1. INTRODUCTION

3. SETUP

3.1 Initial Charging

Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge the pencil. The Baseus Smooth Writing Series 2 supports two charging methods:

- **Wired Charging:** Connect the provided USB-C cable to the pencil's charging port and to a USB power adapter (not included).
- **Wireless Charging:** Attach the pencil magnetically to the side of a compatible iPad model. The pencil will begin

charging automatically.

3.2 Pairing with iPad

The Baseus Smooth Writing Series 2 Pencil typically connects automatically to compatible iPad models when powered on and placed near the device. No manual Bluetooth pairing is usually required for basic functionality.

- Ensure your iPad's Bluetooth is enabled.
- Turn on the pencil by pressing the power button (if applicable, refer to Operating section).
- The pencil should connect automatically. If not, try restarting both the pencil and your iPad.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Power On/Off

Locate the power button on the pencil (refer to image below). Press and hold the button for a few seconds to turn the pencil on or off. An indicator light will typically show the power status.

4.2 Writing and Drawing

The pencil is designed for smooth and precise input on your iPad screen. Its high-precision tip allows for detailed work, while palm rejection ensures that only the pencil's input is registered, even if your hand rests on the screen.

Simply touch the tip to the iPad screen to begin writing, drawing, or navigating. Pressure sensitivity and tilt support may vary depending on the iPad model and the application used.

4.3 Charging the Pencil

Monitor the pencil's battery level through your iPad's battery widget or the pencil's indicator light. Recharge the pencil using either the wired USB-C connection or by attaching it magnetically to a compatible iPad for wireless charging.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning

To clean the pencil, gently wipe its surface with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, alcohol, or

solvents, as these can damage the finish.

5.2 Replacing the Tip

Over time, the pencil tip may wear down. To replace it:

1. Gently twist the old tip counter-clockwise to remove it.
2. Align the new tip with the pencil's thread and twist clockwise until it is securely fastened. Do not overtighten.

5.3 Battery Care

To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the pencil frequently. Store the pencil in a cool, dry place when not in use for extended periods.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Pencil not connecting to iPad.	Pencil is off, low battery, Bluetooth off on iPad, or compatibility issue.	Ensure pencil is charged and powered on. Check iPad's Bluetooth settings. Restart both devices. Verify iPad model compatibility.
Pencil not charging.	Cable issue, power source issue, incorrect wireless charging position, or iPad model incompatibility for wireless charging.	Try a different USB-C cable or power adapter. Ensure the pencil is correctly aligned for wireless charging. Note that wireless charging may not be compatible with all iPad models (e.g., iPad 10th Gen).
Tip not responding or inaccurate.	Worn tip, loose tip, or software glitch.	Replace the tip if worn. Ensure the tip is securely tightened. Restart the iPad and the pencil.
Palm rejection not working.	Application specific issue or iPad settings.	Ensure the application supports palm rejection. Check iPad settings for stylus input.
