### Device Ports and Indicators:

Magcubic logo should appear on the screen.

4. **Initial Setup Wizard:** Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup, which typically includes language selection, network connection (Wi-Fi or Ethernet), and Google account sign-in.
5. **Network Connection:**
  - **Wi-Fi:** Select your Wi-Fi network from the list, enter the password, and connect.
  - **Ethernet:** If you connected an Ethernet cable, the device should automatically detect the wired connection.
6. **Remote Control Pairing (if applicable):** Some remotes may require pairing. Follow any on-screen prompts or refer to the remote's specific instructions if it does not respond immediately.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING



Common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power/Device not turning on	Power adapter not connected or faulty; power outlet issue.	Check power connections. Try a different power outlet. Ensure the power adapter is working.
No display on TV	Incorrect HDMI input selected on TV; faulty HDMI cable; TV Box not powered on.	Ensure TV is on the correct HDMI input. Try a different HDMI cable or port. Verify the TV Box is powered on.
No Wi-Fi connection	Incorrect Wi-Fi password; router issues; device too far from router.	Double-check Wi-Fi password. Restart your router. Move the TV Box closer to the router or use an Ethernet cable.
Applications freezing or crashing	Insufficient memory; app compatibility issues; outdated software.	Close background applications. Clear app cache. Update the app or system software. Restart the device.
Remote control not responding	Low battery; remote not paired; obstruction.	Replace batteries. Re-pair the remote if necessary (refer to device settings). Ensure no obstructions between remote and TV Box.
