1. Introduction

Excessive noise or vibration	Loose mounting; Impeller imbalance (due to dirt); Bearing wear	Tighten mounting bolts; Clean impeller; Contact support for bearing issues.
Reduced airflow	Blocked intake/exhaust; Dirty impeller; Incorrect speed setting	Clear obstructions; Clean impeller; Adjust speed setting.
