1. INTRODUCTION

4. SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all knives from their packaging. Dispose of packaging materials responsibly.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Serrated knives are specifically designed for cutting foods with a tough exterior and soft interior, such as:

- Tomatoes and other soft fruits/vegetables
- Roasts and poultry (for slicing, not bone cutting)

Proper Cutting Technique:

- Place the food on a stable cutting board.

- Hold the knife firmly by the handle, ensuring a secure grip.
- Use a sawing motion, moving the blade back and forth across the food. Avoid pressing down too hard, as the serrations are designed to do the work.
- Always keep your free hand clear of the blade's path.

- **Sharpening:** Serrated knives require specialized sharpening tools and techniques. For best results, consider professional sharpening services when the knives become dull. Do not attempt to sharpen with standard knife sharpeners, as this can damage the serrations.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Knives appear dull	Normal wear and tear; improper sharpening attempts.	Serrated knives require specialized sharpening. Consider professional sharpening services.
Rust spots on blade	Improper drying; exposure to moisture for extended periods; harsh detergents.	Ensure knives are dried immediately after washing. Avoid leaving them in standing water. Use mild detergents. Minor spots can sometimes be removed with a non-abrasive cleaner.
Loose handle	Wear over time; exposure to extreme temperatures.	Discontinue use if the handle is significantly loose. Contact support if within warranty.
