1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Dpofirs Mini Body Camera. This compact and versatile device is designed for various recording needs, offering 1080P Full HD video, 12MP photos, and infrared night vision. Please read this manual carefully to ensure proper use and optimal performance of your camera.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND KEY FEATURES

The Dpofirs Mini Body Camera is a portable recording device equipped with advanced features for reliable performance.

- **Full HD 1080P Video & 12MP Photos:** Records clear videos at 1920x1080P and captures high-resolution photos at 4032x3024P.
- **Infrared Night Vision:** Equipped with infrared lights for clear video and photo capture in low-light or dark conditions.
- **Long Recording Time:** Built-in 1000mAh battery provides up to 5 hours of continuous video recording. Can be powered by an external power bank for extended use.
- **Loop Recording:** Automatically overwrites the oldest files when the memory card is full, ensuring continuous recording.
- **One-Touch Operation:** Simple controls for video and audio recording.
- **Rotatable Lens:** Features a 180° rotatable lens for flexible recording angles.
- **Micro SD Card Support:** Supports up to 256GB Micro SD card (not included).

4. PARTS IDENTIFICATION

Familiarize yourself with the different parts of your camera:

5. SETUP

5.1. Charging the Camera

1. Connect the camera to a USB power source (e.g., computer, wall adapter) using the provided charging cable.
2. The indicator light will show the charging status. Refer to the indicator light section for details.
3. A full charge typically takes approximately 2-3 hours.

5.2. Inserting the Micro SD Card

The camera requires a Micro SD card (up to 256GB, not included) for storing recordings.

1. Locate the TF Card Slot on the side of the camera.
2. Gently insert the Micro SD card into the slot with the gold contacts facing down until it clicks into place.
3. To remove, push the card in slightly until it springs out.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press and hold the Power Button for a few seconds until the indicator light turns on.
- **Power Off:** Press and hold the Power Button again for a few seconds until the indicator light turns off.

6.2. Video Recording

The camera supports one-touch video recording.

1. Ensure the camera is powered on.
2. Press the **One-Touch Video Recording** button once to start recording. The indicator light will change to confirm recording has started.
3. Press the **One-Touch Video Recording** button again to stop recording. The video file will be saved to the Micro SD card.

6.3. Audio Recording

The camera supports one-tap audio recording.

1. Ensure the camera is powered on.
2. Press the **One-Tap Audio Recording** button once to start recording audio. The indicator light will change to confirm recording has started.
3. Press the **One-Tap Audio Recording** button again to stop recording. The audio file will be saved to the Micro SD card.

6.4. Night Vision

Activate night vision for recording in low-light conditions.

1. While the camera is powered on, press the **Infrared Light Button** to activate night vision.
2. The night vision lights will turn on, allowing for clear recording in the dark.
3. Press the **Infrared Light Button** again to deactivate night vision.

6.5. Loop Recording

The camera automatically manages storage space by overwriting old files.

- When the Micro SD card's memory is full, the camera will automatically delete the oldest video files to make space for new recordings.
- This feature ensures continuous recording without manual intervention.

7. MAINTENANCE

- Keep the camera clean and free from dust and moisture.
- Avoid dropping the camera or subjecting it to strong impacts.
- Do not attempt to disassemble the camera, as this will void the warranty.
- Store the camera in a cool, dry place when not in use.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Camera does not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the camera fully.
Cannot record video/audio.	No Micro SD card inserted or card is full/corrupted.	Insert a Micro SD card. Format or replace the card if full or corrupted.
Poor video/audio quality.	Lens is dirty; recording in very low light without night vision; microphone obstructed.	Clean the lens. Activate night vision in dark environments. Ensure microphone is clear.
Camera freezes or becomes unresponsive.	Software glitch.	Press the Reset Button using a thin object (e.g., paperclip) to restart the camera.
