SETUP

Powering the Device

The ChessGenius Pro can be powered by four AA batteries or an optional AC adapter (sold separately).

1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the board.
2. Open the battery cover and insert four AA batteries, ensuring correct polarity.
3. Alternatively, connect the optional AC adapter to the power port on the side of the board.

Initial Setup and Power-On

1. Place the chess pieces in their starting positions on the board. The magnetic base of the pieces will help them stay in place.
2. Press the power button (usually marked with a circle and vertical line) to turn on the device. The color LCD display will illuminate.
3. The display will show the initial chess board setup and may prompt you to select a language or game mode.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Gameplay

To make a move, gently press down on the square of the piece you wish to move, then press down on the destination square. The board's sensor technology will register your move. The color display will update to show the move and the current state of the game.




Figure 5: Clearly see your moves on the LCD color display.

Navigating Menus and Play Levels

Use the arrow buttons and 'SELECT' button to navigate through the menus on the LCD display. You can adjust various settings, including play levels, game modes, and access training features.




Figure 6: Menu options allow you to play at your level.

- **Play Level:** Select from a wide range of Elo ratings (350-2200) to match your skill.
- **Hints:** Request move suggestions or legal options from the built-in tutor.
- **2 Players/Analysis:** Switch between playing against the AI or using the board for 2-player games and analysis.




Figure 7: The display indicates whose turn it is.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your ChessGenius Pro, follow these cleaning guidelines:

- Wipe the board surface with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.

- Clean the chess pieces with a soft, damp cloth if necessary, then dry thoroughly.
- Ensure no liquids enter the electronic components or battery compartment.

Battery Replacement

When the display indicates low battery or the device does not power on, replace the AA batteries as described in the "Powering the Device" section under Setup.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not power on.	Low or no batteries; incorrect battery insertion; AC adapter not connected (if used).	Replace batteries, check polarity, or ensure AC adapter is securely connected.
Moves are not registering.	Pieces not pressed firmly enough; foreign object on sensor square.	Ensure a firm press on the squares. Check for debris on the board surface.
Pieces feel loose or fall easily.	Magnets may be weak (less common for Pro model); board not on a stable surface.	Ensure the board is on a flat, stable surface. If issues persist, contact support.
Display is dim or unreadable.	Low battery; brightness setting too low.	Replace batteries. Adjust display brightness using the dedicated button.





