COMPATIBILITY

These thermal laminating pouches are compatible with all standard **HOT mode laminator machines**. Ensure your laminator is set to the correct temperature for 3 Mil (80 Mic) pouches for optimal results.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for effective lamination using MAXDONE thermal pouches:

1. **Prepare Your Laminator:** Turn on your laminator and allow it to preheat to the recommended temperature for 3 Mil (80 Mic) thermal pouches. Wait for the 'Ready' indicator light (if available) to illuminate.
2. **Open the Pouch:** Carefully open one laminating pouch. The pouch is folded, with one side sealed.
3. **Insert Document:** Place the document or item you wish to laminate inside the pouch, ensuring it is centered and flat. Leave a small margin around the edges for a secure seal.
4. **Feed into Laminator:** With the sealed edge of the pouch leading, gently feed the pouch horizontally into the laminator's entry slot.
5. **Lamination Process:** The laminator will automatically pull the pouch through. Do not pull or push the pouch during this process.

6. **Cool Down:** Once the laminated item exits the machine, place it on a flat surface to cool down for a few moments. This helps to ensure a firm and smooth seal.

CARE AND STORAGE

To maintain the quality of your MAXDONE laminating pouches:

- Store pouches in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Keep them flat to prevent bending or creasing before use.
- Avoid exposing unused pouches to dust or dirt, which could affect lamination quality.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Most issues during lamination are related to the laminator machine settings or document preparation, not the pouches themselves. If you encounter problems such as bubbles, wrinkles, or incomplete seals, consider the following:

- **Bubbles or Incomplete Seal:** Ensure your laminator is fully preheated and set to the correct temperature for 3 Mil (80 Mic) pouches. A lower temperature may result in an incomplete seal.
- **Wrinkles:** Make sure the document is placed flat and smoothly inside the pouch. Feed the sealed edge of the pouch straight into the laminator.
- **Cloudy Finish:** This can sometimes indicate the laminator temperature is too low or the rollers are dirty. Refer to your laminator's manual for cleaning instructions.

If issues persist, consult your laminator's instruction manual or contact the laminator manufacturer for support.
