1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation, setup, and maintenance of your Ninja CFN601 Espresso & Coffee Barista System. This versatile appliance is designed to brew single-serve coffee pods, Nespresso-compatible capsules, and up to a 12-cup carafe of coffee, featuring a built-in frother for specialty beverages.

Please read all instructions thoroughly before using the appliance to ensure proper function and to prevent injury or damage.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, injury, or damage.

- Read all instructions before use.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against fire, electric shock, and injury to persons, do not immerse cord, plugs, or appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may result in fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Key Components

- **Control Panel:** Features buttons for brew styles, sizes, and functions like Delay Brew, Keep Warm, and Clean.
- **Water Reservoir:** Removable for easy filling and cleaning.
- **Brew Basket:** For ground coffee, compatible with paper filters.
- **Capsule Holder:** For Nespresso-compatible capsules.
- **Built-in Frother:** Fold-away design for milk frothing.
- **Adjustable Cup Tray:** Accommodates various cup and travel mug sizes.
- **12-Cup Glass Carafe:** For larger coffee batches.
- **Ninja Smart Scoop:** For precise ground coffee measurement.
- **Used Capsule Storage Bin:** Collects up to 20 used capsules.

Features

- **Barista Plus Technology:** 19-bar pressure system for flavorful espresso with crema.
- **Coffeehouse Drinks at Home:** Create cappuccinos, lattes, and flat whites with the integrated frother.
- **Single-Serve Espresso:** Brew Espresso (1.35 oz), Lungo (3.75 oz), and Over Ice (1 oz) from capsules.
- **Brew Through Coffee Grounds:** Classic, Rich, or Over Ice brews in 9 sizes, from single cup to 12-cup carafe.
- **Convenient Functions:** Delay Brew, Keep Warm, and Clean functions for enhanced usability.

4. INITIAL SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Clean:** Wash the water reservoir, carafe, brew basket, and frother whisk in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry.
3. **Position:** Place the system on a clean, dry, level surface.
4. **Fill Water Reservoir:** Fill the removable water reservoir with fresh, filtered water up to the MAX fill line. Ensure it is securely seated on the unit.
5. **Power On:** Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet. The power button will illuminate.
6. **Initial Clean Cycle:** Before first use, run a full water reservoir through the system without coffee or capsules to prime the system and clean internal components. Follow the 'Clean' cycle instructions in the operating section.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Brewing Ground Coffee

1. Ensure the water reservoir is filled.
2. Open the brew basket lid and insert a paper filter.
3. Use the Ninja Smart Scoop to add desired amount of ground coffee to the filter. Close the lid.
4. Place your cup or carafe on the adjustable cup tray or warming plate.
5. Select your desired brew size (cup, travel mug, carafe) and brew style (Classic, Rich, Over Ice) using the control panel.
6. Press the 'Start Brew' button.

5.2 Brewing Espresso Capsules

1. Ensure the water reservoir is filled.
2. Lift the capsule lever and insert a Nespresso-compatible capsule into the capsule holder. Close the lever firmly.
3. Place an espresso cup on the adjustable cup tray.
4. Select your desired espresso size (Espresso, Lungo, Over Ice) on the control panel.
5. Press the 'Start Brew' button.

5.3 Using the Built-in Frother

1. Fill a mug with cold milk (dairy or non-dairy) to your desired level.
2. Swing out the frother arm from the side of the unit.
3. Submerge the frother whisk into the milk.
4. Press and hold the frother button until desired froth consistency is achieved.
5. Once complete, swing the frother arm back into its storage position. Clean immediately after use.

5.4 Additional Functions

- **Delay Brew:** Set a time for your coffee to start brewing automatically.
- **Keep Warm:** The warming plate will keep your carafe coffee warm for a set duration after brewing.
- **Clean Function:** Use this cycle for descaling and deep cleaning.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and longevity of your Ninja Barista System.

6.1 Daily Cleaning

- **Frother:** After each use, wipe the frother whisk with a damp cloth. For a deeper clean, remove the whisk and wash with warm, soapy water.
- **Drip Tray & Grate:** Remove and wash with warm, soapy water.
- **Carafe & Brew Basket:** Wash with warm, soapy water after each use.
- **Used Capsule Bin:** Empty and rinse daily.

6.2 Weekly Cleaning

- **Water Reservoir:** Wash with warm, soapy water and rinse thoroughly.
- **Exterior:** Wipe down the exterior of the unit with a soft, damp cloth.

6.3 Descaling

The 'Clean' indicator light will illuminate when descaling is required. This process removes mineral buildup from hard water.

1. Empty the water reservoir.
2. Pour 16 oz. of white vinegar into the water reservoir, then fill the rest with water up to the MAX fill line.
3. Place the carafe on the warming plate.
4. Press the 'Clean' button and follow the on-screen prompts. The cycle will take approximately 20-30 minutes.
5. After the cycle, discard the solution from the carafe and rinse the reservoir.
6. Run two full cycles with fresh water to rinse the system thoroughly.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Unit unplugged; circuit breaker tripped	Ensure unit is plugged in; check circuit breaker.
Coffee not brewing	Water reservoir empty; brew basket/capsule not properly seated	Fill water reservoir; ensure brew basket/capsule is correctly inserted.
"Clean" light illuminated	System needs descaling	Perform a descaling cycle as per Section 6.3.
Weak coffee	Insufficient coffee grounds; incorrect brew style selected	Increase coffee grounds; select 'Rich' brew style.
Frother not working	Frother whisk dirty or clogged	Clean frother whisk thoroughly.
