# FORLIGHT July Ceiling Fan with LED Light 19W User Manual

Model: July

## 1. INTRODUCTION

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This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your FORLIGHT July Ceiling Fan with LED Light. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and use to ensure safe and efficient operation. Keep this manual for future reference.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

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- Ensure the power supply is disconnected before installation, cleaning, or maintenance.
- Installation must be performed by a qualified electrician in accordance with local wiring regulations.
- The fan must be mounted to a structure capable of supporting its weight (approximately 6.6 kg).
- Maintain a minimum clearance of 2.3 meters (7.5 feet) from the floor to the fan blades.
- Do not insert objects into the fan blades while the fan is operating.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

## 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

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Verify that all components are present before beginning installation:

- Ceiling Fan Motor Assembly
- Fan Blades (3, wood effect finish)
- LED Light Kit
- Remote Control
- Mounting Bracket and Hardware
- Downrod

## 4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

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**Note:** Installation should be performed by a qualified professional.

1. **Prepare for Installation:** Turn off power at the main circuit breaker. Ensure the mounting location is secure and can support the fan's weight.
2. **Install Mounting Bracket:** Secure the mounting bracket to the ceiling junction box using the provided screws. Ensure it is firmly attached.
3. **Assemble Downrod and Motor:** Feed the electrical wires from the motor through the downrod. Attach the downrod to the motor assembly.
4. **Hang Fan Assembly:** Carefully lift the fan assembly and hang it on the mounting bracket hook.
5. **Wire the Fan:** Connect the electrical wires from the ceiling to the fan's wiring according to the wiring diagram provided in the separate wiring guide (if applicable) or standard electrical codes. Ensure all connections are secure.
6. **Attach Fan Blades:** Securely attach the three fan blades to the motor housing using the provided screws. Ensure all screws are tightened.
7. **Install LED Light Kit:** Connect the LED light kit wires to the fan motor assembly. Secure the light kit to the bottom of the fan.
8. **Final Check:** Double-check all connections and ensure no loose wires. Restore power at the circuit breaker.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

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The FORLIGHT July Ceiling Fan is operated using the included remote control.

### Remote Control Functions:

- **Power On/Off:** Press the power button to turn the fan and light on or off.
- **Fan Speed (1-6):** Use the numbered buttons (1 to 6) to select the desired fan speed. 1 is the lowest speed, 6 is the highest.
- **Light On/Off:** Press the light bulb icon button to turn the LED light on or off.
- **Light Temperature (3000K, 4200K, 6200K):** Press the button with the sun icon to cycle through the three

available light color temperatures: warm white (3000K), neutral white (4200K), and cool white (6200K).

- **Dimmable Light:** The light intensity can be adjusted. Refer to the remote control for specific dimming buttons (often indicated by up/down arrows or a dedicated dimming button).
- **Timer (1H, 2H, 4H, 8H):** Set the fan to turn off automatically after 1, 2, 4, or 8 hours.
- **Breeze Mode:** Activates a natural breeze effect by varying fan speeds.
- **Winter Mode (Reverse Rotation):** Press the reverse rotation button (often indicated by a circular arrow) to change the direction of the fan blades. In winter, this mode helps circulate warm air downwards, improving heating efficiency.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

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Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your ceiling fan.

- **Cleaning:** Disconnect power before cleaning. Use a soft, damp cloth to wipe down the fan blades and motor housing. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Blade Cleaning:** Dust the fan blades regularly to prevent dust buildup, which can affect balance and performance.
- **Tighten Screws:** Periodically check and tighten all screws on the fan blades and mounting hardware to

ensure secure operation.

- **Light Source:** The integrated LED light source is designed for long life and is generally not user-replaceable. If the light fails, contact customer support.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your FORLIGHT July Ceiling Fan, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan does not start	No power supply; Loose wiring; Remote control battery low.	Check circuit breaker; Verify wiring connections (power off first); Replace remote control batteries.
Light does not work	Loose wiring; LED light failure.	Check wiring connections (power off first); Contact customer support for LED light issues.
Fan wobbles	Loose blade screws; Unbalanced blades; Loose mounting bracket.	Tighten all blade screws; Ensure blades are balanced (balancing kit may be needed); Secure mounting bracket.
Remote control not responding	Low battery; Obstruction between remote and receiver.	Replace remote control batteries; Ensure clear line of sight to the fan's receiver.
Fan is noisy	Loose screws; Motor issue.	Check and tighten all screws; If noise persists, contact customer support.
