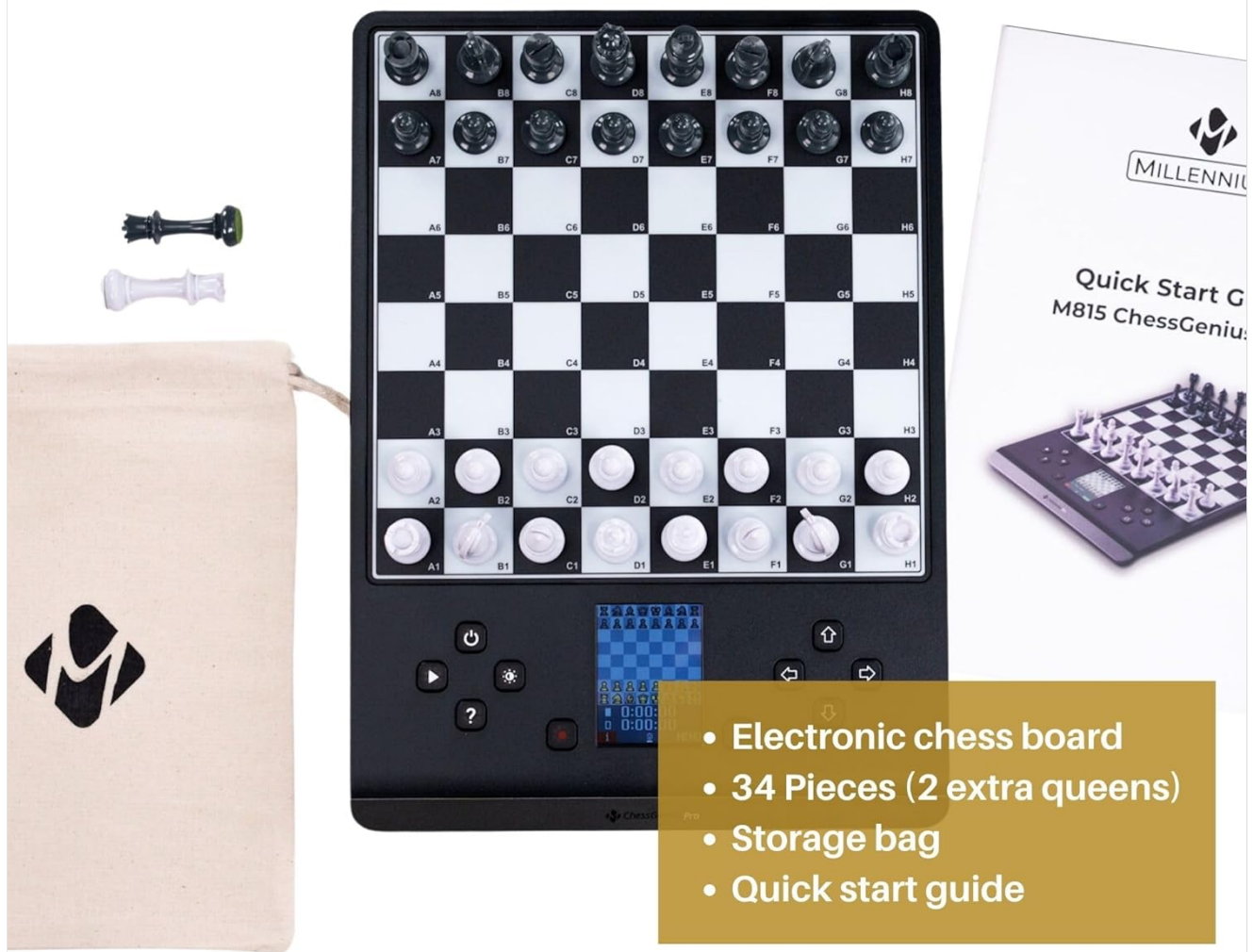

SETUP

Powering the Device

The ChessGenius PRO can be powered by batteries for portability or an optional AC adapter for continuous play.

Battery Installation

1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the chess board.
2. Open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert 4 x AA/LR06 batteries (not included), ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

Using an AC Adapter (Optional)

An optional AC adapter can be purchased separately for direct power from a wall outlet. Connect the adapter to the designated port on the device.

Placing the Chess Pieces

Place the magnetic chess pieces on their starting positions on the board. The magnetic base ensures pieces remain stable during play, even when moving the board.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Starting a Game

The intuitive menus and the dedicated PLAY button allow for quick game initiation. You can choose to play as White, Black, engage in a 2-player mode, or set up a game from a specific position.

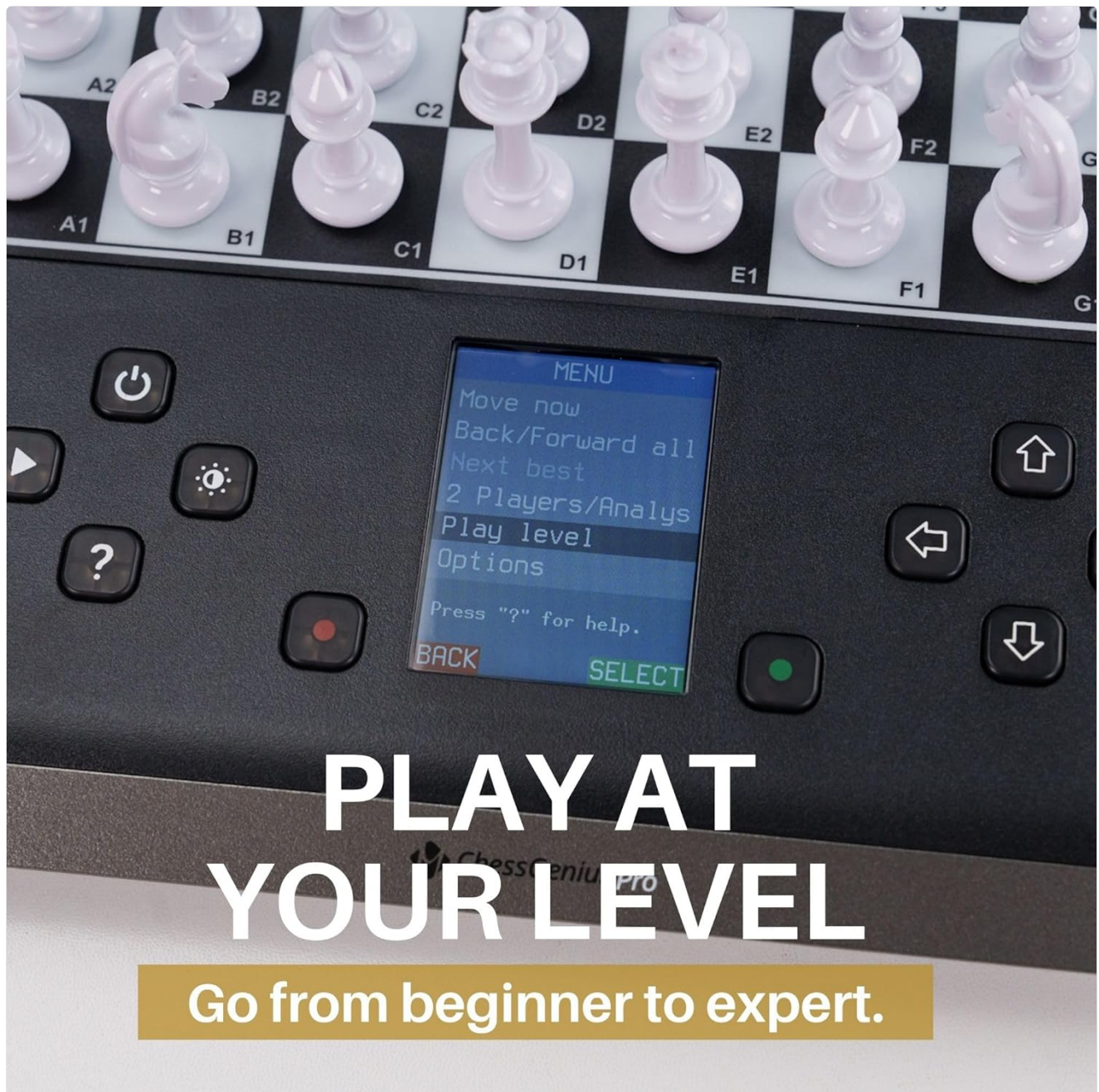


Figure 5: Intuitive controls. The ChessGenius PRO features an intuitive menu system and a dedicated PLAY button for easy game setup and navigation.

Understanding the Display

The integrated LCD color display shows your moves, the current board state, and provides visual cues for various functions.

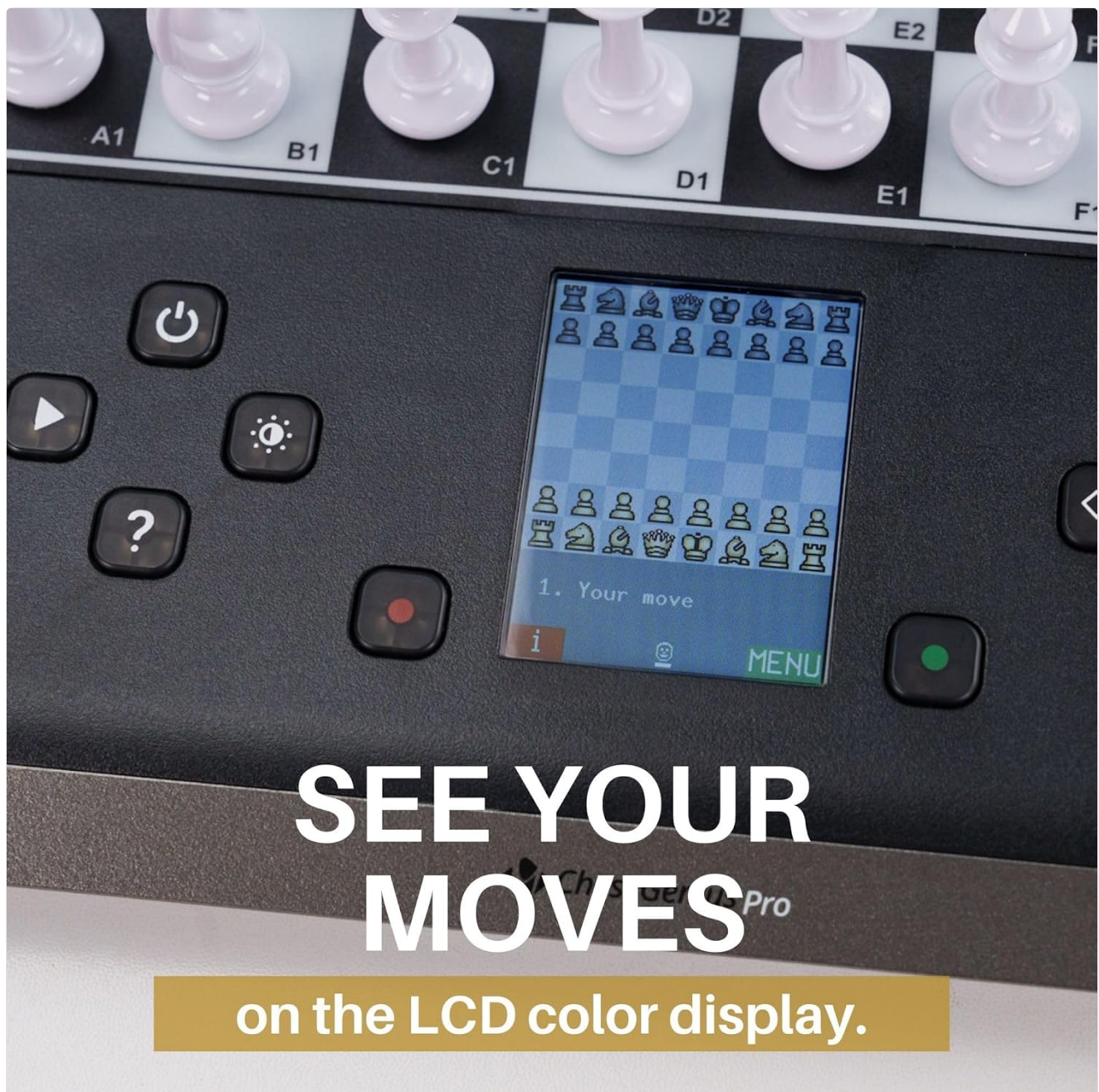


Figure 6: LCD color display. The display provides clear visual feedback on the game state and prompts for your next move.

Playing Against the Computer

The AI adapts to your playing level, offering a realistic training partner with a playing strength of up to 2200 ELO. You can adjust the difficulty to match your skill, from beginner to master.

Two-Player Mode

In two-player mode, the computer acts as an arbiter, ensuring adherence to chess rules. This is ideal for playing with a friend while still benefiting from the computer's rule enforcement.

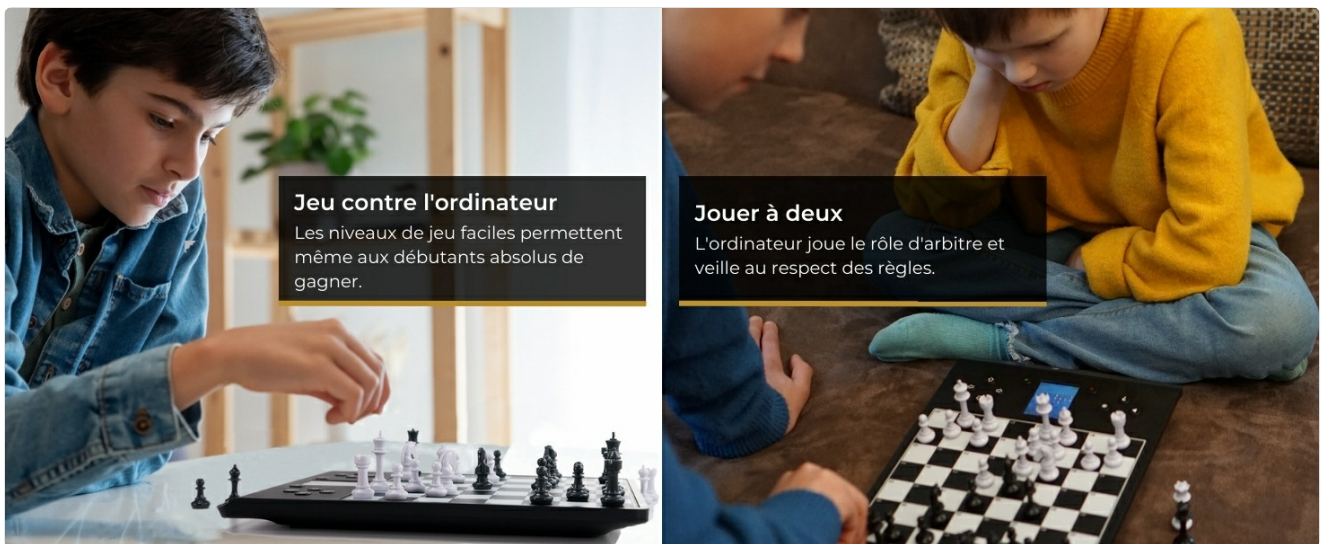


Figure 8: Game modes. The ChessGenius PRO supports playing against the computer and a two-player mode where the computer enforces rules.

FEATURES AND TRAINING OPTIONS


The ChessGenius PRO is equipped with various features to assist and train players:


- **Move Suggestions:** Receive hints for optimal moves.
- **Bad Move Warnings:** The computer alerts you to potentially poor moves, helping you learn from mistakes.
- **Take-back Options:** Undo moves to explore different strategies or correct errors.
- **Help Button:** Press the '?' button to get assistance or suggestions during a game.
- **Opening Names Display:** The screen can display the names of chess openings as they occur, aiding in learning opening theory.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your ChessGenius PRO, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the board and pieces with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the chess pieces in the provided storage bag to prevent loss and damage. Keep the device in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** If the device will not be used for an extended period, remove the batteries to prevent leakage and potential damage to the electronics.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your ChessGenius PRO.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not turn on.	Batteries are dead or incorrectly inserted. AC adapter (if used) is not properly connected or faulty.	Check battery polarity and replace with new batteries. Ensure AC adapter is securely plugged into both the device and the power outlet.
Pieces do not register on the board.	Piece not placed correctly on the center of the square. Magnetic sensor issue (rare).	Ensure each piece is centered on its square. Try restarting the device. If the problem persists, contact customer support.
Display is dim or unreadable.	Low battery power. Display settings.	Replace batteries or use AC adapter. Check display brightness settings in the menu.

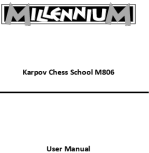
