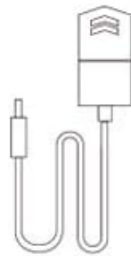

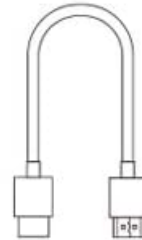

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to connect your BOXPOT Q8 TV Box to your television and power source:

1. **Connect HDMI Cable:** Insert one end of the HD cable into the HDMI port on the TV Box and the other end into an available HDMI port on your TV.
2. **Connect Power Adapter:** Plug the power adapter into the DC IN port on the TV Box, then plug the adapter into a wall outlet.
3. **Connect to Network (Optional):** For a wired connection, connect an Ethernet cable from your router to the LAN port on the TV Box. For Wi-Fi, you will configure it during the initial setup.
4. **Power On:** The TV Box should power on automatically. If not, press the power button on the device or remote control.
5. **Select Input:** On your TV, select the correct HDMI input source using your TV's remote control.
6. **Pair Remote Control:** Follow the on-screen instructions to pair the Bluetooth remote control. Typically, this involves holding down specific buttons on the remote close to the device until pairing is complete.
7. **Initial Setup:** Follow the on-screen wizard to complete the initial setup, including language selection, Wi-Fi connection, and Google account login.

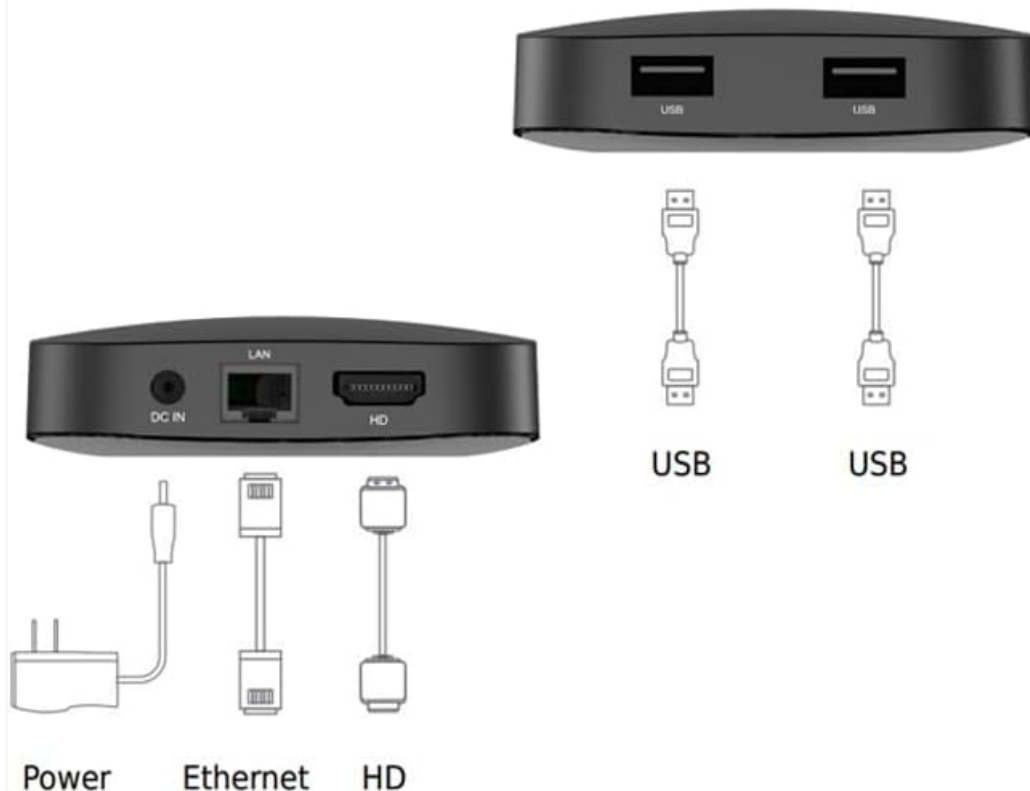


Image: A visual guide showing how to connect the power, Ethernet, and HDMI cables to the BOXPOT Q8 TV Box.

- **Remote Not Responding:** Check the batteries in the remote control. If it's a Bluetooth remote, try re-pairing it according to the setup instructions.
- **Buffering/Slow Performance:** Check your internet connection speed. For Wi-Fi, try moving the device closer to your router or using a wired Ethernet connection. Close unused applications to free up RAM.
- **App Issues:** If an app is not working correctly, try clearing its cache or reinstalling it from the Google Play Store.



