mattress. The space beneath the upper bunk can also be used as a play area or for storage if a mattress is not placed on the floor.
- **Weight Limits:** Do not exceed the 400 lbs weight limit for each bunk.
- **General Use:** Discourage jumping on the bed or rough play to maintain structural integrity and ensure safety.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will prolong the life and ensure the safety of your bunk bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that may damage the finish.
- **Fastener Checks:** Periodically (e.g., monthly) check all bolts, screws, and fasteners to ensure they are tight. Retighten as necessary. Loose fasteners can compromise the bed's stability and safety.

- **Structural Integrity:** Inspect the wood components for any signs of damage, cracks, or splinters. Address any issues immediately to prevent injury.
- **Slide Inspection:** Ensure the slide surface is smooth and free of damage. Keep the slide clean and dry.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your bunk bed, refer to the following common troubleshooting tips:

- **Bed feels wobbly:**
 - Ensure all bolts and fasteners are securely tightened.
 - Verify that the bed is placed on a flat, level surface.
 - Check that all components are correctly assembled according to the manual.
- **Squeaking noises:**
 - Tighten all bolts. Squeaking often indicates loose connections.
 - Ensure mattress slats are properly seated and not rubbing against the frame.
- **Missing parts:**

- Double-check all packaging materials. Small parts can sometimes be overlooked.
