SETUP

What's Included

Before you begin, ensure all components are present in the box:

- Fire TV 2-Series 40-inch TV
- Fire TV Alexa Voice Remote
- Power cord
- 2 AAA batteries (for remote)
- 4 screws (for stand attachment)
- TV stand (2 legs)

Physical Installation

1. **Attach the TV Stand:** Carefully place the TV screen-down on a soft, clean surface. Align the two stand legs with the designated slots on the bottom of the TV. Secure each leg with the provided screws.
2. **Connect Power:** Plug the power cord into the TV's power input, then into a wall outlet.
3. **Connect Devices:** Use the available ports on the back of the TV to connect external devices such as cable boxes, gaming consoles, or sound systems.

Port Descriptions:

- **Optical:** Digital Optical Audio Output for soundbars or audio receivers.
- **Ethernet:** For wired internet connection.
- **USB:** USB 2.0 port for external storage or accessories.
- **Cable/Ant:** For connecting an antenna for over-the-air broadcasts.
- **HDMI (2 ports):** Standard HDMI 1.4 inputs for various devices.
- **HDMI ARC:** HDMI Audio Return Channel for simplified audio connection to compatible sound systems.
- **IR Emitter:** For connecting an IR blaster to control other devices.
- **Headphone:** 3.5mm audio output for headphones.

Initial Power-On and Network Connection

1. **Power On:** Press the power button on the remote or the TV.
2. **Remote Pairing:** If the remote is not automatically paired, press and hold the Home button on the remote for 10

seconds until the LED indicator flashes.

3. **Language and Region:** Follow the on-screen prompts to select your preferred language and region.
4. **Network Setup:** Select your Wi-Fi network from the list and enter the password. Alternatively, connect an Ethernet cable for a wired connection.
5. **Amazon Account:** Sign in with your Amazon account. If you don't have one, you will be prompted to create one.
6. **Channel Scan:** If you connected an antenna, the TV will guide you through a channel scan.

OPERATING YOUR FIRE TV

Using the Alexa Voice Remote

The included Alexa Voice Remote allows for intuitive control of your Fire TV and compatible devices. Insert the two AAA batteries into the remote before use.

- **Voice Button:** Press and hold the microphone button to speak commands to Alexa. Release the button when you are finished speaking.
- **Navigation Ring:** Use the circular ring to navigate menus and select items.
- **Home Button:** Returns you to the Fire TV home screen.
- **Back Button:** Goes back to the previous screen.
- **Menu Button:** Accesses contextual options within apps.
- **Playback Controls:** Play/Pause, Fast Forward, Rewind.
- **Volume Buttons:** Control the TV volume.
- **Power Button:** Turns the TV on or off.

Navigating Fire TV OS

The Fire TV home screen provides access to your favorite apps, live TV, and streaming content.

- **Home Screen:** Displays recommended content, recently used apps, and quick access to various categories.
- **Apps:** Access your installed applications. You can download new apps from the Appstore.
- **Live TV:** If you have an antenna or compatible live TV streaming service, access live channels here.
- **Settings:** Configure network settings, display and sound options, accessibility features, and more.



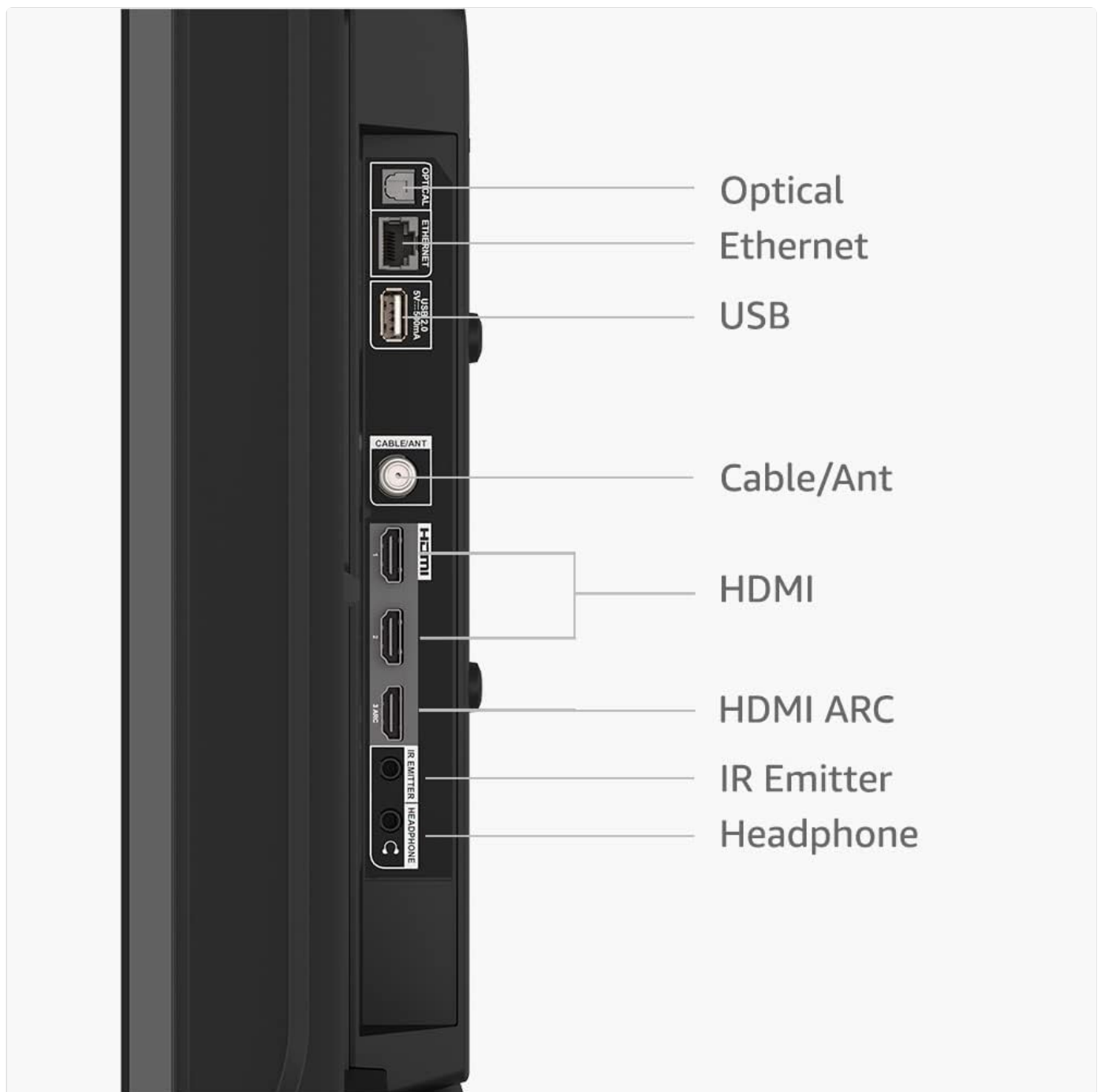

1. Go to **Settings > Remotes & Bluetooth Devices > Other Bluetooth Devices**.
2. Select **Add Bluetooth Devices**.
3. Put your Bluetooth device into pairing mode.
4. Select your device from the list to pair.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Your TV

- Always unplug the TV before cleaning.
- Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to wipe the screen and frame.
- For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Avoid spraying liquids directly onto the screen or into openings.

Software Updates

Your Fire TV automatically receives software security updates to ensure optimal performance and access to new features. Ensure your TV is connected to the internet for these updates to download and install.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Fire TV, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
No Power / TV Won't Turn On	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into both the TV and a working wall outlet. Try a different power outlet. Check if the power indicator light on the TV is on.
No Picture / Black Screen	Verify the correct input source is selected (e.g., HDMI 1, HDMI 2). Check all HDMI cables for secure connections. Restart the TV by unplugging it for 30 seconds and plugging it back in.
No Sound	Increase the volume on the TV and any connected audio devices. Check audio cable connections (HDMI ARC, Optical). Ensure the TV is not muted. If using external speakers, check their power and input settings.
Remote Not Responding	Replace the AAA batteries in the remote. Re-pair the remote by pressing and holding the Home button for 10 seconds. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV.
Network Connection Issues	Check your Wi-Fi password. Restart your Wi-Fi router and modem. Go to Settings > Network and try reconnecting. If possible, try a wired Ethernet connection.


