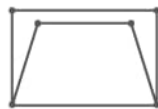

## 2. Setup Guide

### 2.1 Package Contents

Before proceeding, ensure all components are present in the package:

- WANBO Mozart 1 Projector
- Power Adapter
- Remote Control
- User Manual (this document)
- Other accessories (e.g., HDMI cable, if included in your specific package)

## 2.2 Physical Placement

Place the projector on a stable, flat surface. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the device to prevent overheating. For optimal projection, position the projector perpendicular to the screen or wall.

## 2.3 Power Connection

Connect the power adapter to the projector's power input port, then plug the adapter into a wall outlet. The power indicator light will illuminate.

## 2.4 Initial Power On & Network Setup

Press the power button on the projector or the remote control to turn on the device. Follow the on-screen prompts to select your language and connect to a Wi-Fi network. A stable internet connection is required for system updates and accessing online content.

## 3. Operating Instructions

---

### 3.1 Basic Navigation

Use the provided remote control to navigate the Android interface. The directional buttons allow movement, the 'OK' button confirms selections, and the 'Back' button returns to the previous screen.

### 3.2 Automatic Adjustments (Focus, Keystone, Obstacle Avoidance)

The WANBO Mozart 1 features intelligent automatic adjustments:

- **Auto Focus:** The projector automatically adjusts the image clarity. If needed, manual focus adjustment options are available in the settings.
- **Auto Keystone Correction:** The projector automatically corrects the trapezoidal distortion of the image, ensuring a rectangular projection even if the projector is not perfectly aligned. Manual keystone adjustment is also available for fine-tuning.
- **Intelligent Obstacle Avoidance:** The projector can detect obstacles in the projection path and automatically adjust the image size and position to avoid them.

### 3.3 Connecting External Devices

The projector supports various input sources:

- **HDMI:** Connect gaming consoles (PS5, Xbox), laptops, PCs, or TV boxes via the HDMI ARC port.
- **USB:** Plug in USB drives to play media files directly.
- **Bluetooth:** Connect external Bluetooth speakers or headphones for enhanced audio.
- **Wireless Mirroring:** Supports screen mirroring from iOS and Android devices.



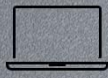

## 3.4 Audio Output

The projector features built-in 8W x 2 speakers with a full-frequency unit and symmetrical structure, providing robust audio. For a more immersive experience, connect external audio systems via Bluetooth or the HDMI ARC port.

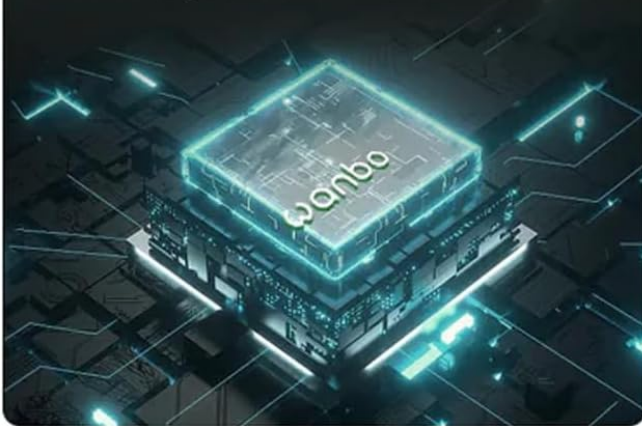
## 3.6 App Management

## 4. Maintenance

### 4.1 Cleaning the Lens

Use a soft, lint-free cloth specifically designed for optical lenses to gently wipe the projector lens. Avoid using abrasive materials or harsh chemicals that could damage the lens coating.

### 4.2 Dust Prevention & Heat Dissipation

The WANBO Mozart 1 is designed with anti-dust features. To maintain optimal performance and prevent overheating, ensure the projector's ventilation ports are clear and unobstructed. Regularly clean the exterior with a soft, dry cloth. The projector incorporates a dual-intelligent temperature control NTC system with 3 fans for efficient heat dissipation.

## 5. Troubleshooting

### 5.1 Common Issues and Solutions

Issue	Possible Cause / Solution
-------	---------------------------

Issue	Possible Cause / Solution
No image or distorted image	Check power connection. Ensure lens cap is removed. Verify input source. Perform manual focus or keystone correction if auto-adjustment is insufficient.
Audio/Video lag or out of sync	Restart the projector. Check for system updates. If using external devices, ensure their cables are securely connected.
Applications uninstalling or not launching	Ensure sufficient storage space. Reinstall the application. Perform a factory reset if the issue persists (note: this will erase all data).
Projector overheating	Ensure ventilation ports are clear. Operate in a well-ventilated area. Turn off and allow to cool down.
Obstacle avoidance or auto keystone not working as expected	Ensure the projector is on a stable surface. Clear any objects directly in front of the projector's sensors. Manual adjustment may be required in some complex environments.

### 5.2 Resetting the Device

If you encounter persistent issues, you may perform a factory reset. Navigate to *Settings > System > Reset* and confirm the action. **Warning:** A factory reset will erase all personal data, installed applications, and settings, restoring the projector to its original factory state.




