

#### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to correctly attach a new Phonak Power Smokey Dome to your hearing aid receiver. Always handle domes with clean hands.

- 1. Gently remove the old dome from the receiver by pulling it straight off.
- 2. Ensure the receiver tip is clean and free from any debris.
- 3. Take a new Power Smokey Dome (Small, 10mm) from its packaging.
- 4. Align the opening of the dome with the tip of the receiver.
- 5. Push the dome firmly onto the receiver until it clicks securely into place. Ensure it is fully seated and not loose
- 6. Verify that the dome is securely attached before inserting the hearing aid into your ear.

#### MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular cleaning and timely replacement of your hearing aid domes are crucial for optimal performance and hygiene.

- Daily Cleaning: Gently wipe the dome with a clean, dry cloth after each use to remove earwax and debris.
- **Avoid Liquids:** Do not use water or cleaning solutions directly on the domes unless specifically instructed by your audiologist or the manufacturer.
- **Regular Replacement:** Domes should be replaced regularly, typically every 2-4 weeks, or sooner if they appear discolored, stiff, or damaged. This prevents wax buildup and maintains sound quality.
- Storage: Store unused domes in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
