1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all instructions before assembling and using this product. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Always use the ladder to access the top bunk.
- Do not jump on the bed.
- **Weight Limit:** 250 lbs for the top bunk, 350 lbs for the bottom bunk.
- Do not use if damaged.
- Keep away from heat sources.
- Do not use inappropriate bedding materials for infants and young children.
- Ensure all connections are tight before use. Periodically check and tighten hardware.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Anwick Twin-Over-Futon Convertible Bunk Bed is a versatile furniture piece designed for space-saving and multi-functional use. It features a twin-size upper bunk and a futon-style lower bunk that can convert from a full-size bed to a sofa.

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

General Assembly Tips:

- Unpack all components and verify against the parts list in your manual.
- Assemble on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
- Do not fully tighten screws until all components are loosely assembled.
- Ensure all connections are secure before use.

Assembly Configurations:

This bunk bed offers two primary assembly configurations:

1. **Bunk Bed Configuration:** The standard setup with a twin bed on top and a futon bed/sofa on the bottom, with an optional trundle underneath.
2. **Two Separate Beds Configuration:** The upper and lower bunks can be assembled as two independent twin-size beds.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Converting the Futon:

The lower futon bed can be easily converted between a full-size bed and a sofa. Refer to the specific mechanism in your physical manual for detailed steps. Generally, this involves releasing a locking mechanism and folding the frame into the desired position.

Using the Trundle Bed:



6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** For the metal frame, wipe with a damp cloth and mild soap. Dry immediately. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- **Futon Mattress Care:** If your futon mattress has a removable cover, follow the care instructions on its label. If not, spot clean with a suitable fabric cleaner. The product specifications mention "Dry Clean Only" for product care, which typically applies to fabric components.
- **Hardware:** Periodically check all bolts and screws to ensure they are tight. Re-tighten as necessary to maintain stability and safety.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the bed for any signs of wear, damage, or loose parts. Discontinue use if damage is found and contact customer support.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING


If you encounter any issues with your Anwick bunk bed, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Instability:** Verify that all components are correctly assembled and all fasteners are fully tightened. Ensure the bed is placed on a flat, stable floor.
