BWT Bestprotect M Filter Candle User Manual

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The BWT Bestprotect M Filter Candle is an advanced water filtration solution designed to optimize water quality. It features a 5-stage filtration process that effectively prevents the formation of limescale and gypsum, while also maintaining a consistently high pH value to minimize corrosion risks. The integrated activated charcoal fleece ensures consistently crystal-clear water.

Key Features:

- **Advanced 5-Stage Filtration:** Provides comprehensive water treatment.
- **Limescale and Gypsum Protection:** Reliable protection for connected machines.
- **High pH Value:** Helps to minimize the risk of corrosion in water systems.
- **Crystal-Clear Water:** Achieved through activated charcoal fleece.
- **User-Friendly Design:** Facilitates ease of handling during filter replacement.

2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper installation is crucial for the optimal performance of your BWT Bestprotect M Filter Candle. Please follow these general guidelines. For specific system configurations, consult your water system's manual or a qualified technician.

Safety Precautions:

- Ensure the main water supply is turned off before beginning installation.
- Relieve any water pressure in the system before opening connections.

- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment, such as gloves and eye protection.
- Do not overtighten connections, as this may cause damage.

Installation Steps:

1. **Unpack the Filter Candle:** Carefully remove the filter candle from its packaging. Inspect for any visible damage.
2. **Prepare the Filter Head:** If replacing an existing filter, ensure the filter head is clean and free of debris.
3. **Insert the Filter Candle:** Align the filter candle with the filter head. Insert it firmly and twist according to the markings on the filter head until it is securely locked in place.
4. **Check for Leaks:** Slowly turn on the main water supply. Carefully check all connections for any signs of leakage. Tighten if necessary.
5. **Initial Flush:** Allow water to run through the filter for several minutes (e.g., 2-5 minutes) to flush out any air or loose carbon particles. This prepares the filter for regular use.

3. OPERATION

Once installed and flushed, the BWT Bestprotect M Filter Candle operates automatically as water flows through your system. No further user interaction is typically required during normal operation.

Normal Use:

- The filter continuously treats water as it passes through, providing protection against limescale and gypsum, maintaining pH, and ensuring clear water.
- Monitor your water system for any changes in water flow or quality, which may indicate the need for filter replacement.

4. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance, primarily filter replacement, is essential to ensure the continued effectiveness of your BWT Bestprotect M Filter Candle and the quality of your water.

Filter Replacement:

- The BWT Bestprotect M Filter Candle is designed for user-friendly replacement.
- The replacement frequency depends on water hardness, usage volume, and local water quality. Refer to your system's documentation or the filter's capacity indicator (if available) for recommended replacement intervals.
- To replace, turn off the main water supply and relieve pressure. Twist the old filter candle to unlock and remove it. Insert the new filter candle following the installation steps outlined in Section 2.
- Always flush the new filter after replacement.

Cleaning:

The filter candle itself is a consumable item and cannot be cleaned for reuse. Ensure the filter head and housing are kept clean during replacement.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your BWT Bestprotect M Filter Candle. If problems persist, contact customer support.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Reduced Water Flow	Clogged filter candle; air in the system.	Replace the filter candle; flush the system to remove air.
Unusual Taste or Odor	Filter candle needs replacement; initial flush incomplete.	Replace the filter candle; perform a thorough initial flush.
Water Leakage	Improperly seated filter candle; loose connections; damaged O-rings.	Ensure filter candle is correctly installed and tightened; check and tighten all connections; inspect and replace O-rings if damaged.
Filter Not Locking Securely	Misalignment; obstruction.	Realign the filter candle and try again; check for any debris preventing proper seating.

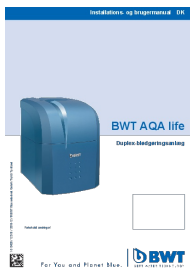
