INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your BIADNBZ L-Shaped Twin Over Full Bunk Bed with an attached loft bed, slide, and desk. Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and use to ensure proper function and safety.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Your safety is paramount. Failure to follow these warnings could result in serious injury.

- **Maximum Weight Capacity:** The upper bed and down bed each have a maximum weight capacity of 200 lbs. Do not exceed this limit.
- **Guardrails:** Always use the full-length guardrails on the upper bunk. Ensure they are properly installed and secured.
- **Ladder Use:** Always use the provided ladders for entering and exiting the upper bunks. Do not use chairs or other items.
- **Mattress Thickness:** The recommended mattress thickness for the upper bed is 6 inches. For the down bed, it is 8-10 inches. Using thicker mattresses may reduce the effectiveness of guardrails.
- **Age Recommendation:** The upper bunk is not suitable for children under 6 years of age.
- **Assembly:** Ensure all parts are correctly assembled and tightened before use. Periodically check and re-tighten all connections.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation around the bed.
- **No Horseplay:** Prohibit horseplay on or under the bed.
- **Lighting:** Provide adequate lighting near the ladder when using the upper bunk.
- **Slide Safety:** Ensure the slide is used properly and supervise children during use.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

This product requires assembly. It is recommended that two adults assemble this bed. Please ensure all parts are present before beginning assembly. The product ships in multiple boxes, which may arrive separately.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully unpack all components and hardware from the boxes. Verify against the parts list (not provided in this manual, refer to your product packaging).
2. **Prepare Area:** Clear a spacious area for assembly.
3. **Assemble Base Frames:** Begin by assembling the base frames for the twin and full beds according to the manufacturer's instructions.
4. **Attach Support Slats:** Install the wooden slats onto the bed frames. Ensure they are evenly spaced and securely fastened.
5. **Construct Loft Bed:** Assemble the loft bed frame, ensuring all connections are tight.
6. **Integrate L-Shape:** Connect the twin bunk bed, full bunk bed, and loft bed components to form the L-shaped configuration.
7. **Install Guardrails:** Securely attach all guardrails to the upper bunk and loft bed.
8. **Attach Ladders:** Install both ladders firmly to the designated positions.
9. **Assemble Desk:** Construct and attach the built-in desk underneath the loft bed.
10. **Install Slide:** Securely attach the slide to the loft bed.
11. **Final Check:** Once assembled, double-check all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they are tight and secure.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- **Sleeping:** The bed is designed to accommodate three individuals across the twin upper bunk, full lower bunk, and twin loft bed. Ensure mattresses meet the recommended thickness.
- **Ladder Access:** Use the integrated ladders to safely access the upper twin bunk and the loft bed. Always face the ladder when climbing up or down.
- **Desk Usage:** The built-in desk under the loft bed provides a dedicated space for studying, working, or other activities. Keep the desk clear of excessive weight.
- **Slide Usage:** The slide is intended for recreational use. Ensure the area around the slide exit is clear. Supervise children during slide use.

MAINTENANCE

- **Structural Integrity:** Check for any signs of damage, cracks, or wear on the wood or MDF components. Discontinue use if significant damage is found and contact the manufacturer.
- **Mattress Care:** Follow the care instructions provided with your mattresses.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Bed Feels Wobbly:**
 - Ensure all assembly bolts and screws are fully tightened.
 - Verify that the bed is placed on a level surface.
 - Check for any missing or damaged hardware.
- **Squeaking Noises:**
 - Re-tighten all hardware.
 - Ensure slats are properly seated and not rubbing against the frame.
 - Consider applying a small amount of lubricant (e.g., paraffin wax) to contact points if squeaking persists after tightening.
- **Missing Parts:**
 - Check all packaging thoroughly. This product ships in multiple boxes.
