ALLIMITY RCH-2609NA Replacement Remote Control User Manual

For Hisense Air Conditioner Models KFR-35G and 27FZBPH

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This manual provides instructions for the ALLIMITY RCH-2609NA replacement remote control, designed for use with specific Hisense Air Conditioner models. This remote control requires no programming and is ready for use after battery installation.

Key Features

- Direct replacement, no setup or programming required.
- Durable ABS material construction.
- Ergonomic design for comfortable handling.
- Compatible with Hisense Air Conditioner models KFR-35G and 27FZBPH.

SETUP GUIDE

Battery Installation

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the remote control.
2. Slide the battery cover downwards to open.
3. Insert two (2) AAA alkaline batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+ and -) as indicated inside the compartment.
4. Slide the battery cover back into place until it clicks securely.
5. The remote control is now ready for use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This remote control is designed for intuitive operation. Point the remote control directly at your Hisense air conditioner's receiver when pressing buttons.

Button Functions

- **Power Button** (): Press to turn the air conditioner ON or OFF.
- **Temperature Up** (▲): Increases the set temperature.
- **Temperature Down** (▼): Decreases the set temperature.
- **Mode Button** (*/*): Cycles through operating modes such as Cool, Heat, Fan, Dry, Auto. *(Specific modes depend on your air conditioner model)*
- **Fan Speed Button** (⚙): Adjusts the fan speed (e.g., Low, Medium, High, Auto). *(Specific speeds depend on your air conditioner model.)*

Sliding Cover

The remote control features a sliding cover at the bottom. Slide it down to reveal additional, less frequently used functions, if available on your specific air conditioner model. Slide it up to protect these buttons and simplify the remote's appearance.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Remote Control

To clean the remote control, gently wipe its surface with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners, abrasive materials, or chemical solvents, as these may damage the remote's finish or internal components.

Battery Replacement

Replace batteries when the remote control's response becomes sluggish or stops working. Always replace both batteries simultaneously with new AAA alkaline batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries.

Dispose of used batteries according to local regulations.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Remote control not working.	Dead or incorrectly installed batteries.	Check battery polarity. Replace with new AAA alkaline batteries.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Air conditioner does not respond.	Obstruction between remote and AC unit; remote out of range; AC unit power off.	Ensure clear line of sight. Move closer to the AC unit. Check if the AC unit is powered on.
Some functions not working.	Air conditioner model does not support the function; sliding cover is closed.	Verify your AC model supports the function. Open the sliding cover for additional buttons.
