IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read this manual carefully before assembly and use. Keep these instructions for future reference. Failure to follow these warnings and instructions could result in serious injury or death.

- Always supervise children when using the staircase and slide.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity: **200 lbs for the upper bed** and **150 lbs for the lower bed**
- Ensure all connections are tight and secure before use. Periodically check and tighten hardware.
- The top bunk is not suitable for children under 6 years of age.
- Use only mattresses that are 39.3 inches wide and 76 inches long. The maximum mattress thickness for the upper bunk should not exceed 6 inches to ensure proper guardrail height.
- Do not allow horseplay on or under the bed.
- Prohibit more than one person on the upper bunk.
- Always use the provided guardrails on the upper bunk.
- Do not attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed; for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts, and jump ropes.
- Keep these instructions for future reference.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The SOFTSEA Twin Over Twin Floor Bunk Bed is designed for children and teens, featuring a low-profile structure, integrated stairs with banisters, and a slide for added enjoyment. This bed is constructed from solid pine wood with a painted finish.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the SOFTSEA bunk bed is required. It is recommended to have two adults for assembly. All necessary tools are included with the product. Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the packaging. Ensure all parts are present before beginning assembly.

Key Assembly Points:

- The bunk bed includes side stairs and guardrails for the top bed.
- The staircase features banisters for secure climbing.
- The ladder also provides storage compartments.
- Carefully attach the slide according to the instructions.
- Ensure all slats are properly secured to the bed rails. Some users have noted that pre-drilled holes for slats may not always align perfectly; exercise caution and ensure secure attachment.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This bunk bed is designed for sleeping and recreational use with the slide. Adhere to all safety guidelines to ensure proper

operation.

Using the Bunk Beds:

- **Upper Bunk:** Only one occupant at a time. Ensure the mattress fits snugly and the guardrails are always in place. Maximum weight capacity is 200 lbs.
- **Lower Bunk:** Suitable for one occupant. Maximum weight capacity is 150 lbs.
- **Stairs:** Use the integrated stairs for safe access to the upper bunk. Hold onto the banisters for stability. The storage compartments within the stairs can be used for small items.
- **Slide:** The slide is intended for children's play. Ensure the area around the slide exit is clear before use. Supervise children to prevent injuries.

Weight Capacities:

- Upper Bed: 200 lbs
- Lower Bed: 150 lbs

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will ensure the longevity and safety of your SOFTSEA bunk bed.

- **Cleaning:** For general cleaning, wipe surfaces with a dry cloth. For deeper cleaning, use a damp cloth with mild soap and water, then dry immediately. The manufacturer recommends "Dry Clean Only" for specific components, which typically refers to fabric parts if any, but for the wooden frame, a damp cloth is generally safe.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically (e.g., monthly) inspect all bolts, screws, and fasteners. Tighten any loose hardware to maintain structural integrity.
- **Slats Inspection:** Check bed slats for any signs of damage, cracks, or bowing. Replace damaged slats immediately to ensure proper mattress support.
- **Mold Prevention:** Ensure adequate air circulation around the bed, especially the lower bunk slats, to prevent mold growth. If mold appears, clean immediately with an appropriate mold-killing solution and ensure the area is well-ventilated.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your bunk bed.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed feels unstable or wobbly.	Loose hardware.	Inspect all bolts and screws. Tighten any loose connections using the provided tools.
Slats appear thin or bow easily.	Normal material characteristic; insufficient support.	Ensure all slats are correctly installed and evenly spaced. Consider adding extra support slats if needed (not included). Ensure mattress weight is within limits.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Chipped parts upon arrival.	Shipping damage or manufacturing defect.	Contact SOFTSEA customer support immediately with photos of the damaged parts for replacement.
Mold growth on slats (especially lower bunk).	Lack of air circulation, high humidity.	Clean affected areas with a mold-killing solution. Improve room ventilation. Ensure mattresses are not directly on the floor if the lower bunk has no slats.
Slide causes discomfort upon landing.	Design characteristic; impact at the bottom.	Place a soft mat or rug at the base of the slide to cushion landings. Supervise children during slide use.




Image: Technical drawing showing all key dimensions of the bunk bed in inches.
