INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Trevi SLD 3850 Digital Alarm Clock. This device combines a digital clock, alarm, calendar, and thermometer into a compact and user-friendly design. Please read this manual carefully to ensure proper setup and operation of your new alarm clock.



COMPONENTS AND CONTROLS

Familiarize yourself with the various parts and control buttons of your Trevi SLD 3850 alarm clock.

- LCD Display: Shows time, date, day of the week, and temperature.
- SET Button: Used to enter time/date/alarm setting mode.
- UP/DOWN Buttons: Used to adjust values during setting, and to switch between 12/24-hour format or Celsius/Fahrenheit.
- ALARM ON/OFF Button: Activates or deactivates the alarm.
- SNOOZE/LIGHT Button: Activates the snooze function when the alarm sounds, or illuminates the display backlight.
- Battery Compartment: Located on the back, for battery installation.

SETUP

1. Battery Installation

- 1. Open the battery compartment cover located on the back of the unit.
- 2. Insert the required batteries (e.g., 2 x AAA, not included) according to the polarity indicators (+ and -) inside the compartment.
- 3. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

4. The display will light up, and the clock will be ready for initial setup.

2. Setting Time and Date

- 1. Press and hold the SET button for approximately 3 seconds until the hour digits start flashing.
- 2. Use the **UP** or **DOWN** buttons to adjust the hour.
- 3. Press **SET** again to confirm the hour and move to setting the minutes.
- 4. Use the **UP** or **DOWN** buttons to adjust the minutes.
- 5. Continue pressing **SET** to cycle through and set the year, month, and day using the **UP** or **DOWN** buttons for adjustment.
- 6. After setting the day, press **SET** one last time to exit the setting mode.

3. Setting Temperature Unit (Celsius/Fahrenheit)

In normal time display mode, press the **DOWN** button to toggle between Celsius (°C) and Fahrenheit (°F) temperature units.

4. 12/24-Hour Format Selection

In normal time display mode, press the **UP** button to switch between 12-hour and 24-hour time formats.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Setting the Alarm

- 1. Press the **SET** button once (short press) to display the current alarm time.
- 2. While the alarm time is displayed, press and hold the **SET** button for approximately 3 seconds until the alarm hour digits start flashing.
- 3. Use the **UP** or **DOWN** buttons to adjust the alarm hour.
- 4. Press **SET** again to confirm the alarm hour and move to setting the alarm minutes.
- 5. Use the **UP** or **DOWN** buttons to adjust the alarm minutes.
- 6. Press SET one last time to exit the alarm setting mode.

2. Activating/Deactivating the Alarm

Press the **ALARM ON/OFF** button to toggle the alarm function. An alarm icon (bell symbol) will appear on the display when the alarm is active and disappear when it is off.

3. Snooze Function and Backlight

- Snooze: When the alarm sounds, press the SNOOZE/LIGHT button to temporarily silence the alarm. The alarm will sound again after approximately 5 minutes.
- Backlight: In normal display mode, press the SNOOZE/LIGHT button to illuminate the display for a few seconds.

4. Stopping the Alarm

To stop the alarm completely after it sounds (without snooze), press any button other than the SNOOZE/LIGHT button, or let it ring for its full duration (typically 1 minute) after which it will automatically stop and reset for the next day.

MAINTENANCE

• Cleaning: Wipe the unit with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

- Battery Replacement: When the display dims or functions become erratic, replace the batteries with new ones. Ensure correct polarity.
- Storage: If the unit will not be used for an extended period, remove the batteries to prevent leakage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Display is blank or dim.	Batteries are dead or inserted incorrectly.	Replace batteries with new ones, ensuring correct polarity.
Alarm does not sound.	Alarm is not activated or set incorrectly.	Ensure the alarm icon is visible on the display. Re-check alarm time settings.
Incorrect time/date.	Time/date was not set correctly or batteries were removed.	Re-set the time and date following the "Setting Time and Date" instructions.
Temperature reading seems inaccurate.	Unit is placed near a heat source or in direct sunlight.	Relocate the clock to a stable room temperature environment.
