## 1. INTRODUCTION

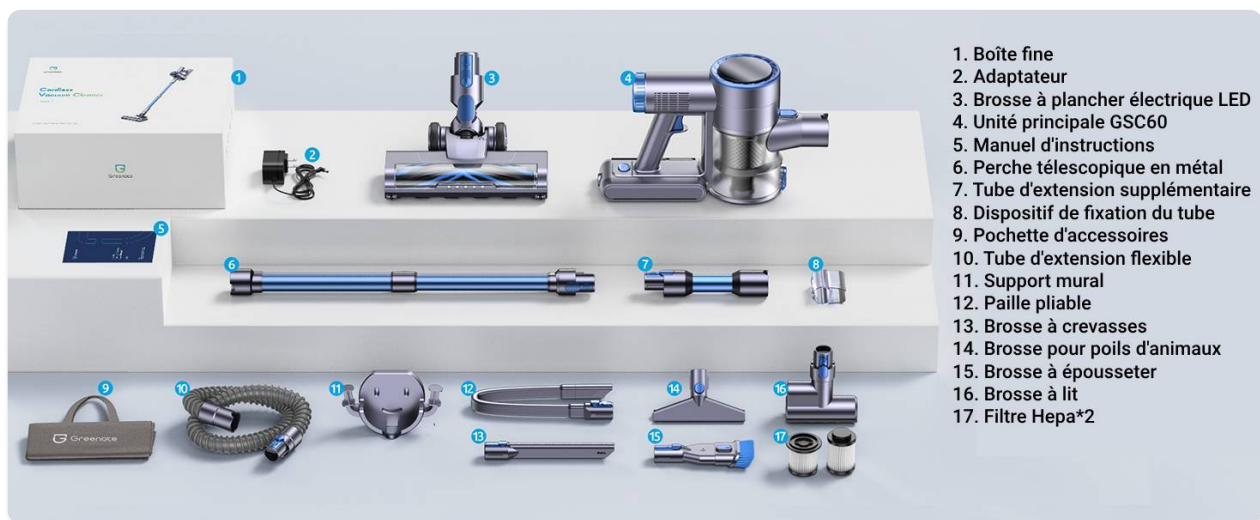


Image: An exploded view diagram showing all the individual components and accessories included with the Greenote GSC60 vacuum cleaner, each clearly numbered and labeled for identification.

### 3. SETUP AND CHARGING

#### Assembly

1. **Attach the Extension Tube:** Insert the metal telescopic rod into the main unit until it clicks into place.
2. **Connect the Floor Brush:** Attach the LED electric floor brush to the other end of the extension tube, ensuring it locks securely.
3. **Install Battery:** Ensure the battery is fully charged before first use. Insert the battery into the main unit until it clicks.
4. **Attach Accessories:** For specific cleaning tasks, attach the desired accessory directly to the main unit or the extension tube.

#### Charging the Battery

The GSC60 features a detachable battery for convenient charging. A full charge takes approximately 2.5 hours.

- **Charging on the Unit:** Connect the power adapter to the charging port on the main unit.
- **Charging Separately:** Remove the battery by pressing the release button and connect the power adapter directly to the battery.

## 4. OPERATION

### Powering On/Off and Mode Selection

The GSC60 features an intuitive LED touch screen for easy control.



- **Power On:** Press the power button on the handle. The LED screen will illuminate.
- **Adjust Suction Mode:** Tap the mode selection icon on the LED touch screen to cycle through the three suction modes: Standard (up to 55 min runtime), Power (up to 35 min runtime), and MAX (up to 20 min runtime). The screen will display the current mode and remaining battery percentage.
- **Power Off:** Press the power button again to turn off the vacuum.

## Using Attachments

The 10-in-1 multi-accessories allow for versatile cleaning across various surfaces and areas.

- **LED Electric Floor Brush:** Ideal for hard floors, tiles, carpets, and wooden floors. The integrated LED lights illuminate dust and debris in dark areas.
- **Metal Telescopic Rod:** Adjust the length for comfortable cleaning of floors or high areas. This design



reduces muscle strain.

- **Flexible Extendable Hose & Crevice Tool:** Perfect for reaching tight spaces, car interiors, and corners.
- **Pet Hair Brush & Bed Brush:** Designed to effectively remove pet hair from upholstery, carpets, and mattresses.
- **Dusting Brush:** Use for delicate surfaces, shelves, and blinds.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your vacuum cleaner.

### Emptying the Dustbin

The 1.2-liter dustbin should be emptied regularly, especially when full, to maintain suction power.

- Position the dustbin over a trash can.
- Press the dustbin release button to open the bottom flap and empty the contents.
- Close the flap securely after emptying.

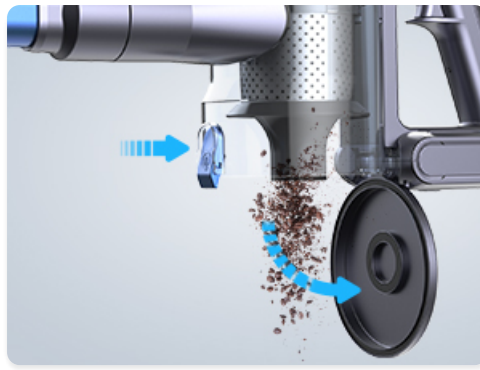

## Cleaning the Filters

The 4-stage HEPA filtration system captures 99.9% of fine particles. Filters should be cleaned regularly to prevent blockages and maintain suction.

- Twist and pull to remove the filter assembly from the dustbin.
- Separate the cyclonic filter, gitter filter, and HEPA filters.
- Tap off loose dust. Rinse washable components under cold water.
- Allow all parts to air dry completely for at least 24 hours before reassembling.

## Cleaning the Brush Roll

The anti-tangle brush roll should be inspected and cleaned periodically to remove tangled hair or debris.

- Locate the brush roll release tab on the side of the floor brush.
- Push the tab to release and slide out the brush roll.
- Remove any tangled hair or debris using scissors or a cleaning tool.
- Slide the brush roll back into place until it clicks.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Greenote GSC60, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vacuum does not turn on	Battery not charged or not properly installed.	Ensure battery is fully charged and securely clicked into place.
Low suction power	Dustbin full, filters clogged, or brush roll tangled.	Empty dustbin, clean/replace filters, clear brush roll of debris.
Brush roll stops spinning	Obstruction in the brush roll or motor protection activated.	Turn off the vacuum, remove any obstructions from the brush roll.
Short battery runtime	Battery not fully charged or operating in MAX mode.	Ensure battery is fully charged. Use Standard or Power mode for longer runtime.
LED screen displays error	Indicates a specific issue like clogged brush or nozzle.	Refer to the LED screen indicators for specific maintenance cues and address the indicated problem.
