- Always use the tool on dry skin.
- Avoid applying excessive pressure to prevent injury.

- Keep the tool away from water while in use to prevent electrical shock. The device has an IPX5 waterproof rating, meaning it is resistant to water jets, but it should not be submerged.
- Always unplug the tool before changing the grinding head or cleaning it.
- Do not attempt to disassemble, modify, or repair the product yourself to avoid personal injury or equipment damage.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The JTLB Jinding Electric Pedicure Tool is designed for effective removal of dead skin and calluses. It features an ergonomic design, two-gear speed regulation, a digital battery display, and USB charging.

2.1 Components

- **Exfoliating Roller:** The primary grinding head for callus removal.
- **Light:** Illuminates the treatment area.
- **Power Switches:** Controls the device's on/off function and speed settings.
- **Battery Display Screen:** Shows the current battery charge level.
- **Remove Key of Grinding Head:** Button to release the grinding head.
- **Charging Interface:** USB port for charging the device.

3. SETUP AND CHARGING

3.1 Charging the Device

Before first use, fully charge the device. The battery display will indicate charging status.

1. Connect the USB charging cable to the charging interface at the bottom of the tool.
2. Plug the other end of the USB cable into a suitable power source (e.g., USB wall adapter, computer USB port).
3. The red power indicator on the digital display will flash while charging.
4. Charging is complete when the indicator shows "100". A full charge takes approximately 3.5 hours.
5. Once fully charged, unplug the charging cable.

3.2 Attaching and Removing Grinding Heads

The device comes with two types of grinding heads: coarse and fine. Choose the appropriate head for your needs.

To Remove a Grinding Head:

1. Hold the machine body firmly with one hand.
2. Press the switches button for the grinding head (located on the side) at the same time.
3. With the other hand, pull the grinding head upwards to detach it.

To Mount a Grinding Head:

1. Hold the machine body firmly with one hand.
2. Align the grinding head with the front and back slots of the body.
3. Press the switches button for the grinding head at the same time, then press the grinding head down into place until it clicks securely.

Press the switches button of grinding head at the same time



Pull the grinding head up with the other hand

Head mounting method



Hold the machine body with one hand



Point the grinding head at the front and back of the body and press the switches button at the same time

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Ensure your feet are clean and completely dry before use. Do not use on wet or damp skin.

1. Select and attach the desired grinding head (coarse for heavy calluses, fine for lighter skin or finishing).
2. Press the power switch to turn on the device. The device has 2 gear regulations. Press once for the first speed, press again for the second speed.
3. Gently apply the rotating grinding head to the affected area of your foot. Move the tool in circular motions, applying light to moderate pressure.
4. Do not hold the tool in one spot for too long to avoid excessive friction and potential skin irritation.
5. Continue until the desired smoothness is achieved.
6. After use, press the power switch to turn off the device.

Note: The ergonomic design and built-in light enhance usability and visibility during operation.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your pedicure tool.

1. Ensure the device is turned off and unplugged from any charging source.
2. Remove the grinding head as described in Section 3.2.
3. Use the provided cleaning brush to remove any dead skin particles from the grinding head.
4. You can rinse the grinding head under running water. Ensure it is completely dry before reattaching or storing.
5. Clean the main body of the device with a dry or slightly damp cloth. Do not rinse the main body under water to avoid damage to the electrical components, especially the charging interface.
6. After cleaning, reattach the grinding head or store it with the pedicure head cover.
7. Store the tool in a dry place, away from direct sunlight and moisture.

 - **Reduced performance:** The grinding head may be worn out and needs replacement, or it might be clogged with skin particles. Clean or replace the grinding head.
 - **Charging issues:** Ensure the USB cable is securely connected to both the device and the power source. Try a different USB port or adapter.
