INTRODUCTION

SETUP GUIDE

1. Charging the Devices

Before first use, ensure both the keyboard and mouse are fully charged. Use the provided USB Type-C cable to connect them to a power source.

- **Keyboard:** Connect the Type-C cable to the charging port located on the top edge of the keyboard.
- **Mouse:** Connect the Type-C cable to the charging port on the front of the mouse.
- A full charge typically takes approximately 3 hours for the keyboard and 25 hours for the mouse (with backlight off).

2. Pairing with Your Device

The TECURS KB566 set utilizes Bluetooth connectivity for wireless operation. Follow these steps to pair your keyboard and mouse with your device:

1. **Turn On:** Slide the "ON/OFF" switch on the keyboard and mouse to the "ON" position.
2. **Activate Bluetooth:** On the keyboard, press the "Connect" button (usually near the ON/OFF switch) to enter pairing mode. The Bluetooth indicator light will flash.
3. **Enable Bluetooth on Your Device:** Go to the Bluetooth settings on your computer, tablet, or smartphone.
4. **Search for Devices:** Your device will scan for available Bluetooth devices. Look for "TECURS KB566 Keyboard" and "TECURS KB566 Mouse" in the list.
5. **Select and Pair:** Select each device from the list to initiate the pairing process. Follow any on-screen prompts.
6. **Confirm Connection:** Once paired, the Bluetooth indicator light on the keyboard will stop flashing and remain solid or turn off, indicating a successful connection.

The keyboard is compatible with Windows, Android, and iOS operating systems, making it suitable for a wide range of devices including iPads, iPhones, laptops, and PCs.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Keyboard Backlight Control

The keyboard features 7 colored backlights to enhance visibility and aesthetics.

- **Turn On/Off Light:** Press the **light bulb icon key** (usually near the Home key) to toggle the backlight on or off.
- **Switch Light Color:** Press the **RGB icon key** (usually next to the light bulb icon) to cycle through the available backlight colors.

2. Mouse DPI Adjustment

The wireless mouse offers adjustable DPI settings for precise cursor control.

- The mouse supports 3 DPI levels: 800, 1200, and 1600.
- To change the DPI, press the DPI button (often located behind the scroll wheel) to cycle through the settings. Each press will change the sensitivity.

3. Quiet Operation
