#### 1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the INALSA Master Vac WD 12 Wet and Dry Vacuum Cleaner. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your appliance. Please read it thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference.

## **Important Safety Instructions**

- Always ensure the power supply voltage matches the rating on the appliance.
- Do not leave the vacuum cleaner unattended when plugged in. Unplug from outlet when not in use and before servicing.
- Do not use the appliance to pick up flammable or combustible liquids, such as gasoline, or use in areas where they may be present.
- Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking, such as cigarettes, matches, or hot ashes.
- Do not use without filters in place, especially for dry vacuuming.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts.
- Use only as described in this manual. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The INALSA Master Vac WD 12 is a versatile 3-in-1 vacuum cleaner designed for wet, dry, and blowing applications. It features a powerful 1200W motor and a durable 12-liter stainless steel tank.

## 4. ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to assemble your vacuum cleaner before first use:

- 1. **Attach Wheels:** Turn the SS container upside down. Insert the four wheels into the designated slots on the base until they click into place.
- 2. **Secure Carry Handle:** Attach the carry handle to the motor unit using the provided handle screws.
- Connect Hose: Insert the flexible hose into the suction port on the front of the SS container for vacuuming, or into the blower port on the motor unit for blowing. Ensure it is securely twisted into place.
- 4. **Assemble Extension Pipes and Nozzle:** Connect the desired number of extension pipes to the hose handle. Attach the appropriate cleaning nozzle (e.g., wet & dry squeezing brush, crevice nozzle, or small round brush) to the end of the extension pipe.
- 5. **Install Filter (Crucial):** Depending on your cleaning task (wet or dry), install the correct filter as described in the 'Operating Modes' section.

## 5. OPERATING MODES

The INALSA Master Vac WD 12 offers three distinct operating modes:

## **5.1 Dry Vacuuming**

For dry dust and debris collection:

- Ensure the **Cloth Filter** is securely installed over the motor unit's filter cage. The HEPA filter is also suitable for dry use.
- Connect the hose to the **suction port** on the front of the SS container.
- Use the appropriate dry cleaning attachment, such as the 2-in-1 crevice nozzle or small round brush.

## 5.2 Wet Vacuuming

For liquid spills and wet cleaning:

- Remove the cloth filter. Install the **Sponge Filter** over the motor unit's filter cage.
- Connect the hose to the **suction port** on the front of the SS container.
- Use the wet & dry squeezing brush for optimal liquid pickup.
- **Important:** Do not overfill the tank. The vacuum cleaner has a buoy technology that will stop suction when the water level reaches its maximum.

#### **5.3 Blower Function**

For clearing leaves, dust from crevices, or drying surfaces:

• Remove all filters (cloth, sponge, HEPA) from the motor unit.

- Connect the hose to the blower port located on the top of the motor unit.
- Direct the hose towards the area to be cleared.




Figure 5.2: Filter Configuration for Each Mode

## 6. OPERATION

- 1. Prepare the Vacuum: Ensure the correct filter is installed for your task (dry, wet, or blower).
- 2. **Connect Power:** Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet. The 4-meter power cable provides ample reach.
- 3. Turn On: Press the ON/OFF switch located on the motor unit to start the vacuum cleaner.
- 4. **Clean:** Guide the appropriate attachment over the surface to be cleaned. For dry vacuuming, move steadily to allow suction to pick up debris. For wet vacuuming, move slowly to allow the brush to collect liquids.
- 5. **Turn Off:** Once cleaning is complete, press the ON/OFF switch to turn off the appliance.
- 6. **Unplug:** Disconnect the power cord from the outlet.

## **Cleaning Range**

The INALSA Master Vac WD 12 offers an extensive cleaning range of over 7.0 meters, allowing you to clean large areas without frequently unplugging. This is achieved through its 1.8m flexible hose pipe, 3 x 0.3m extension tubes, and a 4.0m power cord.

## 7. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your vacuum cleaner.

## 7.1 Emptying the Tank

- Always unplug the vacuum cleaner before emptying.
- Unlatch the clips on the side of the container and carefully lift off the motor unit.
- Dispose of collected dry debris or pour out liquids from the stainless steel tank.
- Clean the inside of the tank with a damp cloth if necessary and dry thoroughly before reassembly.

## 7.2 Filter Care

Filters are crucial for performance and motor protection. Clean or replace them regularly.

- Cloth Filter (for Dry Use): After dry vacuuming, remove the cloth filter and gently shake off
  accumulated dust. It can be hand-washed with mild soap and water. Ensure it is completely dry
  before re-installing.
- Sponge Filter (for Wet Use): After wet vacuuming, remove the sponge filter and rinse it under running water. Squeeze out excess water and allow it to air dry completely before storage or next use.
- HEPA Filter: The HEPA filter should be cleaned periodically by tapping it gently to dislodge dust. Do
  not wash the HEPA filter unless specified by the manufacturer, as it can damage the filter media.
   Replace the HEPA filter if it appears heavily soiled or damaged.

## 7.3 Cleaning Accessories

Wash all nozzles, brushes, and extension pipes with water and mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly and allow them to air dry before storing.

Vacuum cleaner does not start.	No power supply.	Check if the plug is securely inserted into the outlet. Check the circuit breaker.
Low or no suction.	<ul> <li>Hose or attachment blocked.</li> <li>Filter clogged.</li> <li>Tank full (wet vacuuming).</li> <li>Motor unit not properly sealed.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Check and clear any blockages in the hose, extension pipes, or nozzles.</li> <li>Clean or replace the filter.</li> <li>Empty the tank.</li> <li>Ensure the motor unit is securely latched onto the container.</li> </ul>
Water leaks from the tank.	<ul> <li>Tank overfilled.</li> <li>Seal around motor unit damaged or improperly seated.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Empty the tank.</li> <li>Check the seal and ensure the motor unit is correctly latched.</li> </ul>
Blower function is weak.	Filter still installed.	Ensure all filters are removed when using the blower function.
